The Project Proponent has to carry out the traffic survey to estimate the signal requirement at the entry and exit of the project site. 2. The noise level generated from the cooling tower shall meet the noise levels during the day & night. The Project Proponent has to propose adequate noise abatement measures exclusively for the cooling towers. 3. The fresh water requirement is around 500 KLD. The Project Proponent has to furnish commitment from the approved sources for the drawal of fresh water for the operation phase. 4. The Project Proponent also has to provide bio-diversity management plan and use of space for green lungs with appropriate native species. Greenery plan with native species to be illustrated.
