

**PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL EXPERT APPRAISAL  
COMMITTEE, ODISHA HELD ON 02<sup>ND</sup> SEPTEMBER, 2022**

The SEAC met on 02<sup>nd</sup> September, 2022 at 10:30 AM in the Conference Hall of Odisha State Pollution Control Board, Bhubaneswar under the Chairmanship of Sri B. P. Singh. The following members were present in the meeting.

The following issues were discussed and decision taken:

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**A. CONSIDERATION OF MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS (NEW):**

The committee verified 40 nos. of minor mineral proposals forwarded by the SEIAA, Odisha on the basis of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India OM no. F. No. L-I 1011/175/2018-IA-II (M), dated 12.12.2018. The case-wise proceedings and observations of the committee are detailed in Table as per **Annexure – A**. The proposals of following categories are:

**B. CONSIDERATION OF MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS (COMPLIANCE RECEIVED):**

The committee verified 01 no. of minor mineral proposals (compliance received) on the basis of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India OM no. F. No. L-I 1011/175/2018-IA-II (M), dated 12.12.2018. The case-wise proceedings and observations of the committee are detailed in Table as per **Annexure – B**. The proposals of following categories are:

**C. CONSIDERATION OF TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR EIA STUDY FOR MINOR MINERAL PROPOSALS OF LEASE AREA 25 HA. OR LESS (INCLUDING THE CLUSTER APPROACH):**

1. The SEAC in its meeting held on 17.11.2020 decided that the appraisal for issue of ToRs for the minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) may be considered with specific ToRs as suggested by SEAC as well as standard ToRs based on merit of the proposal without presentation.
2. The SEIAA, Odisha has forwarded 10 online EC applications of minor mineral proposals of lease area 25 ha. or less (including cluster approach) as per **Annexure-C**.
3. The MoEF&CC, Govt. of India vide circular no. F.No. IA 3 – 22/15/2022 – IA-III (computer no. 178038), dated 06.05.2022 issued mechanism for handling ToRs applications for issuing standard ToRs.

After detailed discussion, the SEAC opined that ToRs including specific ToRs for conducting EIA study may be issued as per decision taken in the SEAC meeting held on 17.11.2020 with following two additional specific ToRs.

- (i) Preparation of revised mining plan based on essential physical criteria as per Enforcement and Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining, January 2020 of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India enclosed as **Appendix - A (In case of Sand Mining)**.
- (ii) Lay out of Progressive Mine Closure Plan shall also be incorporated in the Revised Mining Plan” (**in case of Stone & Other Mine**).

**D. APPRAISAL OF DISTRICT SURVEY REPORTS (DSRs) OF DISTRICTS – MAYURBHANJ AND GANJAM:**

- i) The need for District Survey Report (DSR) have been necessitated by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) vide their Notification No. S.O. 141 (E), dated 15<sup>th</sup> January 2016. The notification was addressed to bring certain amendments with respect to the EIA notification 2006 and in order to have a better control over the legislation. District level committees have been introduced in the system. As a part of this notification, preparation of District Survey Reports has been introduced.
- ii) The MoEF&CC in compliance of the Hon’ble Supreme Court’s and NGT’S order has prepared “Sustainable Sand Mining Guidelines (SSMG), 2016” in consultation with State governments, detailing the provisions on Environmental Clearance (EC) for cluster, creation of District Environment Impact Assessment Authority, preparation of District survey report and proper monitoring of minor mineral.
- iii) Subsequently, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has published Notification No. 3611 (E), dt. 25th July, 2018 regarding inclusion of the “Minerals Other than Sand” and format for preparation of the DSR has been specified. The notification

stated about the objective of DSR i.e. "Identification of areas of aggradations or deposition where mining can be allowed; and identification of areas of erosion and proximity to infrastructural structures and installations where mining should be prohibited and calculation of annual rate of replenishment and allowing time for replenishment after mining in that area".

- iv) Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining (EMGSM) January 2020 has been published modifying Sustainable sand Mining Guidelines, 2016 by MoEF&CC for effective enforcement of regulatory provisions and their monitoring. The EMGSM 2020 directed the states to carry out river audits, put detailed survey reports of all mining areas online and in the public domain, conduct replenishment studies of river beds, constantly monitor mining with drones, aerial surveys, ground surveys and set up dedicated task forces at district levels. The guidelines also push for online sales and purchase of sand and other river bed materials to make the process transparent. They propose night surveillance of mining activity through night- vision drones.
- v) The Hon'ble NGT in O. A. No. 360/2015- NGT Bar Association Vrs. Virender Singh (State of Gujarat) & O. A. No. 173/2018 - Sudarshan Das Vrs. State of West Bengal & Ors issued the following directions to the States:
- As the DEIAA is not functioning as a consequence of the decision of the Tribunal in Satendra Pandey (supra) case, the DSR shall be prepared through consultants accredited by the National Accreditation Board of Education and Training/ Quality Control Council of India in terms of O.M. of MoEF&CC, Govt. of India dated 16.03.2010.
  - The DSR so prepared shall be submitted to the District Magistrate who shall verify the DSR only in respect of the relevant facts pertaining to the physical and geographical features of the district which shall be distinct from the scientific findings based on the parameters prescribed in the SSMMG- 2016. After such verification, the District Magistrate shall forward the DSR for examination and evaluation by the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) having regarding to the fact.
  - The SEAC after appraisal of the report shall forward it to the SEIAA for consideration and approval if it meets all scientific/technical requirements.
  - While preparing the DSR, the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Accredited Agency/Consultant shall scrupulously follow the procedure and the parameters laid down under the SSMMG-2016 and EMGSM - 2020 read in sync with each other."
- vi) The order of the Hon'ble NGT clearly specifies that DSR to be prepared by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Accredited Agency/Consultant and sent to the SEIAA by the technical appraisal by the SEAC.
- vii) The DSRs of Mayurbhanj and Ganjam Districts as forwarded by the SEIAA to SEAC have not been prepared by the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Accredited Agency/ Consultant.
- viii) The SEAC opined that the order of the Hon'ble NGT is silent about the applicability of preparation of DSR by NABET Accredited Consultants for all the minor minerals or only for sand mines as the matter dealt in Hon'ble NGT Order is related to Sand Mines only. **The SEIAA, Odisha may consider to seek legal views and / or clarification from MoEF&CC, Govt. of India in this regard to come to a conclusion.** Accordingly, the SEIAA may take decision on minor mineral cases other than sands without sending to SEAC for appraisal.

- ix) Since, the DSRs of Mayurbhanj and Ganjam Districts are not prepared by NABET/ QCI accredited consultant/ agency, SEAC is not authorized to make appraisal of the same as per para - v above.
- x) **However, the SEAC opined that the SEIAA, Odisha may decide if such DSRs as received from Mayurbhanj and Ganjam will be considered for implementation even when the same has not been prepared by the NABET Accredited Consultants. However, If decided to consider for implementation, the following may be incorporated district wise as observed by the SEAC.**

**a) DISTRICT SURVEY REPORT (DSR) OF MAYURBHANJ DISTRICT (SAND MINING):**

- DSR of Mayurbhanj District forwarded is prepared and approved by DEIAA on 28 th December, 2019.
- This DSR is not prepared by any agency accredited by QCI/ NABET.
- This DSR contains only Sand Mining, no other minor minerals.
- It speaks about revenue/ royalty received from sand mining in last three days 2016-17, 17-18 & 18-19 for 26 Tahasils, but data furnished pertains to FY 2019-20, 20-21 & 21-22 in the Annexure which might not have been examined by DEIAA.
- Out of 26 Tahasils, the production is Zero in three Tahasils, namely, Khunta, Bisoi Bijataala.
- 9 Major Rivers are flowing in this district namely, Budhabalanga, Baitarani that cover about 45 percent of the area drained.
- Availability of sand or Gravel or aggregate resources in terms of geological resources and mineable resources in volume has been furnished without any scientific back up as to how they are arrived at. It is stated that mineable mineral potential is 60 percent of the total mineral potential, but the basis of which has not been indicated.
- The mineral potential of 21 rivers or streams has been furnished out of which it is NIL in case of 4 rivers, namely, Gangadhar, Kantamauli, Jhagada and Balijon.
- Process of deposition of sediments in 2016 -17 to 18-19 is stated to be "Moderate/ slow" and it is NIL in case of 2 rivers, the basis of which is also not known.
- It is stated that geological study carried out during field observations that can be considered for mining concession, but the backup & basis is absent.
- Out of 120 sand mining identified, 49 are working and rest are non- working, the reasons of which are not stated.
- While informations like name of the river/ stream, portion of the river, average length & width of the area, distance of nearest railway/ road bridge to recommend for mineral concession are indicated, all other essential physical features, both upstream and down stream, essential in terms of guidelines of MOEF& CC' 2020 are not available.
- Rate of replenishment of sand in the stretch of river where the same is located is under progress and will be submitted in December '22-23. This is stated in the forwarded DSR.
- In absence of Replenishment study and inference on RF as per the guidelines of MOEF & CC, it is not possible to consider the informations furnished for appraisal.
- Methodology of Replenishment study prepared by SEAC be communicated to the concerned in order to facilitate for undertaking the desired study.

b) **DISTRICT SURVEY REPORT (DSR) OF GANJAM DISTRICT (ROAD METAL / BUILDING STONE / BLACK STONE / DECORATIVE STONE / MOORUM / BRICK EARTH):**

- The report has been prepared by District Administration and approved by DEIAA consisting of four members namely; Sub-collector Chhatrapur cum Secretary DEIAA, Prof. K.C. Patnaik Expert Member, DFO Berhampur and Collector & DM Ganjam.
- Report is silent on methodology adopted, public consultation/ report in public domain. No expert/ consultant has been involved in preparation of draft. No scientific method/ tools such as remote sensing/ aerial Photographs/ drone technology, Ground trothing/verification or field survey has been used. Report is a compilation of leases granted and Sairat sources identified by revenue department. Hence there exist much scope of improvement using technology.
- Mineral reserves have been estimated but basis of estimation has not been mentioned. Methodology followed in estimation is also not mentioned.
- General mitigation measures for air/ water/ noise pollution have been furnished. Mine closure by either filling or conversion to water body mentioned. Green belt as provided by SPCB in their consent order is stated to be followed. Sense of sustainable and safe extraction, reduction in erosion, mine closure in phased manner, commitment for returning the mined out area in better form for future generation appear absent in the report.
- Report has neither been kept in public domain for suggestions nor discussed thoroughly for safety measures and improvement in technology for environmental amelioration.
- District general profile, topography, rainfall, drainage pattern, Land utilization pattern, mining overview, geology and mineral wealth, etc., have been furnished with revenue earned from 2014-15 to 2018-19. Production data has not been given but mineral utilized by different departments in different years has been given. Close monitoring of mining activities which is need of time has neither been discussed nor has any mechanism been suggested /provided.
- Transport pattern/ timing and safety with improvement in technology has also not found its place in report.
- The report appears provisional with much scope for improvement by using technology and engagement of competent accredited consultant/expert.

**DISTRICT SURVEY REPORT (DSR) OF GANJAM DISTRICT (SAND):**

- DSR of Ganjam District for Road metal/Building stone/Black stone/Decorative Stone/Moorum/Brick earth has been copied and submitted by changing cover page. It needs to be thoroughly revised and sand extraction/ proposed related data needs to be furnished.


