1. Transfer of EC of Proposed river bed Sand Mining from Yamuna River at Gata No. 10/25 & 10/26, Village-Kataiya, Tehsil-Chail, District- Kaushambi, U.P. (Leased Area-24.28 ha) Transfer EC 3980 dated 22-10-2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 12.11.2021 in which SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 136/Parya/SEAC/3980/2017 date 30.01.2018 from Shri Abdul Samad S/o Shri Abdul Quyyum, 151/165, Village Pura Manohardas, Akbarpur, GTV Nagar, Allahabad to M/s Ras Indica Pvt. Ltd. Shri Ajay Chandak S/o Shri Madanlal Chandak, Block BHN 38, Amohga Marg, Hanuman Nagar, Jaipur for six months and 1,80,000 m³ capacity, with the condition that the EC will not be transferred further and after 6 months the EC will be null and void. Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 136/Parya/SEAC /3980/2017 date 30.01.2018 shall remain same.

SEIAA opined to add that area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

SEIAA opined to add that area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

SEIAA noted that the above project was granted ToR in its 514th meeting dated 13.11.2021.

SEIAA noted that the above project was granted ToR in its 514th meeting dated 13.11.2021.

3. Stone Mining at Arazi No.-02, Si No.- 07, at Village- Sariya, Tehsil-Chunar, Mirzapur., Shri Sanjay Bhai Patel, Area 0.8090 ha. File No. 6465/Proposal No. SIA/UP/ MIN/62538/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was granted ToR in its 514th meeting dated 13.11.2021.

4. Expansion of Residential Complex at Plot No- GH-08A, Tech Zone-IV, Greater Noida, U.P., M/s Habitech Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6325/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 63672/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToR;s to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR:-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- Copy of all the analysis reports duly signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 3- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.

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
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- 4- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
 - 5- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
 - 6- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.
 - 7- Certified compliance report from IRO, MoEF&CC to be submitted along with EIA to SEIAA for evaluation.
5. Construction of Institutional Building at Plot No.- A 45 to A 52 & A 56 to 63, Sector-153, Noida, District- Gautam Budh Nagar, U.P., Shri Sumit Sardana, M/s Rail Vikas Nigam Ltd. File No. 6440/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/211928/2021
- SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that it is mentioned that water requirement shall be met from Noida development authority and tankers. SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit a letter/agreement from Noida development authority, legible copy of building plans and details of green belt. SEIAA also opined that solid waste during construction should go to construction debris plant. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit the above.

- SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and opined that project proponent shall submit the source from where water demand will be met during construction phase and a letter/agreement from Noida development authority, details of disposal of solid waste from warehouse cold storage etc. , details of final discharge of waste water, fresh water requirement, water conservation plan and green belt.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and opined that project proponent shall submit the source from where water demand will be met during construction phase and a letter/agreement from Noida development authority, details of disposal of solid waste from warehouse cold storage etc., details of final discharge of waste water, fresh water requirement, water conservation plan and green belt.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to send a letter to Member Secretary, UPPCB to provide a factual report regarding feasibility / requirement of Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facility at the proposed site.

9. Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility at Khasra No.-2871/0.94, Village- Arazi Amani, Pargana- Gopalpur, Tehsil- Sagri, District- Azamgarh, U.P., M/s Devansh Environmental Solutions. File No. 6495/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/66502/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal.

10. Expansion of Group Housing Colony at Plot No.- GH-A, (GH-6 to GH-13) Housing Sector, Talanagri Industrial Area, Aligarh, U.P., M/s Ozone Promoters Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6498/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/224266/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A reference to DM, Aligarh, MS UPPCB and VC Aligarh Development authority to be made to ensure that no expansion takes place without valid EC and in case expansion has been carried out without valid EC legal action should be initiated against the project proponent.

11. Modernization of Hotel Building to 197 Bedded Multi Specialty Hospital Building at Plot No.- SH-06, Site-IV, Surajpur, Industrial Area, Greater Noida., M/s Ram Ratan Real Estate Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6473/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/222610/2021


SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.









- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharge.
- 7- Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be discharged to municipal sewer line.
- 8- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 9- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
- 10- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
- 11- In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
- 12- If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.

12. Sand/Morrum Mine from Ken River Bed at Khand No.-5137, 5138, 5139, 5140 & 5141, Village-Bhawanipurwa, Tehsil & District-Banda., Shri Narendra Kumar Singh, Area-4.0Ha). File No. 6351/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/208812/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC-2 in its minutes has mentioned that Certificate No. and validity of Consultant is not available which is not a good practice, whereas on examination of file consultant QCI No and period of validity is mentioned as NABET/EIA/2124/1A0086 and September 2024. SEAC-2 is advised to be more careful in future while preparing minutes of the meeting. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project for one year only along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found

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false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

1. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
2. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc..
3. Replenishment study, duly approved by the competent authority for approving DSR for the district should be submitted within one year. In the absence of replenishment study keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State EC is accorded for a period of one year.
4. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
5. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 4,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

SEIAA noted that SEAC has commented that no action is required at the SEAC-1 level. SEIAA is requested to transfer the environmental clearance as requested by the project proponent

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Chandra Kant Tripathi dated 12.03.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 70/Parya(DEIAA)/2017-18 date 30.12.2017. SEIAA gone through file, documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to M/s Tirpathi Constructor Prop. Shri Anand Kumar Tripathi S/o Shri Devi Prasad Tripathi Shobha Singh ka purwa, karwi, District - Chitrakoot. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Anand Kumar Tripathi was cancelled vide DM, Chitrakoot order no. 290/Khanij/2018-19 dated 31.01.2019 and another LOI was issued to Shri Chandra Kant Tripathi S/o Shri Shatru jeet Tripathi, Neuramau Chitrakoot vide letter no. 182/Khanij/2020-21 dated 29.01.2021 for a period of 6 months. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no.

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70/Parya(DEIAA)/2017-18 date 30.12.2017 from M/s Tripathi Constructor Prop. Shri Anand Kumar Tripathi S/o Shri Devi Prasad Tripathi Shobha Singh ka purwa, karwi, District - Chitrakoot to Shri Chandra Kant Tripathi S/o Shri Shatru jeet Tripathi, Neuramau Chitrkoot for six months and 11,620 m³ capacity, with the condition that the EC will not be transferred further and after 6 months the EC will be null and void. Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 70/Parya(DEIAA)/2017-18 date 30.12.2017 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

SEIAA added following additional condition:-

1. If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate.
2. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
4. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Gautam Buddh Nagar and UPPCB to ensure that no construction activity is started until valid EC is obtained.

3. Proposed "Gaur Yamuna City" at Sector-19, Yamuna Expressway, YEIDA, Greater Noida, District-Gautam Buddh Nagar, U.P. File No. 1657 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/178551/2020

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to extend the validity of the Environmental Clearance letter dated 12/10/2013 for 03 years i.e. 12/10/2020 to 11/10/2023. SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit certified compliance report from IRO, MoEF&CC for Environmental Clearance letter no. 2093/PARYA /SEAC /1657/2013/JDCA(S) dated 12/10/2013 and the current status of the project.

4. Proposed "Rohit Colonizer Pvt. Ltd.", 681/682, Village - Madiakon, Tehsil- Bakshi Ka Talab, Lucknow, U.P., Shri Narendra Kumar Maurya, Director, M/s Rohit Colonizers Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5938 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/177931/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent requested to defer the matter and will be taken only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. SEIAA opined a letter shall be send to DM, Lucknow and UPPCB to ensure that no construction activity is started until valid EC is obtained.

5. Revision & Expansion of Group Housing "Vilaasa" at Plot No.-GH-01B(2), Sector-ETA-2, Greater Noida, M/s Yamuna Builtech Pvt. Ltd. File No. 5506 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS / 49785/2019

SEIAA noted that the Project Proponent/Consultant submitted an action taken report on the issue raised by MoEF&CC in the certified compliance report. Prima facie the committee is not fully satisfied with the reply of the project proponent/consultant. Because of delay by MoEF&CC, Regional office the committee decided to constitute a committee to visit the site and examine the observation raised in MoEF&CC certified compliance report. Based on the report of the committee appropriate decision will be taken by the committee.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Varanasi and UPPCB to ensure that no mining takes place without valid EC is obtained.

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7. Proposed IT ITES Offices Building at Plot No.- 04, Tech Zone-02, Greater Noida, U.P. File No. 6280 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/62121/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to issue ToR to the above project. The project requires a detailed scrutiny which is not possible through video conferencing. Hence SEIAA opined that this project shall be taken when the meeting is held in person at Directorate of Environment, Lucknow.

8. Sand/ Morrum Mining from Yamuna River Bed at Gata No.- 4, 5, 16, 17, 18, 25, 48 & 56, Village-Ghazipur, Tehsil-Khaga, Fatehpur, U.P., Shri Sunil Kumar, M/s The Sunworld Travels, Area: 15.0 ha. File No. 5733 Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/54711/2020

SEIAA noted that in the minutes of SEAC QCI No and period of validity of Consultant is mentioned as NABET/EIA/1821 RA 0120 Valid till – 19/07/2021 and the project was heard on 07.10.2021 whereas it is valid up to 13.01.2022 hence SEAC should be careful while preparing minutes. SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project for one year only along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding following specific condition as follows:-

1. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
2. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
3. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
4. Replenishment study, duly approved by the competent authority for approving DSR for the district should be submitted within one year. In the absence of replenishment study keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State EC is accorded for a period of one year.
5. 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
