The committee noted that M/s. HPCL Depot (Vijayawada Terminal) POL storage capacity will propose to enhance said storage capacity and also a new pipeline (Vijayawada – Dharmapuri Pipeline) has been proposed from existing Kondapalli POL Terminal to the proposed Dharampuri Terminal with pipeline capacity of 4.24 MMTPA (Phase-I) and 5.85 MMTPA (Phase-II). The Terms of Reference (TOR) with public hearing was issued on 10.05.2018. Public hearing was conducted on 8th August 2018. The certified compliance report of EC of existing HPCL Kondapalli POL Terminal from the MoEFCC, Regional Office, Chennai was submitted along the final EIA report.

The Committee noted that the proposed project falls under Item No. 6(b) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- Isolated storage & handling of hazardous chemicals.

The Committee recommended for issue of Environmental Clearance to this proposed additional POL storage capacity – 2070 KL and for the Augmentation / Conversion of Pumping/pigging facilities at Kondapalli (Vijayawada) Terminal, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh to the proposed Vijayawada Dharmapuri Pipe line project, duly stipulating conditions.
