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### Minutes of the 576<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 24.03.2022

The meeting of 576<sup>th</sup> State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 24.03.2022 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

1. Construction of Data Center Building at Plot No.- C-20/1A/10, Sector-62, Noida, Shri Hemant Sonawane, M/s Adani Enterprises Limited. File No. 6625/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/231053/2021

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 550<sup>th</sup> meeting in which some queries were raised. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 28.02.2022. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of 609<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be

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related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.

- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharge.

- 11- In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.

Under no circumstances treated waste water and effluent shall be discharged to any drain/sewer line/ inland surface water/Nala etc.
2. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-2 that the matter shall be discussed after submission of online information on prescribed portal.

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
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
