The meeting of 589th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 22.04.2022 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

Nodal Officer SEIAA informed that agenda is prepared by Secretariat and approved by MS SEIAA which is hereby put up for the consideration of SEIAA and placed files and documents related to below mentioned projects before SEIAA.

1. Sand/ Morrum Mining at Khasra No./Gata No.- 61 to 69, 86 to 92, 93 Mi, 94 Mi, 98 Mi, 99 Mi, Village-Gadhiva Majhgawan, Tehsil-Khaga, District-Fatehpur, U.P., M/s Tesmas Treading Pvt. Ltd.. Area: 25 ha File No. 5728/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/54660/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC 2 that the matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.

2. Sand Mining from Yamuna Riverbed at Gata No-212 ,216-224, 232-246, 379, 381-385, 391,392, Khand No.-03, Village- Subhanpur, Tehsil-Khekra, Baghpat. M/s MHG Land Stockiest Pvt. Ltd.- Area-16.0053 Ha. File No. 3894/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/71392/2017

SEIAA noted the comments of SEAC-2 that PP has requested to defer the project as the project proponent did not appear. SEIAA opined to delist the file and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Baghpat to ensure that no mining activity is started until valid EC is obtained and in case mining has been carried out without valid EC then work should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP.



3. Exploratory Drilling of One well in OALP-VI BLOCK, GV-ONHP-2021/2, District- Ballia, U.P., Shri Rajesh Sharma, R/o- I/C HSE, ONGC, Frontier Basins, Ganga Building, Idt Campus, Kaulagarh Road, Dehradun, Uttarakhand File No. 6895/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/252292/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC-2 to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC-2.

4. Sand Mining at Ghaghra River Bed at Gata No. 396/1, Village: Takia Dharahara Khadar, Tehsil: Salempur, District: Deoria, Shri Raj Pratap Yadav, Area: 11.70 Ha, File No. 6905/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/71278/2022

It was informed that PP has made a request for withdrawing the proposal. SEIAA discussed this issue and decided as follows –

1. Nodal Officer, SEIAA should put up relevant documents before SEIAA detailing the procedure / authority for accepting the withdrawal application made by PP.
2. A general business rule is, before taking decision of withdrawal application, such application should be placed before the highest authority who has deliberated upon on said proposal.

5. Building Stone (Khanda,Gitti,Boulder) Mining at Arazi No. 20३४, Village: Naigawan, Tehsil-Mahoba, District- Mahoba. Shri Pushpendra Singh Yadav, Area -1.729 Ha., File No. 6913/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/71818/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC-2 to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Mahoba to ensure that no mining activity is started until valid EC is obtained and in case mining has been carried out without valid EC then work should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP.

6. Hospital Building at Plot No. HO-01, Sector-03, Greater Noida, U.P. Mr. Suraj Singh, M/s NiranjanVidya Foundation Delhi. File No. 6916/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/234842/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-2 that the matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.

7. Expansion in Existing Formaldehyde Manufacturing of (30 TPD to 250 TPD) at Plot No. K-1, Phase 1, UPSIDC, Industrial Area Sandila, Hardoi, U.P., M/s Focus Merchant Ltd., File No. 6923/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND3/70632/2021

SEIAA noted the comments of SEAC-2 that the Secretariat informed the committee that the standard terms of reference for the above project proposal has already been issued through online Parivesh Portal on 11/02/2022. Hence, no action is required in the matter.



8. Group Housing at Plot No.- 7D/GH-03 at Awadh Vihar Yojna, Sultanpur Road (Shahidpath), Lucknow., M/s Certa Infrastructure Private Limited, File No. 2300/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/255856/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC-2 to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Lucknow; MS, SPCB; and VC, LDA to ensure that no construction activity is started until valid EC is obtained and in case construction has been carried out without valid EC then work should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP.

9. Building stone (khanda-boulder/gitti-ballast Mining at Gata/Arazi No.- 02/1, Village- Lakhanpura, Tehsil & Dist.-Lalitpur, Smt. Suraj Rani. Area - 2.225 ha., File No. 6931/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/72136/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC-2 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to ToR-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/ amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- 3- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 4- Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
- 5- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.
- 6- KML file for the area and mining lease area should be provided.
- 7- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.
- 8- In case project proponent intends to temporarily store mined out material or any tools, equipments or other material outside mine lease area then NOC from competent authority for doing so should be submitted and details of such area and associated Environmental impacts should be included in EIA-EMP report. This should also be clearly mentioned during public hearing.
- 9- Road network to be used by the project should be clearly shown on Survey of India toposheet in 1:50,000 scale. In case road network involves forest road, permission should be obtained from Forest Department and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of appraisal of EIA-EMP report.
- 10 The project proponent should clearly spell out whether it is a green field or brown field project. In case it is a brown field project and -
 - (i) If the earlier and present lease holder are same then compliance report of previous EC should be submitted.

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(ii) If the earlier and present lease holder are different then environmental footprint of the site and mitigation measures should be included in EIA-EMP report.

- 11- In case of expansion / renewal of earlier EC, following information should be submitted
 - a. Status of compliance of earlier EC conditions by Integrated Regional Office, MoEFCC, Gol, Lucknow.
 - b. Copy of CTE and CTO issued by SPCB.
 - c. Status of submission of six-monthly compliance report to EC granted earlier
 - d. Court cases, if any.
- 12- Observations raised in public hearing, replies submitted by project proponent, suitable modifications carried out in EIA-EMP report.
- 13- Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 3,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.
- 14- In consultation with District Environment Authority or an authority nominated by concerned DM, Project Proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for the rejuvenation and management of water bodies having a total surface area of not less than 15 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six-monthly implementation status will be presented by the Project Proponent before the nominated authority in the district.
- 15- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire T&R while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report. A presentation to this effect should be made before SEAC at the time of EIA-EMP presentation.

10. Proposed "5 Star Hotel" at Plot/Khasra No: 1/2 Ramgarh Tal Parlyojna, Gorakhpur, M/s AD Estate Developers, Gorakhpur, U.P., File No. 6933/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/255581/2022

SEIAA noted the comments of SEAC-2 to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and opined that the project proponent/consultant shall submit:-

1. Details of final discharge point.
2. NOC from wetland Authority and Forest Department.
3. Approval from AAI and Ministry of Defense.
4. Approved building plan from the development authority.



11. Granite Mining at Gata No.-715/24, Village- Gonda, Tehsil- Karwi, District- Chitarkoot., Shri Rajjan Bajpeyi, Area -4.048 ha. File No. 6441/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/64582/2021

SEIAA noted that as per the direction of SEIAA, the matter was listed in 640th SEAC meeting dated 04/04/2022. SEAC-2 went through the file and documents and opined that the project proponent should be call for presentation before SEAC in view of points raised by SEIAA.

12. Commercial Project "Lulu Mall" at IBB-2, Plot No., T4A, T-5, Sushant Golf City (Hi Tech Township), Shaheed Path, Village-Hariharpur, Tehsil,Sarojani Nagar,Lucknow, M/s Lulu India Shopping Mall Pvt. Ltd. File No. 6807/6467/Proposal No. SIA/UP/ MIS/70564/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project has already been taken in 577th SEIAA minutes. Hence no further action is required.
