The Authority after detailed discussion and deliberation decided the following:

1. **Serial No. 1.** The authority decided to refer back the proposal to SEAC : –

- To Examine in the light of the complaint letter dated 04.03.2025 and ADM letter dated 06.03.2025 and re-send the recommendations to SEIAA accordingly.
- To seek and adjudge the adequacy of additional documents viz. valid Cluster Ceritfcate, original copy of Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule-I

species, NABL Certificate of testing laboratory and NOC from the concerned land holder for plantation outside the mining lease area.

2. Serial No. 2. The authority decided to refer back to SEAC : –

- a. To seek and adjudge the adequacy of additional documents viz. signed final EIA/EMP report, valid Cluster Certificate, approved Cluster Mining Plan, Replenishment Study, approved Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule I species and NOC from the concerned land holder for plantation outside the mining lease area.
- b. To seek clarifications regarding following:
 - i. Contradiction observed in details of water requirement as per Approved Mining Plan and Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - ii. Proposal is for opencast semi-mechanized mining without drilling and blasting as per approved Mining Plan. However, point no. 11.1, 14.1 of Compliance of TOR and point no. 2.6 of Chapter 2 of final EIA/EMP report mentions carrying out of drilling and blasting.
 - iii. Proposed total area of plantation along the banks of the river in final EIA/EMP report is 20.00 ha without any details of certified length of cluster boundary path to verify the same.
 - iv. The date mentioned in GPS coordinated ambient air monitoring photos do not match with the monitoring reports.
 - v. Fauna Species found in study area differ in Point No. 3.7.3 of Final EIA/EMP Report and in Wildlife Conservation Plan submitted.
 - vi. Three Schedule-I species (as per Wildlife Protection Amendment Act, 2022) were found wrongly classified as Schedule III and IV in Point No. 3.7.3 of Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - vii. Conservation Plan made for two species namely Panther & Peacock. However, this differs from the faunal diversity details of study area as per Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - viii. Budget is allocated only for one Schedule -I species as per submitted Conservation Plan.

3. Serial No. 3. The authority decided to refer back to SEAC : –

- a. To seek and adjudge the adequacy of additional documents viz. signed final EIA/EMP report, valid Cluster Certificate, approved Cluster Mining Plan, Replenishment Study, approved Wildlife Conservation Plan for Schedule I species and NOC from the concerned land holder for plantation outside the mining lease area.




b. To seek clarifications regarding following:


- i. Contradiction observed in details of water requirement as per Approved Mining Plan and Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - ii. Proposal is for opencast semi-mechanized mining without drilling and blasting as per approved Mining Plan. However, point no. 11.1, 14.1 of Compliance of TOR and point no. 2.6 of Chapter 2 of final EIA/EMP report mentions carrying out of drilling and blasting.
 - iii. Proposed total area of plantation along the banks of the river in final EIA/EMP report is 40.00 ha without any details of length of cluster boundary path to verify the same.
 - iv. Sukli Nadi is mentioned to be at a distance of 2.15 km from the lease area but was observed to be a tributary of West Banas River merging into the river very nearby to lease area as per the submitted KML file of lease boundary.
 - v. The date mentioned in GPS coordinated ambient air monitoring photos do not match with the monitoring reports.
 - vi. Fauna Species found in study area differ in Point No. 3.7.3 of Final EIA/EMP Report and in Wildlife Conservation Plan submitted.
 - vii. Three Schedule-I species (as per Wildlife Protection Amendment Act, 2022) were found wrongly classified as Schedule III and IV in Point No. 3.7.3 of Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - viii. Conservation Plan made for two species namely Panther & Peacock. However, this differs from the faunal diversity details of study area as per Final EIA/EMP Report.
 - ix. Budget is allocated only for one Schedule -I species as per submitted Conservation Plan.
4. **Serial No. 4.** The authority decided to refer back to SEAC with directions to re-examination the proposal in light of latest Supreme Court order dated 28.03.2025.
