
SEIAA noted that this project has been granted EC in 338th SEIAA meeting dated 27/01/2020. Hence no further action is required.

3. Integrated Township at Naini, District-Prayagraj, U.P. M/s Prayagraj Development Authority. File No. 5288/4539/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 47377/2018

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue Environmental Clearance to the project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that 1842 KLD of water is proposed to be used and that 1355 KLD of waste water is mentioned to be generated which will be discharged to CSTP of ADA for treatment. No recycling or reuse of treated waste water is proposed and fresh water is mentioned to be used for horticulture, flushing etc which is not acceptable. SEIAA noted that project proponent has submitted the proposal for treatment of waste water and its reuse/recycle with form-I for which ToR was issued. SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit the proposal for reuse/recycle of treated waste water for horticulture, flushing (with the proposal of dual plumbing system) etc. Project proponent shall also submit the details about CSTP of ADA, its installed capacity and capacity available to treat waste water of the project, along with its functional status.

SEIAA noted that this project has been granted EC in 337th SEIAA meeting dated 24/01/2020. Hence no further action is required.






SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close the file as the project proponent did not appear and and agreed to reopen only after submission of online request on prescribed portal.




The SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

1. All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
2. Copy of all the analysis reports signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
3. MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
4. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
5. Public hearing is to be conducted as per EIA notification,2006 (as amended).


SEIAA agreed with recommendation of SEAC and opined that being located in CPA/SPA and being in B1 category, according to the provisions of EIA notification, 2006(as amended thereof) the project is to be appraised at the central level, if not taken by SEAC/UTSEAC as per MoEF&CC, OM of dated 30/12/2019.




SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue Environmental Clearance to the project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and found that in general and specific condition no. X(7) it is mentioned that:-

"The project proponent allows the treated effluent to be discharged in the ambient environment only after exhausting options for reuse in order to minimize freshwater usage. (in case of the large scale tanneries in sensitive/critical areas-implement Zero Liquid Discharge)"

SEIAA opined that the condition is confusing and is not clear about the disposal of treated water/ZLD and hence the project shall be referred back to SEAC for clear recommendation for this particular project.
