True Value Homes "TVH Entelechy" has applied for modification in Environment Clearance for the Proposed modification for the construction of Multi-storeyed Residential Complex at S.F.No's. 7/80, 7/81, 8/14 of Adyar Village, Kotturpuram, Mambalam – Guindy Taluk, Chennai District.</p> <p>The Committee observed that the above project comes under Item No 8 (a) of the Schedule. A certificate from a competent Revenue Authority to certify that the project proposed will not be affected by the possible floods in future, with reference to the basement levels proposed by the proponent. 2. A certificate from the competent Revenue authority to certify that the project proposed has not encroached any water body, river, stream, canal, tanks, etc., from its original boundary as per the government records. 3. A certificate from a competent Government institution like Anna University, IIT, SERC to certify that the structural design is safe with reference to the Environmental conditions prevailing at the site and also with reference to possible floods in the future. <p>On perusal of the certificates/ documents as and when submitted by the proponent, the SEAC will take appropriate decision on merit regarding</p>







1. The Proponent has approached the concerned government departments and the matter is being followed in getting the certificate. He has promised that the certificate will be produced at the earliest.
2.	A certificate from a competent Revenue Authority to certify that the project proposed has not encroached any water body, river, stream, canal, tanks, etc., from its original boundary as per the government records.	A satisfied certificate has been produced.
