1. **Affordable Housing "Diya Green City NH-24" at Khasra No.-630 & 632, Village- Khera Dehat, Tehsil-Dholana, Hapur., M/s Eureka Builders (P) Ltd. File No. 5390/Proposal No. SIA/UP/NCP/ 49682/2020**

The SEAC observed that the project is categorized under B-1 category according to the provision of EIA Notification, 2006 (as amended thereof). A clarification has been issued by the MoEF&CC, O.M. dated 30/12/2019 wherein the Ministry has directed that "in respect of the cases where applications were received but not yet taken for SEAC/UTSEAC (class III) may be transferred to Ministry for dealing at central level as per O.M. dated 31/10/2019. Hence, SEAC opined that the project proponent may apply at MoEF&CC as per MoEF&CC, O.M. dated 31/10/2019, thus the project file was closed.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to defer the matter on request of project proponent for next SEAC meeting.

  
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3. "Ekta Kunj Township" plotting development at Gird Locality of District- Gonda, U.P., M/s Samiah International Builders Ltd. Shri Jamil Ahmed. File No. 5317/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 131519/2019



SEIAA noted the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that the complete information regarding final disposal of surplus treated waste water of 615 KLD during monsoon and 674 KLD during non monsoon season has not been submitted. SEIAA opined that complete details regarding the final disposal of treated waste water shall be submitted and the detail maps along with the permission of competent authority to finally dispose-off surplus treated water of 615 KLD during monsoon and 674 KLD during non-monsoon season shall also be submitted. Organic waste converter has been proposed for the project but the proposal of disposing-off biodegradable waste to municipal solid waste site has also been made, Plan to treat and use biodegradable organic waste within the premises and to use the organic manure in green belt development shall be made. SEIAA also opined that upcoming individual projects within the township have to take separate prior environment clearance as per the provision made in EIA notification. Assurance in this regard is to be submitted.

4. "Inaaya Royal Heights" at Plot No.- GH 1/20 & 1/21, Gomti Nagar Extension Scheme, District-Lucknow., M/s Surya Infra Developers. File No. 5319/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/131568/2019

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the project proponent is required to submit structural stability certificate from a competent person from some Government Institution. The matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.

5. Group Housing Project Zodica-II at Plot No.-2B/GH-8, Vrindavan Yojana, No.-2, Phase-II, District- Lucknow, U.P. Shri Manoj Aggarwal. File No. 5320/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/131754/2019

SEIAA noted the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that the complete information regarding final disposal of surplus treated waste water during monsoon and during non-monsoon season has not been submitted. SEIAA opined that complete details regarding the final disposal of treated waste water shall be submitted and the detail maps along with the permission of competent authority to finally dispose-off surplus treated water during monsoon and non-monsoon season shall also be submitted. SEIAA also found that the project proponent has submitted a proposal for development of green belt on an area of 10.27% to that of total plot area which is not adequate. SEIAA opined that 15% area of the total plot area shall be compulsorily made available for the green area development including the peripheral green area. Revised plan for green area of minimum 15% shall be submitted in this regard.

6. Commercial Complex at Plot No.-TC-A-1, Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, District- Lucknow, U.P., M/s Purvanchal Projects Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5344/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/133859/2019

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

1. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
2. The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
3. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
4. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
5. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
6. The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to municipal sewer line.
7. The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
8. The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks/ designed ecosystems.
9. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.

- 2- The Online Emission/ effluent Monitoring system shall be installed and data shall be communicated online to UPPCB/MOEF&CC.



1. All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed both by the consultant and project proponent both. Form-1 submitted by project proponent is unsigned. It should be signed by the applicant.
  2. Presentation made by the project proponent/authorized signatory Shri. Brij Narian Mishra along with their consultant on 24/10/2019, 06/11/2019 and 06/02/2020 respectively, the signature on attendance sheet made by Shri. Brij Narian Mishra on 06/02/2020 and that of signature made on information sheet submitted while during the presentation on the day do not match with the previous days. Clarification in this regard should be submitted.
  3. The project has been submitted as a Multi feed of 100 KLPD (60 KLPD Molasses and 40 KLPD Grain) Distillery. Project proponent shall clarify, whether feeding of molasses and grain will be at the same time in the distillery to meet the required production of 100 KLPD per day or 60 KLD and 40 KLD distillation plant with the feed of molasses and grain respectively will be installed or some other mechanism is to proposed to adopt. This should be clarified and changed accordingly in the EIA report and form-1 while submitting the signed copy.
