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Buldhana District Sand Proposals:-

The 17 numbers of proposal were earlier considered in the 242nd meeting of SEAC-1 wherein all proposals were deferred for following reasons. Now PP reviewed all proposals and submitted 16 numbers of proposals for appraisal along with information on following points,

During deliberations it was observed that, the accredited consultant was not prepared to present the case as also the EIA coordinator was not available for any clarifications. The EIA co-ordinator joined later after the committee sought his/her presence. The consultant was not responding to any query of the expert committee members with relevant data and explanation. Over all the presentation was not up to the mark to appraise the proposal. The SEAC expressed its dissatisfaction over the behaviour of the consultant as well as preparedness of the PP.

Following important issues were raised during the presentation:

- 1. PP to submit details of expenditure done in last five years from the District Mining Funds in the villages where sand ghats were auctioned.*
- 2. PP to submit point wise compliance of all the issues raised during public hearing along with roles and responsibility related to compliances with details of specific time lines and budgetary allocations. It was also noted that most points raised in public hearing were not addressed with a view to credible actions.*
- 3. In some cases, the transportation route was noticed to be passing through the village; PP to relook into all proposals and ensure the transport routes in all cases pass through outside of the village in all the sand ghat proposals.*
- 4. In some cases, it was observed that, the proposed depth for sand mining is only 0.15 meters which is practically very difficult to ensure exact depth for sand excavation as well as monitoring of compliance; PP to relook into all proposals and ensure that practically and environmentally sustainable proposals are submitted. In all such cases, if it's not practical, PP to withdraw such proposals from the PARIVESH PORTAL.*

In some cases it was observed that, the wells are within the proposed sand ghat area. Therefore, PP to revisit all such sites and check whether the wells are authorized or not and if not take action against the defaulters. PP also to submit their plans to conserve the well if they are authorized and make necessary changes in the EMP.

2.	PP to submit details of expenditure spent on the areas of villages where sand ghats were auctioned in last five years from the District Mining Fund.
3.	DMO to demarcate the proposed sand ghat with geo-referencing clearly providing adequate space for necessary infrastructure and facilities as presented in the layout
4.	The District Collector shall ensure that, the final lease be granted only after ensuring that the river bed is dry. No sand mining activity should be carried out if there is water in the river bed. PP also to ensure compliance of all issues raised during Gram Sabha before issuing final lease.
5.	The District Collector shall ensure that, the approach road from the proposed sand ghat to the sand storage depot is properly identified and demarcated with the consent of the concern land owners /local authority before issuing final lease document.
