Minutes of the 22nd Meeting of SEIAA held on 18th & 19th March, 2020

The meeting was chaired by the Chairman, State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttarakhand (SEIAA) Dr S.S. Negi and was attended by following:

- i. Shri Shailendra Singh Bisht, Member, SEIAA, Uttarakhand.
- ii. Shri G.S. Pande, Member Secretary, SEIAA

The meeting started with welcome remarks by Chairman, SEIAA.

Following agenda items were discussed and decisions taken: -

18th March, 2020 10:00 AM

1) Consideration of following proposals for E.C, received after appraisal of SEAC: -

- 1) Environmental Clearance for proposed installation of Polyurethane (PU) Manufacturing Unit at Plot No. 54-58, Sector No. – 8A, IIE, "SIDCUL", Haridwar by M/s Ampro at Plot No. 54-58, Sector No. – 8A, IIE, "SIDCUL", Haridwar.
- 2) The Authority considered the matter and observed that the PP shall comply with The Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989, implement CER of 2% of project cost i.e., ₹ 1.6 Lakh and develop green belt in one third of the project area i.e., 833 m2. With these conditions the Authority agreed with the recommendations

of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

- 3) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by M/s Salluj Jal Vidhyut Nigam Limited (SJVNL), VPO - Mori, Tehsil -Mori, District - Uttarkashi. at, Sandra Rage, Binol Beet, Compartment No- 15 & 16, VPO - Mori, Tehsil -Mori, District - Uttarkashi. **(Area- 4.0 Ha.)**

The Authority discussed the matter and required the PP to submit detailed /original EIA and EMP and copy of EC granted by the MoEF&CC. The matter will be taken up again after these documents are submitted by the PP.

- 4) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by Shri Purn Singh S/o Shri Jeet Singh. At Village- Chaupadia, Tehsil- Keertinagar, District- Tehri Garhwal. **(Area- 1.50 Ha.)**

The authority agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC and decided to grant environment clearance to the project.

- 5) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by M/s Uttarakhand Forest Development Corporation (UKFDC), Aranya Vikas Bhawan, 73, Nehru Road, Dehradun at Village- Abdultapur & Rampur, Tehsil Vikasnagar District- Dehradun. **(Area- 23.75 Ha.)**

The Authority discussed the project in detail and observed that copy of ToR and original copy of EIA/EMP have not been received. In addition to this green belt development plan should contain MoUs between the PP and the owners of the plantation site especially the villagers/ Gram Panchayat along the river. The project includes large manpower (300) for mining which will have adverse impact on the area in terms of ecology needs to be examined by the PP. Accordingly it was decided that the matter will be taken up after necessary examination of impact of manpower and submission of the required documents by the PP.

- 6) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Soapstone by Shri Manoj Kumar Shah at Village - Surkaligaon, Tehsil - Dugnakuri, Dist - Bageshwar. **(Area- 2.022 Ha.)**



The Authority discussed the project and it was observed that the PP should submit details of implementation of Corporate Environment Responsibility (CER). Under biodiversity conservation especially conservation the PP requires to consult local Forest Officer. Subject to these conditions the authority agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC and decided to grant EC

- 7) Environmental Clearance for Manufacturing of Soft Gelatin Capsules at 4A, Sara Industrial Estate Ltd., By M/s Alder Biochem Pvt. Ltd. 4A, Sara Industrial Estate Ltd., Village-Rampur, Selaqui, Dehradun.

The Authority considered the matter and it was observed that the PP should submit green belt development plan after consulting local Forest Officer. details of plan for using Solar Energy and Rain Water Harvesting. Subject to these conditions the authority agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC.

- 8) Environmental Clearance for Manufacturing Proposed to setup a Hotel Project By M/s Ghati Developers & Builders at Mauja Niranjapur, Dehradun.

The Authority considered the matter and it was observed that the PP should ascertain from the Director, Rajaji Tiger Reserve (RTR) regarding requirement of Wildlife Clearance in terms of location of the project within the Eco Sensitive Zone of RTR. Muck management plan, details of green belt development and Wildlife Clearance (WLC), if required or certificate from Director, RTR indicating non-requirement of WLC should also be submitted. The project will be taken up by the Authority after the documents as mentioned above are submitted.

- 9) Environmental Clearance for Manufacturing Installation of DG Set and Enhancement of Man power along with painting facility for Passenger Motor Car Service Centre in the existing complex by M/s B.M Autosales Private Limited at Mohabbewala, Subhash Nagar, Saharanpur Road, Dist. Dehradun.

The Authority considered the matter and it was observed that the PP should submit details of installation of solar panels and MoU for maintenance of plantation with the green belt development plan. Subject to submission of these documents, the Authority agreed with

the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

- 10) Environmental Clearance for proposed expansion of existing Pharmaceutical Formulations By M/s M/s Natco Pharma Limited at Selaqui, Tehsil Vikas Nagar, Dehradun.

The Authority considered the matter and agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC and decided to grant EC to the project

- 11) Environmental Clearance for proposed Proposed PET Plastic Recycling Facility to Manufacture PET Flakes & PET Straps By M/s Beyond Clean Solution Private Limited at, Village- Koal, Pargana & Tehsil- Narendar Nagar, District- Tehri Garhwal.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it subject to submission of details of plan for using Solar Energy.

19th March, 2020 at 10:00 AM

- 1) Environmental Clearance for Establishment of Grain based distillery: 40.0 KLD along with Co-generation power- 3.0 MW at Village - Ahmadpur Grant, Block - Bahadrabad, Tehsil & District- Haridwar by M/s Uttam Distillers Ltd. Village - Ahmadpur Grant, Block – Bahadrabad.

The Authority discussed the project in depth and it was decided to obtain revised EMP as per the ToR, in view of glaring discrepancies of flora and state of construction in the EMP, Fly Ash Management Plan and green belt development plan on 3.178 Ha land prepared in consultation with local Forest Officer RFO/DFO. The project will be taken up by the Authority after the documents as mentioned above are submitted.



- 2) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by M/s Mahakali Associates at Village – Dubaula - Birtola Tehsil- Gangolihat District - Pithoragarh. **(Area- 0.372 Ha.)**

The Authority discussed the project and decided to grant EC to the proposal as per recommendations of the SEAC subject to submission of Restoration Plan of Mining/Quarry site.

- 3) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by Shri Dharampal Singh S/o Shri Bachan Singh Dumaga at, Village - Amotha, Tehsil & Distt Rudraprayag (Area- 0.200 Ha.)

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it subject to submission of details of Gram Panchayat and development of green belt and details of CSR by the PP.

- 4) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, bajri, boulder by Shri Dinesh Negi, S/o Shri Balam Singh Negi at, Village – Sunara, Tehsil – Barkot, District – Uttarkashi. **(Area- 0.971 Ha.)**

The Authority decided to defer the matter as consultant/ PP did not appear.

- 5) Environmental Clearance for proposed DG Set for Hotel construction by M/s Pearl Grand at Saharanpur road, Niranjapur Opp. Sabjimandi, Distt. Dehra Dun.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

- 6) Environmental Clearance for proposed Installation of Green insulated DG Set and Enhancement of Man Power in the existing Complex to manufacture Flip Flop i.e. Slippers & Sandals (Capacity – 18.0 Lac pairs/Annum) and EVA Compound (3000.0 MT/Annum) By M/s Soltec (Unit – II) at, Lal Tappar, Industrial Area, Tehsil Rishikesh, Dehradun.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

The PP was directed to submit Solar Energy utilization plan, Rainwater Harvesting Plan and name of the villages where CSR/CER activities will be implemented.

- 7) Amendment in Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Soapstone by Shri Jeewan Singh Mal) at Village- Village –Dungra, Tehsil & Distt Pithoragarh **Area-4.184 Ha**

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

It was also decided that MS SEIAA and Member SEIAA will also visit the site to monitor the compliances.

2) Miscellaneous Matters: -

- 1) The replies submitted by Project Proponents to queries raised by Authority in its previous meeting were considered and decisions taken as under: -**

- (i) Amendment in Environmental Clearance for change in Boiler Capacity (From 1.5 Ton/Hr. to 850 Kg/Hr and fuel (From Dual Fuel Fired Boiler to Multi fuel Boiler i.e. FO/LPG/HSD/LDO) in the Existing Complex by M/s Ban Labs (P) Ltd. C- 4, at Selaqui Industrial Area, Selaqui, Dehradun. (Installation boiler)

In the 22nd meeting of SEIAA held on 18th and 19th March, 2020, it was observed that the Authority deliberated upon the application of E.C. No.8-9(01)/2018 Dated 1st February, 2019. The P.P has requested vide letter dated 27-01-2020 for change in Boiler Capacity (From 1.5 Ton/Hr. to 850 Kg/Hr and fuel (From Dual Fuel Fired Boiler to Multi fuel Boiler i.e. FO/LPG/HSD/LDO) in the Existing Complex by M/s Ban Labs (P) Ltd. C- 4, at Selaqui Industrial Area, Selaqui, Dehradun. The Authority deliberated upon the matter and it was decided to accept the above request of the PP.

- (ii) Establishment of Hot Mix Plant M/s Doon Infrastructure at Khata No. 327, and Khasra No. 197 Sha/1 in Village- Sherpur, Tehsil- Vikasnagar, District- Dehradun (Extend for one year)



In the 22nd meeting of SEIAA held on 18th and 19th March, 2020, it was observed that the Authority granted E.C. No.4-9(16)/2018 Dated 11th January, 2019 for one year. The P.P has vide letter dated 6-03-2020 requested for extension of validity of Environment Clearance. The Authority considered the matter and it was decided to accept the the request for extension of the validity of Environment Clearance as per EIA Notification, 2006 for 5 years.

- (iii) Picking of sand, bajri and boulders at Village- Purwala Birsangpur, Pargana –Jwalapur, Tehsil- Laksar, District- Haridwar, by Smt. Suman W/o Shri Brajpal Contractor (Owner), Village–Sewla Kalan, Post- Majra, District- Dehradun.

In the 22nd meeting of SEIAA held on 18th and 19th March, 2020, it was observed that The Authority deliberated upon the request dated 27-02-2020 of applicant (Smt. Suman W/o Shri Brajpal Contractor (Owner), Village – Sewla Kalan, Post- Majra, District- Dehradun who was granted EC No. 83-01(108)/2019 dated 06.12.2019 for Picking of sand, bajri and boulders at Village- Purwala Birsangpur, Pargana –Jwalapur, Tehsil- Laksar, District- Haridwar in the lease area 1.512) for amendment in condition No. 12 of the EC regarding replacement of method from 'open cast manual mining' to 'semi-mechanized open cast method' as per the approved mining plan which allows semi-mechanized open cast method. Accordingly, the PP has requested for amendment in the condition no. 12. The Authority deliberated upon the matter and it was decided to accept the above request and accordingly amend method of mining stipulated in condition No. 12 is allowed as 'Semi-mechanized open cast method.'

- (iv) M/s Rusan Pharma Ltd at Central Hope Town, Selaqui, Dehradun.

In the 18th meeting of SEIAA held on 20-21 December, 2019, the PP was directed to submit compliance of conditions of EC dated 6th October, 2008. The proponent has now submitted compliance of conditions of EC dated 6th October, 2008. The PP has now submitted these documents and with this, the Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.






The matter was deferred for the next meeting.
