SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to amend the environmental clearance letter no. 532/PARYA/SEAC /4214/2018 dated 27/11/2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the project proponent also informed that they have proposed to add Hot Air Generator and 10 TPH Coal along with Diesel. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the plan to mitigate increased air pollution.

There was difference of opinion.

Chairman SEIAA opined that since this is a violation project and came up before SEIAA in its meeting no. 497th dated 04.10.2021 and even when the minutes of the said meeting were under examination of Chairman, SEIAA, ToR to the said project was issued. Chairman, SEIAA vide letter no. 9/CH/SEIAA-UP/2021 dated 28.10.2021, detailing that in light of various facts ToR issued to said project vide letter no. 211/Parya/SEIAA/6467/2019 dated 07.10.2021 needs to be withdrawn, but it seems that this has not been done. ToR issued to the said project should be withdrawn immediately.

Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, GoI through minutes of the meeting (circulated through email on 27.11.2021) held on 12.11.2021 under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary, MoEFCC, GoI para 5(iv) clearly states "As on date the SEIAA may not process any violation cases as per the provisions of SoP dated 7th July 2021 as it has been interim stayed by the Madurai Bench of the High Court of Madras in the matter W.P.(MD) No. 11757 of 2021 titled Fatima Vs Union of India." In light of above directions from MoEFCC, GoI SEIAA decided to defer the project.

SEIAA opined that Chairman, Members and Nodal Officers of both the SEACs need to be made aware of current status regarding processing of violation cases. Further, a reference should be made to MS, UPSPCB, DM, Lucknow and VC, LDA that no construction should take place without valid EC and legal proceedings should be initiated against the project proponent.

Member Secretary/Member SEIAA decided to defer the project in the light of minutes of meeting of MoEFCC, GoI dated 12.11.2021.

The project proponent has been advised to resubmit the proposal after considering all the features. This project application is closed and directed to apply afresh application.
