

1. "Emami Nature" at Khellar, District- Jhansi, U.P., Shri Sanjoy Kumar Mohanty, M/s Emami Realty Ltd. File No. 5641/5249/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/52710/2019

SEIAA gone through the letter of the project proponent dated 20.08.2020 regarding change in conditions in the minutes. SEIAA noted that EC to the above project has already been issued vide letter no. 224/Parya/SEIAA/5249/2019 dated 28.07.2020. Hence SEIAA opined that no further action is required at present.

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its 404th meeting dated 21.09.2020 in which SEIAA opined that the Environmental Clearance can be transferred only after project proponent shall submit a certificate from the competent authority that mining has not been executed on the above lease after 17.02.18. The project proponent has submitted letter no. 277/Khanij/KhairaKhas 2020 dated 01.10.2020 of DMO, Balia from DM office, Balia requesting to transfer the previous EC for the remaining period i.e upto 15 March 2023. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 187/Parya/SEAC/3969/2017 dated 17.02.2018 from Shri Dadan Khan, Hindustan Construction Company, ItiyaThok, Gonda to Shri Krishna Nagar Yadav, M/s Shiva Enterprises Maharajganj S/o late Ram Vriksha Yadav, Darhata Thana- Chauk, Tehsil- Sadar, Maharajganj for remaining period i.e upto 16.02.2023 (remaining period of previous EC). Validity of Environmental Clearance shall be extended after receiving certificate from the competent authority that mining was not conducted on previous EC i.e after 17.02.2018. Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter shall remain same.

SEIAA noted that the above project was taken in its meeting dated 21.05.2020 in which SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit revised water balance for monsoon and non-monsoon season. The project proponent has submitted his reply vide letter dated 29.09.2020. After reviewing the reply SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC 05.03.2020. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

1. If the proposed project falls in Critically Polluted Areas (CPAs), Severely Polluted Areas (SPAs) the provision of the mechanism framed regarding compliance of Hon'ble NGT order in OA 1038/2018 dated 19-08-2019 by MoEF& CC, Govt. Of India vide letter dated 31-10-2019 shall be followed in letter and spirit.
2. All the additional conditions for grant of Consent to Establish (CTE)/Consent to Operate (CTO) related to Pollution mitigation measures as prescribed in the office memorandum of MoEF&CC, Gol. dated 31.10.2019 and as deemed fit by UP Pollution Control Board in the consent orders shall be followed by Project Proponent.
3. The project proponent shall submit the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project within the next 3 months.
4. The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
5. The project proponent shall submit the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details within the next 3 months. The CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
6. The project proponent shall submit the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan within the next 3 months.

Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to the municipal sewer line.
22. The project proponent will ensure that a proper dust control management is practiced during the construction phase and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
23. The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to the water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
24. The project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 before the start of work.
25. In compliance to Hon'ble Supreme Court order dated 13/01/2020 in IA no. 158128/2019 and 158129/2019 in Writ petition no. 13029/1985 (MC Mehta Vs GOI and others) anti-smog guns shall be installed to reduce dust during excavation.
26. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
