





The proposed project is under Red/Orange category of industrial Sectors and appears to exist in the Critically Polluted Industrial Areas (CPAs)/Severely Polluted Industrial areas (SPAs) as notified by MoEF&CC, Govt of India. The present project is categorized under B1 category according to the provisions of EIA notification 14 September, 2006 (As amended thereof), the project was appraised by SEAC in its 425th meeting held on 11/10/2019, wherein, the proposed project have been recommended for grant of Environment clearance to SEIAA for further consideration. The SEIAA kept this project on hold and sought clarification from the MoEF& CC, Gol. regarding grant of Environment Clearance of the proposed project in light of MoEF&CC, OM dated 31/10/2019. A clarification has been issued by the MoEF&CC, OM dated 30/12/2019 wherein, the ministry has directed that the cases where partial deliberations or complete deliberations were made by SEAC or UTEAC, as the case may be (Class- II), the deliberation may be completed keeping in view of the additional conditions by the SEAC or UTEAC, as the case may be, and sent to the ministry for comments. If the comments were not received within 15 days from the communication, may be deemed as accepted and disposed based on the recommendations of the SEAC.

In light of the above the case was reviewed and SEIAA decided to agree with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

1. Since the proposed project falls in Critically Polluted Areas (CPAs), Severely Polluted Areas (SPAs) the provision of the mechanism formed regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order in OA 1038/2018 dated 19-08-2019 by MoEF& CC, Govt. Of India vide letter

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


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
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dated 31-10-2019 shall be followed in letter and spirit.

2. All the additional condition for grant of Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) related to Pollution mitigation measures as prescribed in the office memorandum of MoEF&CC, Gol. dated 31.10.2019 and as deemed fit by UP Pollution Control Board in the consent orders shall be followed by Project Proponent.
3. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
4. The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
5. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
6. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
7. The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
8. The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to municipal sewer line.







The present project is categorized under B1 category according to the provisions of EIA notification 14 September, 2006 (As amended thereof), the project was appraised by SEAC in its 407th meeting held on 01/07/2019, wherein, the proposed project have been recommended for grant of Environment Clearance. The SEIAA kept this project on hold and sought clarification from the MoEF&CC, Gol regarding grant of Environment Clearance of the proposed project in view of MoEF&CC, OM dated 31.10.2019. A clarification has been issued by the MoEF&CC, OM dated 30/12/2019 wherein, the ministry has directed that the cases which are already recommended by SEAC/UTEAC as the case may be, SEIAA may prescribe the additional condition as per the OM dated 31/10/2019 and may disposed off accordingly.

SEIAA noted that the project was taken in its meeting dated 20/07/2019 and 04/11/2019 wherein SEIAA asked for details regarding disposal of untreated unused/unrecycled waste water into CSTP of GDA and also compliance report of MoEF (since it is an expansion project). Project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 07/09/2019 and letter dated 20/11/2019 along with the compliance report of MoEF and acknowledgement slip of GDA regarding disposal of surplus waste water. SEIAA gone through the reply and noted that the acknowledgment slip of GDA submitted mentions disposal of surplus treated waste water into sewer line. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent shall install the STP of 686 KLD capacity for treatment of total waste water generated i.e 572 KLD.

In light of the above the case was reviewed and SEIAA decided to agree with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-





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In light of the above fact SEIAA reviewed the case and opined to seek report of RO UPPCB, Noida whether the present project is inside or within 05 km of CPA/SPA Noida.

1. Sand/Morrum Mining along Ken Riverbed in Gata No.-176mi, 172ga, 182 and 187 at Village-Amlorkhadar, Tehsil-Pailani, District-Banda, U.P., Shri Vipul Tyagi , (Leased Area-25.29 Ha). File No. 4670/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 31379/2019

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in 442nd SEAC meeting dated 06/01/2020 in which the SEAC has seen the digital map of this lease area prepared by SEIAA Secretariat and did not find any shortcoming in grant of EC of this project. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of 429th SEAC Meeting Dated 05/11/2019 to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions adding two specific condition as follows:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.

2. Ordinary Soil Excavation at Gata No.-4936, Village- Kantha, Tehsil- Purwa, District- Unnao, U.P., (Leased Area-1.329 Ha). File No. 5291/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/128895/2019

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in 446th SEAC meeting dated 15/01/2020 in which SEAC has recommended to grant EC along with general and specific condition SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific conditions no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate". And adding one condition:- The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.

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
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


3. Proposed Common Hazardous waste treatment storage and disposal facility (CHW-TSDF), located at Khata Number- 941, 942 and 944, Village- Kharpadi, Tehsil- Hasanpur, District- Amroha, U.P., M/s Sangam Mediserve Pvt. Ltd. File No. 4484/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/29081/2018

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in 444th SEAC meeting dated 08/01/2020 in which SEAC has recommended to grant EC along with general and specific condition. SEIAA gone through the letter of project proponent dated 27/01/2020 regarding correction in 444th SEAC meeting minutes. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding two specific condition as follows:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. The unit shall strictly comply with the CPCB guidelines for setting up the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF).
3. Proponent shall strictly comply the design criteria for incinerator, autoclave, shedder and all other requirements including bar-coding etc. as per the CPCB guidelines.
4. The unit shall strictly ensure mercury waste management at health care facility as per the CPCB guidelines.
5. The unit shall establish Standard Operating Procedure for waste collection, handling transportation, treatment and disposal as per Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016.
6. Zero Liquid Discharge (ZLD) status shall be maintained all the time.
7. The project proponent shall comply with the Environmental standards notified by MoEF&CC for incinerators along with the technology/guidelines.
8. The unit shall develop 33% of plot area as a green belt within premises as per the CPCB guidelines.
9. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
