


Ltd.,” has submitted application Form1, Form 1A for obtaining Environment Clearance for the proposed construction of Multi Speciality Hospital &amp; Research Institute with built up area of 37685 sq.m. at North Vellore No. 9, Ward No. 1, T.S.no. 27, 28 etc., Vellore North Town Village, Vellore Taluk, Vellore District on 29.08.2016.</p> <p>The Committee observed that the above project comes under Item No 8(a) of the Schedule .Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the SEAC Committee decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA , subject to the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Details regarding Batch Decontamination system shall be elaborated.</li> <li>2. The proponent shall obtain details of source of water from Vellore Corporation and the quality of water to be supplied for the residents.</li> <li>3. Revised rain water harvesting and storm water drainage based on the peak flow rainfall for the proposed site. Also furnish details on what percentage is recharged into the surface and the quantity of excess goes off from the proposed site.</li> <li>4. Details on the onsite collection, segregation, handling and disposal of Bio Medical Solid waste from the proposed hospital.</li> <li>5. The Proponent shall commit that they shall follow the Biomedical waste Management Rules, 2016.</li> <li>6. The Proponent shall commit that the two channels inside the project site shall be connected to the existing storm water drain along the road.</li> </ol> |
