



## Minutes of the 89<sup>th</sup> SEAC Meeting held on 25<sup>st</sup> May 2017


<p><b>89<sup>th</sup> – 03.</b> <b>F. 6384/2017.</b></p>	<p>Proposed construction of 2112 Economically Weaker Section Tenements Under HFA - Vertical III by M/s. TamilNadu Slum Clearance Board at SF. No. 3/3A2, 237/3 Kilakathirpur Village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Kancheepuram District – Seeking Environmental Clearance - Schedule S. No. 8(a) of Category “B2” – Building and Construction projects - Regarding.</p>
	<p>The proponent M/s. TamilNadu Slum Clearance Board has applied for Environment Clearance for the proposed construction of 2112 economically weaker section tenements under HFA - Vertical III with built-up area of 81428.87 Sq.m in the total land area of 69900 Sq.m at SF. NO. 3/3A2, 237/3 Kilakathirpur Village, Kancheepuram Taluk, Kancheepuram District.</p> <p>The Committee observed that the above project comes under Item No 8(a) of the Schedule. After the presentation made by the proponent, the Committee decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA after obtaining and considering the following details,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The slum clearance board should conduct feasibility study for finalizing the source of water for the tenements proposed to be constructed and furnish a detailed report. Similarly, the quality of water from the selected source should be analyzed and a report to be submitted.</li> <li>2. The proponent should revise the design of Rain Water Harvesting structures as per the recommendations of the Ministry of Environment, Forest &amp; Climate Change and the Central Public Works Department.</li> <li>3. The proponent should go for vermicomposting at the project site for managing the bio-degradable component of the municipal solid waste that will be generated during the operational phase of the project.</li> <li>4.
