The quarry lease was executed on 20.04.2007 by Asst. Director, Mines & Geology, Tekkali vide Proceedings No. 1416/Q/2003, dated 20-04-2007 for a period of 20 years with effect from 20.04.2007 to 19.04.2027.

The Mining plan has been approved by the Joint Director of Mines & Geology vide Letter No.3564/MS-TKL/2013 dated 20.09.2014 for the mining scheme period 2012-13 to 2016-17.

The credible action was initiated against this mine for operating the mine earlier (Calendar Case no.263/2016).

Earlier this proposal was appraised in the 99th SEAC meeting held on 20.12.2016. The SEIAA, A.P in its meeting held on 10.01.2017 refer back to SEAC for comprehensive recommendations.

This is a proposed Barite beneficiation project adopting dry jig process, in which there is no water requirement and Dryer. Also there is no requirement of Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP). The total water consumption is 8 KLD, i.e., for dust suppression -2 KLD, green belt development -2 KLD and Domestic consumption -4 KLD. The domestic wastewater generation is 3.6 KLD.

The Committee re-appraised and recommended for the following amendments in the Environmental Clearance order issued on 02.09.2016, as detailed below:

1. Specific Condition No. (a). (i) "A stack height 15m shall be provided to the Grinder stack. Bag filter shall be provided to control emissions. At no time, the particulate emissions should exceed 50 mg/Nm³. The DG sets of capacity 1 x 750 KVA shall be provided with adequate stack height, as per CPCB norms".

Specific Condition No. (b) (i). "The source of water is Bore well. Total water requirement is 8.0 KLD and the domestic effluents shall be disposed into septic tank followed by soak pit."

Decision of SEIAA: Agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC.

The Committee recommended for **issue of Environmental clearance** to this **Black Colour Granite Mine** mining project for quantity 4613 m^3 /annum, duly stipulating a condition that the project proponent shall maintain the setback distance 7.5 meters buffer zone all around the mine lease area for greenbelt development.

Decision of SEIAA: Agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC.

Recommendations of the SEAC on 28.01.2017:

The representative of the project proponent and their consultant M/s. Pioneer Enviro Laboratories and Consultants Limited, have attended the meeting.

This is an existing mine and the mine lease was granted in 2005 and executed on 14.02.2005.

The Mining Plan was approved on 09.12.2016 from the scheme period of 5 years i.e., 2016-17 to 2019-20.

The project proponent furnished the information on productions details for the period 2005 to 2016, duly certified by the Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Markapur. It was noted that the production quantities are within the permitted quantities.

The Committee also noted that this mining proposal is covered under the MoEF&CC, New Delhi Notification S.O.No.2269(E), dated 01.07.2016 as this mine's lease was granted prior to 9^{th} September 2013.

The Committee recommended for issue of Environmental clearance to this Quartz mining project for quantity 18,421 Tons/annum, duly stipulating a condition that the project proponent shall maintain the setback distance 7.5 meters buffer zone all around the mine lease area for greenbelt development.

Decision of SEIAA: The Authority noted that as per the MoEF, GoI, New Delhi Circular dated 28th Oct.2004 (No.J-20012/11/98-IA.II(M),dated 28.10.2004), the project proponent can apply for Environment clearance at the time of renewal of mine lease. However, in the present mine application, the mine was executed in 2005 and produced the Quartz from 2005 to 2015, In this context, the SEAC may examine whether there is any credible action to be taken on this mine as the Project Proponent appears done production without obtaining the Environmental Clearance.
