1. **Ordinary Earth Mining Project" at Gata No.- 2476, 2478, 2481, Village- Sikandra Rao Dehat, Tehsil- Sikandra Rao, District- Hathras, Shri Indrajeet Singh, M/s Kunal Beej Bandhar, Area: 1.962 ha., 8467/SIA/UP/MIN/451940/2023.**

SEIAA opined to accept the recommendation of SEAC and grant EC to the said project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC taking into consideration discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022 regarding reply of SEAC-1 and SEAC-2 for compliance/action taken on TOR/Public hearing, adding following specific conditions:-

1. If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate.
2. Validity period of this EC is 3 months from the date of issue as the Lol has been issued for a period of 3 months or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
3. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 19.01.2024 along with CPCB letter dated 30.04.2020 regarding classification of industrial sectors into red orange green and white category. SEIAA opined that the reply submitted by the project proponent shall be send to UPPCB for comments on category of the project.

3. CBWTF at Khasra No.539/3, Village-Makhiyali, Muzafarnagar., Shri Harpal Singh Chawla, M/s Rudra Waste Management (P) Ltd. File No. 5832/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 56459/ 2020

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 732<sup>th</sup> meeting in which SEIAA found that the clear gap analysis has not been submitted only RTI information has been forwarded. Hence SEIAA opined that a letter shall be send to UPPCB for clear report. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 23.01.2024. SEIAA opined that reply submitted by the project proponent shall be send to MS, UPPCB for validation.

SEIAA noted that the above projects were appraised by SEAC on 01.12.2023 that is before 04.12.2023, the date of letter issued by MoEFCC, regarding competent authority for approval of DSR. SEAC had appraised the projects on the basis of DSR approved by authority competent to approve DSR at that time. Based on the appraisal and considering the technicality, the authority decided unanimously that EC may be granted. The matter was again deliberated upon and it was decided unanimously that projects mentioned at serial no. 1, 2 and 3 which were appraised before 04.12.2023, may be granted EC.

SEIAA noted that the above projects were appraised by SEAC on 05.12.2023 and 06.12.2023 that is after 04.12.2023, the date of letter issued by MoEFCC, regarding competent authority for approval of DSR, in which it is mentioned that DSR is to be submitted to SEAC for examination and SEIAA for approval. SEAC had appraised the projects on the basis of DSR approved by authority competent to approve DSR at that time. Based on the appraisal and considering the technicality, the Authority decided unanimously that EC may be granted. The matter was again deliberated upon and it was

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found that DSR has not been submitted by the above District as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended). Hence in light of letter dated 04.12.2023, it was unanimously decided that issuance of EC for projects mentioned at serial no. 1 to 6 may be kept on hold.
