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- **The issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held on 21.08.2015. The Committee observed as following:**

*Recommendations: The committee recommended to issue standard TOR to the mining project with the following additional TOR conditions:*

- *The project proponent shall study the belum caves.*
  - *The proponent shall avoid usage of explosives due to locations of Belum caves nearer to the mine.*

Pg (23-31) Upon payment for use of CETP of APSEZ, APIIC will allow the industries for using the CETP and Effluent generated will be treated in CETP of APSEZ”.*

***However the APSEZ CETP proposal is not mentioned.***

- b) As per the S.No. 3 (i) in the TOR issued by MoEF&CC, **Only non-polluting industries should be established in the proposed industrial area**”. In the EIA report, the APIIC mentioned the following:

*“The tentative list of Industries proposed is given in table 2-4 As seen; they are **predominantly** nonpolluting and less water consuming industries. However, as seen in table 2-3 **some red category industries have already commenced** in the proposed project and the details are mentioned in chapter-2 Pg No (21). APIIC will ensure non polluting industries will be allotted. Besides, APIIC will also ensure that no polluting industries are given relevant consent for establishment.
