SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 649th meeting in which SEIAA noted that the project was discussed in its 510th meeting dated 08.11.2021 where SEIAA opined as follows –



"SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and opined that fresh public hearing should be conducted as per EIA notification 2006 (as amended)."

From the MoM it becomes evident that data collection is during the period 08.01.2020 to 24.03.2020. Refer back to SEAC-2 for clarification on following issues –

- a) Lol was issued on 28.01.2020 and the data collection started before issuance of Lol. This needs clarification.
- b) Whether the draft EIA-EMP was prepared based on data for a period of 75 days?
- c) A clear comment whether data was collected as mandated in EIA Notification 2006 or not?"

- Permission from concerned Department for the storage of ammonia under relevant act shall be obtained.

Validity period of this EC is 5 years from the date of issue as the LoI has been issued
for a period of 5 years or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or
current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null
and void.

- Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
