The SEAC observed that since there is active water channel in between the project location a clarification from Geological wing of Industry Department, Himachal Pradesh with respect to the compliance of Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining (January, 2020) published by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India is necessarily required. As to certify that whether the given mining lease permission is in consonance with these guidelines and strictly as per District Survey Report and copy of DSR shall be provided depicting the said mining lease area.
- 2. The project proponent shall reduce the minable area to 60% of the proposed area as per Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining.

1. The sub-committee shall visit the mining site in view of the adjoining mining activities appeared in the video shown to the Committee and submit its report.

The site was inspected on 06.10.2021 and report was submitted accordingly. The case was again appraised by the SEAC in its  $82^{nd}$  meeting with the following observations:
