
SEAC Resolution 24/2:


The proposal asking EC for mining of brick earth from “M/S UDI Bricks Industry MPA” under Kamrup West Division, Bamunigaon proposed by M/S UDI Bricks Industry is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. The committee scrutinized the documents furnished by the proponent. Approved mining plan and recommendation of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer are also discussed. The committee after due deliberation recommended the proposal for approval of EC to excavate 3000 cu.m. brick earth from the proposed location within a period of two years subject to the condition that the mining depth is restricted to two meters. Similarly, it is approved to extract 1500 cu.m. brick earth annually strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.


The Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup West Division is requested to arrange to mark the site on the ground before allowing mining activities so that mining is permitted only at the approved site. She is also requested to ensure due surveillance to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period.

2. **Proposal of EC for collection of Ordinary Earth/Silt from “Sagalchara Pt.II Ordinary Earth/Silt MPA” under Dhubri Forest Division proposed by Abul Kalam SEIAA.1797/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/219728/2020)**

SEAC Resolution 24/3:

The proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary earth /silt from “*Sagalchara Pt.II Ordinary Earth/Silt MPA*” under Dhubri Division proposed by Abul Kalam is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. The committee scrutinized the documents furnished by the proponent. Approved mining plan and recommendation of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer, Dhubri Division are also discussed. The committee after due deliberation recommended the proposal for approval of *EC to excavate 26500 cu.m ordinary earth/silt from the proposed location within a period of two years*. 

4. **Proposal of EC for extraction of Ordinary Clay/ River Silt from “Panikhaity Ghat Ordinary Clay/River Silt MPA” under Kamrup East Division proposed by M/S Shivam GDCL (JV) SEIAA.1780/2021, (SIA/AS/MIS/210012/2021)**

SEAC Resolution 24/5:

The proposal asking EC for mining of Ordinary Clay/River Silt from “Panikhaity Ghat Ordinary Clay / River Silt MPA” under Kamrup East Division proposed by M/S Shivam GDCL (JV) is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail discussion. Scrutinized the documents furnished by the proponent in support of their proposal. Detail deliberation is held and the committee considering the approved mining plan as well as the indent of the Asstt. EE, Guwahati Division 1, PHE Deptt. recommended the proposal approving to extract 25000 cu.m. Ordinary clay/river silt from the proposed location within a period of one (1) year. The proponent shall have to strictly follow all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan during the pendency of the mining period.

6. **Proposal of EC for Collection of Ordinary Earth from “Sardargaon Kissam P.P land Ordinary Earth MPA” under Nagaon South Division proposed by Abdur Rahman Barbhuyan SEIAA.1537/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/171778/2020)**

SEAC Resolution 24/7:

The project proposal requesting EC for mining of ordinary earth from “*Sardargaon Kissam P.P land Ordinary Earth MPA*” under Nagaon South Division proposed by Abdur Rahman Barbhuyan is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail. Detailed scrutiny of the documents furnished by the proponent is made. Discussion is held on the approved mining plan and recommendation of the concerned DFO. The committee after due deliberation recommended approving the proposal to extract 1000 cu.m. ordinary earth from the proposed location within a period of two years subject to the condition that mining depth should not exceed two meters from the unmined surface. 500 cu.m of ordinary earth is approved to extract per year strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Karbi Anglong East Division will ensure due monitoring on the mining operation to avoid occurrence of irregularities during the mining period. The Divisional Forest Officer, Karbi Anglong East Division is requested to redesign the aforesaid mining area for future mining activities as from the current maps etc. it appears that the location is not very practicable for such mining.

SEAC Resolution 24/9:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of river clay from “Bharalumukh Ghat Brahmaputra River Clay MPA” under Kamrup East Division proposed by M/S S.P Singla Pvt. Ltd. is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail discussion. Scrutinized the necessary documents furnished in support of the project proposal. Detailed deliberation is held in the meeting. Considering the urgency of the Govt. works quoted by the Executive Engineer, PWRD, Brahmaputra Bridge Construction Division the committee recommended for approval of the proposal to extract 83220 cu.m river clay/silt from the proposed location within two years subject to the condition that the proponent shall have to submit detail transport plan for the mined-out materials to the Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup East Division before starting the actual mining activities. Since the proposed site falls within the limit of the city so all precautionary measures are to be adopted by the proponent while transporting the mining materials to avoid air and other such pollution. In the meeting it is also approved to extract 41610 cu.m. river clay/silt per year strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Kamrup East Division is requested to approve the transport plan which is to be furnished by the proponent before starting the actual mining activities ensuring to reduce the scope of pollution. He will also ensure due surveillance to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. Further, he will arrange to mark the proposed site on the ground prior to actual mining activities.

The project proposal asking extension of EC for mining of ordinary earth from “Ghiladhari Ordinary Earth Mahal” under Sonitpur East Division proposed by Sri Bedananda Dasis placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail discussion. Scrutinized the documents submitted in support of the proposal followed by detail discussion. after due deliberation the committee recommended the proposal *approving extension of EC for another two years (validity till 23rd Feb. 2023) for extraction of 2000 cu.m ordinary earth/clay from the proposed site. Annual extractable quantity of mining material is approved 2000 cu.m ordinary earth/clay.* The proponent shall have to adhere to all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Sonitpur East Division will ensure strict surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure that the terms and condition impose is strictly complied by the proponent in course of mining operation




