Minutes of the 546th Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 27.12.2021

The meeting of 546th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on 27.12.2021 at the Directorate of Environment. Following were present in the meeting:-

Nodal Officer, SEIAA-UP informed that in light of minutes of the meeting of joint meeting of SEIAA, SEAC-1 & SEAC-2 held on 22.06.2021, minutes of the below meeting appraised by SEAC-2 have been vetted by SEAC-1.

Nodal Officer SEIAA placed before SEIAA agenda approved by MS, SEIAA and files and documents related to below mentioned projects.

Agenda-A: -Complaints/letters –

SEIAA examined the application. Documents as required in Form-7 (online application form prescribed by MoEFCC, Gol for transfer of EC) have not been uploaded / submitted by PP/consultant. PP /consultant to submit required documents for examination of application at SEIAA.

2. **Proposed Riverbed Sand/Morrum Mining Project from Ken River of M/s Chaudhary Int Udyog located at Gata No. 04 (Block-17), Village-Sadi Khadar, Tehsil- Pailani, District- Banda, U. P. Lease Area-13 Ha File No. 4335/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/29573/2018**

SEIAA examined the application. Documents as required in Form-7 (online application form prescribed by MoEFCC, Gol for transfer of EC) have not been uploaded / submitted by PP /consultant. PP / consultant to submit required documents for examination of application at SEIAA

3. **Sand Mining at Khand No-31, Village- Paranipur-III (from tower of high-tension line up to constructing tower of high tension line) & Kandla Mawaiya (Ganga River), Tehsil- Meja/ Handiya, Prayagraj, Smt. Shakuntla, Area 5.0 Ha. File No. 6691/Proposal No. SIA/UP/ MIN/239863/2021**

SEIAA gone through the undated letter of Shri Maheep Singh regarding cluster certificate issued for the above project. SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its

542nd meeting in which EC was granted but the letter to this effect has not been issued. Hence SEIAA opined to refer the above letter to Directorate of Geology & Mining, UP and DM, Prayagraj for clarification/comments. EC will be issued only after receiving clarification / comments from either Department.

Agenda-B: -Replies-

1. **Expansion of Existing Sugar unit from 4600 TCD TO 6600 TCD (Earlier we filed an application for Expansion from 4600 TCD to 5500 TCD) at Village- Agwanpur, Moradabad, U.P, M/s Dewan Sugar Ltd. File No. 5010/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/184839/2019**

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 532nd meeting in which SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit details of waste water discharge point, modification proposed shall be highlighted clearly, details of boiler as storage facility and handling of boiler ash shall be submitted by project proponent. The project proponent has submitted his reply. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of 589th SEAC meeting dated 18.11.2021 to grant EC to the above project.

Agenda-C: (I) Minutes of 598th SEAC-2 Meeting Dated 30/11/2021

1. **Sand Mining from Ghaghra Riverbed at Gata No.-Gha, Block No.-04, Village-Ratanpura, Teshsil-Gola, Gorakhpur., M/s Aarchis Enterprises, Lease Area: 5.0 Ha. File No. 6410/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 216502/2021**

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 539th meeting in which SEIAA opined that the above project will be taken in the next meeting since the file was not available during the meeting. SEIAA gone through file and documents and agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

1. Validity period of this EC is co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier.
2. In the absence of replenishment study, keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State, initially EC will be operational for a period of one year from the date of issuance and permissible quantity and area shall be strictly limited to quantity and area mentioned in Lol or mining plan, whichever is lesser, and maximum mineable depth will be limited to as approved in the mining plan.
3. For subsequent years, Project Proponent shall submit fresh annual replenishment study to SEIAA, UP for amendment in EC for mineable quantity and maximum permissible depth for mining based on scientific findings of replenishment study. Such study shall be

placed before SEAC for appraisal for next three years to assess rate of deposition and accordingly, mineable production capacity and depth can be prescribed based on trends analysis, provided it is found scientifically satisfactory by the SEAC. The placing of the study report SEAC is mandatory for initial three years.

4. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
5. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 5,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
7. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 25 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
8. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.

1. This EC is co-terminus with validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier.
 2. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.



3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. Three tier green shelter belt of 7.5m width should be developed on the periphery of mine lease area. Local and native species should be planted in consultation with Forest/Horticulture Department/Agriculture University.
6. Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
7. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
