A. CONSIDERATION OF COUNTRY LIQUOR PROPOSALS:

(I) CONSIDERATION OF REVALIDATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE OF COUNTRY LIQUOR PROPOSALS (14 Nos):

The Committee verified the documents furnished along with checklist of 14 nos. of country liquor units as per **Annexure- I**. These 14 nos. of units have already obtained Environmental Clearance earlier. They have applied for revalidation of Environmental Clearance for the same capacity / less than the capacity for which Environmental Clearance granted earlier. The Committee recommended to consider these proposals as per recommendation of SEAC meeting held on 31.10.2019.

(II) CONSIDERATION OF REVALIDATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE AS WELL AS CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF COUNTRY LIQUOR PROPOSAL (02 Nos.):

The committee verified the application furnished in Form-I along with documents and checklist of 02 nos. of country liquor proposals (as per **Annexure – II**) for revalidation of Environmental Clearance as well as change of ownership. The SEAC recommended to consider revalidation of Environmental Clearance for these 02 nos. of proposals as per recommendation of SEAC meeting held on 31.10.2019. The SEAC also recommended to consider change of ownership of these two country liquor proposals as per the provision of para 11 of EIA Notification, 2006 for "Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC)" for change of ownership of country liquor proposals.

(III) CONSIDERATION OF COUNTRY LIQUOR PROPOSALS (NEW AND EXPANSION IN CAPACITY - 04 Nos.):
