Minutes of the 590th Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 22.04.2022

The meeting of 590th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 22.04.2022 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

Nodal Officer SEIAA informed that agenda is prepared by Secretariat and approved by MS SEIAA which is hereby put up for the consideration of SEIAA and placed files and documents related to below mentioned projects before SEIAA.

Agenda:A:-Review

 Sand/Morrum Mining from Baghain river bed at Gata No. 190/2, Village-amiyari, Tehsil-Rajapur, Chitrakoot, M/s Avdhesh Tripathi, Area 1.391 ha., File No. 6861/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/250929/2022

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 582nd meeting. In the MoM additional conditions were not mentioned. Hence SEIAA reviewed the case and added the following condition:-

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition regarding cluster certificate as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate" and adding following conditions:-

 Validity period of this EC is 6 months from the date of issue as the LoI has been issued for a period of 6 months or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan



- or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
- The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake regrassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
- 4. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
- 5. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 2,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
- 6. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 10 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
- Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation
- Any application for transfer of this EC, during its validity period unless it is cancelled by a competent authority, has to be necessarily accompanied with status of compliance of EC conditions duly certified by IRO, MoEFCC, Gol, Lucknow.

SEIAA noted that the same project was deliberated upon by SEAC-1 on 15.03.2022 and granted EC. Now this project was placed before SEAC-2 for deliberation. SEAC-2 has recorded in their MoM as follows —

It was informed that PP has made a request for withdrawing the proposal. SEIAA discussed this issue and decided as follows –

- Nodal Officer, SEIAA should put up relevant documents before SEIAA detailing the procedure / authority for accepting the withdrawal application made by PP.
- A general business rule is, before taking decision of withdrawal application, such application should be placed before the highest authority who has deliberated upon on said proposal.
- "Khandas, Gitti, Boulder Mining" at Gata No.: 42 & 44 (Khand No- 05), Village: Baruwasyodha, Tehsil: Naraini, Banda, Area: 0.8 Ha, File No. 4938/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/257274/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC-2 to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Banda to ensure that no mining activity is started until valid EC is obtained and in case mining has been carried out without valid EC then mining should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP.

 Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF) at Plot No. E = 25 and E=26, UPSIDC Industrial Area, Babrala, Sambhal, Shri Rajesh Kumar, M/s Punahchakran Private Limited, File No. 6497/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/66542/2021

SEIAA noted that SEAC-2 has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA opined to refer back the project to SEAC-2 in light of MoEFCC, Gol OM F.No. 20/2/2020-HSMD dated 01.04.2022 regarding non-compliance of Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2016 and revised CPCB Guidelines in the State of Uttar Pradesh by SFIAA and SEAC with respect in grant of Environmental Clearance for CBWTF to analyse and deliberate upon the proposal and make their recommendations accordingly. DoE to provide above mentioned OM to SEAC-1 and SEAC-2.

All the contents mentioned in Environmental Clearance letter no. 918/Parya/SEAC/2069/2013/JDCA(S) dated 31/07/2014 shall remain the same.

 Proposed 200 KLD Grain Based Distillery (Unit II) with 7.0 MW of Co-Generation Power Plant at E1, Sector – 15, GIDA Industrial Area, Phase 1, Sahjanwa, Gorakhpur, Shri AshutoshGautam, M/s India Glycols Ltd., File No. 6951/6343/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/72468/2021

Under no circumstances treated waste water and effluent shall not be discharged to any drain/sewer line/ inland surface water/Nala etc.
- Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.

Residential Complex "Eco-Village III" at Plot No. GH-06, Sector-016-B, Greater Noida, U.P., M/s Supertech Limited, File No. 6957/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/ 70276/2021

However SEIAA also noted that more than 30 days have passed from the date of application for ToR i.e. 21.02.2022 and standard Terms of Reference have already been issued on 02.03.2022. MoEFCC, GoI vide S.O. 751(E) dated 17.02.2020 has given following directions —

- (iv) The Standard Terms of Reference shall be issued to the following projects or activities through online mode, on acceptance of application within 7 working days, without referring to EAC or SEAC by the Ministry or SEIAA, as the case may be
 - (a) All Highway projects in Border States covered under entry (i) and (ii) of column(3) and (4) against item 7(f) of the Schedule;
 - (b) All projects or activities proposed to be located in industrial estates or parks (item 7(c) of the Schedule) approved by the concerned authorities, and which are not disallowed in such approval; and
