The Authority discussed about the proposals in detail and decided the following:

Serial No. 1, 2 & 3: SEIAA in its 4.62nd meeting dated 7.07.2021 had rejected these proposals as they were at a distance of less than 50 m from the notified forest area. Govt. of







Rajasthan in its Circular dated 20 August, 2010 has clearly mentioned that there is no such distance criteria from the forest area except for the condition that all the mining leases which are at a distance of less than 100 m from the forest area shall have a wall constructed on the lease boundary towards the forest area. SEAC in its meeting 4.84 held on 11 to 13 May, 2021 had recommended for grant of EC to these proposals. Hon'ble NGT Bhopal Bench in its order dated 18 November, 2021 had directed SEIAA to reconsider these proposals. DCF, Bundi in his letter dated 5.08.2021 has informed that the distance of these proposals from forest area is 167, 237 and 103 meters. SEIAA after detailed deliberations, looking to in to all the legal material available found that its earlier decision was incongruous and not substantiated by facts. After considering all the facts SEIAA decided to grant EC to all these proposals.

3. Serial No. 4: SEIAA after defiled deliberation decided to grant EC to the proposal.
