The 6th respondent had been given a mining lease over Ac.12.05 c ents of land in Sy.No.535. The petitioner claims that his land has also b een included in the above Acres 12.05 cents and the 6th Respondent c annot undertake mining in his land. The ownership of the petitioner over the said land was brought into doubt due to the proceedings of the Joint Collector dated 19.02.2011. These proceedings have been suspended by this Court in W.P.No.17614 of 2011. In view of the suspension of the proceedings of the Joint Collector, this Court would not be going into the e question of title of the petitioner over the said land. 2. It is the case of the petitioner that the 6th respondent, under the guise of carrying on mi ning activity in his lease area, had undertaken underground mining whe reby he had entered into the land of the petitioner below the surface an d is carrying on extensive mining activity without obtaining any permissi on for such activity and without obtaining environment clearance and ot her clearances required for such mining activity. Initially a large amount of pleadings and material papers have been filed before this Court on th e question of the extent of mining being undertaken by the 6th respond ent, and whether such mining is permissible or not. 3. The 6th responde nt, by a Memo, has filed the mining plan and the approval obtained for u nderground mining. The said approval had been given under the coveri ng letter bearing No.4166/MS/Qurds/ RRR,J W.P.No.30679 of 2018 2 N LR/2018 dated 02.07.2018 from the Joint Director of Mines and Geology to Deputy Director of Mines and Geology (FAC), Guntur. The said appro ved mining plan is for a period of five years i.e., from 2020 to 2024. In th

e circumstances, the contention of the petitioner that the 6th respondent was undertaking underground mining without the approval, would have t o be rejected. However, the petitioner would also contend that this appr oval has been given behind the back of the petitioner and he would be e ntitled to challenge the same. 4. The petitioner, in turn, filed a Memo dated 04.07.2022 enclosing the notice issued by the A.P. Pollution Cont rol Board dated 02.06.2022 in Lr.No.N-785/APPCB/RO-NLR/2022 wher ein the 6th respondent was directed to stop operations of mining in Sy. No.535/P immediately. The petitioner also produced Lr.No.3049/M/2005 , dated 06.06.2022 from the Assistant Director of Mines and Geology, N ellore to the State Environmental Impact Assessment Authority, Vijayaw ada. In this letter the Assistant Director of Mines and Geology has state d that the Environmental clearance of the 6th respondent had expired o n 30.04.2021 and no production has been carried out from 01.05.2021. Basing upon these two documents, Sri K.S. Murthy, learned Senior C ounsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the 6th responden t cannot carry on any mining activities until the lease granted to the 6th respondent is renewed and the prohibitory order issued by the A.P. Poll ution Control Board on 02.06.2022 is withdrawn. The learned Senior Co unsel would also point to Condition No.1 in the letter dated 14.03.2012 i ssued by the Director of Mines Safety to the 6th respondent, stipulating that the connections between the mines shall exclusively be utilised as second outlet purpose and would contend that this condition cannot be RRR, J W.P.No.30679 of 2018 3 extended to mean that the 6th respond ent may go through the land of the petitioner. 6. Sri N. 	The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (<250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).
	The representative of the proponent and their consultant BS Envitech (P) Ltd have attended the meeting.
	The Committee noted that as per cluster letter issued by Asst. Director of Mines & Geology (FAC), Visakhapatnam, vide Lr. dated: 27.08.2022, there are 06 existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mts area. The total applicable cluster area is 29.47 Ha which is >5.0 Ha. Total cluster area is 74 Ha for which cluster EIA and EMP is to be done.
	The Committee noted that the extent of proposed mine lease area is <b>4.047</b> Ha. The project falls under B2 at par with B1 category.
	The project proponent obtained work order from mines department on 27.06.2014.
	And whereas, pursuant to the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated the 27 <sup>th</sup> February, 2012 in I.A. No.12-13 of 2011 in Special Leave Petition (Civil) No.19628-19629 of 2009, in the matter of Deepak Kumar etc. Vs. State of Haryana and Others etc., prior environmental clearance has now become mandatory for mining of minor minerals and the Central Government has published notification number S.O.141(E), dated the 15th January, 2016 making prior environment clearance mandatory for all minerals (major as well as minor) irrespective of size of the mine lease; And whereas, all mine lease holders are required to obtain prior environment clearance.
	NGT order in OA No 136 of 2017 (SZ) : So under these circumstances, the application can be disposed of, giving the following directions: (i)The applications which are pending as on 31.3.2016 for Environment Clearance have to be treated as normal applications and not violation applications and

the authorities are directed to dispose of those applications in accordance with law. 81 (ii) The persons who have not filed applications on or before 31.3.2016 and filed thereafter, can be treated as violation applications and the MoEF& CC /SEIAA is directed to dispose of those applications as violation cases in accordance with law. (iii) It is also made clear that all mining leases, either majoror minor, even less than 5 hectares area, has to apply and get Environment Clearance as per the amended EIA Notification dated 15.1.2016. This will apply to the existing mining leases as well. The points are answered accordingly.

The committee noted that the proponent operated mine from after 2016 without obtaining environmental clearance as required under EIA notification 2006 after promulgation of S.O. 141 (E) dt 15.01.2016 and hence to be treated as identified violation case as per OM 07.07.2021

The proposal was placed in the 193rd SEAC meeting. The Committee recommended to raise ADS for submission of latest cluster letter and High court disposal order of W,P no. 9578/2021. Accordingly the project proponent submitted latest cluster letter dt 27.08.22 and court interim order in IA 2 of 20211 of 9578 of 2021.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue specific (Violation) Terms of Reference with Public Hearing and with the following conditions:

- 1. The proponent shall prepare cluster EIA & EMP.
  - 2. The proponent shall submit Plantation Plan and shall maintain buffer zone
  - 3. The proponent shall include proper benches remediation plan.
  - 4. The project proponent shall upload the final court order w.r.t disposal of W.P No. 9578/2021 at the time of applying for EC.
  - 5. The project proponent shall submit surface runoff prevention measures plan.
  - The proponent is liable to pay the penalties as levied by the concerned competent authority, as per the OM No.28.1.2022 and clause No 12 of SOP dated07-07-2021, duly incorporating the total production during the violation period and submit the calculation of penalties based on the project cost and the total turnover during the violation period.
  - Credible action to be initiated through concerned Regional office, APPCB under section 15 read with section 19 of E(P) Act 1986.
  - 8. The project proponent shall carry assessment of ecological damage, remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan and it shall be prepared as an independent chapter in the environment impact assessment report by the accredited consultants.

The collection and analysis of data for assessment of ecological damage, preparation of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan shall be done by an environmental laboratory duly notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, or an environmental laboratory accredited by National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories, or a laboratory of a Council of Scientific and Industrial Research institution working in the field of environment.

- 9. The project proponent shall ensure implementation of Environmental Management Plan, comprising remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan corresponding to the ecological damage assessed and economic benefit derived due to violation.
- 10. The project proponent will be required to submit a bank guarantee equivalent to the amount of remediation plan and Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan with the State Pollution Control Board.
- 11. The project proponent shall give an undertaking by way of affidavit to comply with all the statutory requirements and judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court dated the 2nd August 2017 in writ petition (Civil) No.144 of 2014 in the matter of common cause verse union of India and Ors. The undertaking inter-alia includes commitment of the PP not to repeat any such violation in future.& OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to issue Terms of Reference.

Decision of SEIAA:- Refer to SEAC to examine the cluster applicability as per notification S.O no 2269 dated 01.07.2016 issued by MoEF&CC, as the mine lease was issued before 2013 and it may not covered under the cluster.

## This proposal is placed in 206<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting:

The Committee after re-examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC' Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, **recommended** to raise ADS for seeking reasons for not attending the meeting.

#### Again this proposal is placed in 210<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting:

The Committee during the re-examination of the proposal, noted that as per cluster letter issued by Asst. Director of Mines & Geology (FAC), Visakhapatnam, vide Lr. dated: 27.08.2022, the following quarry leases are existing within the radius of 500 mts from the periphery of the boundaries of the proposed quarry lease area of M/s Sanjana Granites. The details are as follows.

From the above details of quarry leases existing within the 500mts area of the proposed quarry lease, the quarry leases Viz., 1) Sri GVV Harivarama (10.00 Ha), M/s Nagabhushanam&Co ( 5.00 Ha), 3) M/s Vishnupriya Granites (8.00 Ha) and 4) Smt P. Ratnalatha ( 2.43 Ha) with a total area of 25.43 Ha are considered for the calculation of cluster area for the proposed quarry lease. Since, the cluster area is 25.43 Ha which is more than 5.00 Ha, the committee recommended for the issue of Violation TOR with Public Hearing in the earlier meeting.

After re-examining the project proposals and presentations and detailed deliberations the committee is of the opinion that the earlier recommendation for the issue of Violation TOR with Public Hearing holds good.
