**C. CONSIDERATION OF TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR EIA STUDY FOR MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS OF LEASE AREA 25 HA. OR LESS (INCLUDING THE CLUSTER APPROACH):**

1. The SEAC in its meeting held on 17.11.2020 decided that the appraisal for issue of ToRs for the minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) may be considered with specific ToRs as suggested by SEAC as well as standard ToRs based on merit of the proposal without presentation.
2. The SEIAA, Odisha has forwarded 03 online EC applications of minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) as per **Annexure-C**.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC decided to forward such 03 online EC applications to SEIAA, Odisha with a request to issue specific ToRs as suggested by SEAC as well as standard ToRs to these 03 proposals for conducting EIA study.

**D. PREPARATION OF MINING PLAN AS PER ENFORCEMENT & MONITORING GUIDELINES FOR SAND MINING, JANUARY, 2020 OF MOEF&CC, GOVT. OF INDIA:**

The MoEF&CC, Govt. of India prepared Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining in January, 2020. Para 4.3 of the guidelines stipulate preparation of mining plan and important aspects to be considered while approving mining plan for sand mining. The SEAC observed that most of the mining plans of sand mining have been prepared and approved without incorporating the important points as pointed out in the para 4.3 of the guidelines.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC recommended that the SEIAA, Odisha may consider to request the concerned Department in Govt. (i.e. Revenue and Disaster Management Department and Steel and Mines Department) to issue necessary instructions for preparation of mining plan as per para 4.3 of Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India.
