The proposed project is for mining **Lime Kankar** in an area of **12.402 Ha.** with a proposed production quantity of **Lime kankar** – **0.20 MTPA** with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan. The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (<250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease). The representative of proponent and their consultant BS Envi-Tech (P) Ltd.,, have attended the meeting. The Committee noted that as per cluster letter issued by Asst. Director of Mines & Geology, Banaganapalle, vide Lr. dated: 22.12.2020. There are 03 existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mts area. The Committee noted that the extent of proponent obtained TOR on 08.10.2021. public hearing was held on 21.04.22. The project proponent reply for issues raised in public hearing is as follows:

The Environmental Consultant has clarified the doubts raised by one of the NGO regarding the baseline status. He stated that the present baseline status of PM<sub>10</sub> is

51.8  $\mu$ g/m3 and will increase up to 59 $\mu$ g/m3 and PM $_{10}$  is 27.8  $\mu$ g/m3 and will

increase up to 30 µg/m3. He also said that employment will be given to the local people basing on their eligibilities. The CSR funds will be spent to locals only. The management expressed that there 14 villages in the area and they are contributing for developing all these villages. They have taken these mines in order to run the cement plant. He said that only from Kurnool district about 73% were employed and so many from other districts as well. Preference will be given to the locals only. The District Revenue Officer, while epitomizing the proceedings of the Public Hearing for the proposed project, expressed about the importance of views, suggestions and objections by the nearby villagers. He informed that the management shall provide the local employment, develop Nandavaram Village, implement pollution control measures during mining operations and develop infrastructural facilities in the village. The Dist Revenue Officer stated that the views, suggestions and objections secured during the public hearing will be submitted to the Government to enable the concerned authorities in making the decision on issuing Environmental Clearance to the proposed project. Finally, the meeting ended with vote of thanks by Environmental Engineer, A.P. Pollution Control Board, Regional Office, Kurnool.
