The project proponent has continued with his obligations to the people of the project area and has spent an amount of Rs. 12,64,000 in compliance with its public hearing commitments. The PP has completed plantation cover over 33% of the total project area.

The PP has intimated the SEAC committee that the Bandhamandi Graphite mine is presently not able to provide graphite feed as per proposed capacity of the Laxmipur plant, hence the PP requested to the Committee to consider allowing them to procure graphite feed from other graphite mining leases which are operating with valid EC from MoEF & CC, Govt. of India and to allow import of graphite feed from other counties in addition to the Bandhamandi graphite mines.
