MINUTES OF THE 68th GOA STATE ENVIRONMENT IMPACT ASSESSMENT AUTHORITY (GOA-SEIAA) MEETING HELD ON 22/12/2021 AT 11.00 AM. IN THE CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE 4th FLOOR, DEMPO TOWER, PATTO, <u>PANAJI-GOA.</u>

The sixty-eighth meeting of the Goa-SEIAA (hereinafter referred as 'Authority') was held on 22nd December 2021 at 11.00 am in the conference room, 4th floor, Dempo Tower, Patto, Panaji. The list of members present during the meeting is annexed ($\underline{refer\ Annexure-1}$).

At the outset, Chairman welcomed Authority members and briefed about the agenda items ($refer\ Annexure - 2$) to be taken up for discussion / deliberations and suitable decisions. Accordingly, the same were considered as detailed below -

1. To decide on proposed Laterite Quarry of Sushant Gaonkar in Survey No. 63/2-A of Codar Village Taluka Ponda Goa.

The representative of the project Sushant Gaonkar appeared before the Authority.

Decision: The proposal of Codar laterite Quarry from Mr. Sushant Gaonkar in respect of Survey No. 63/2-A9(P) of the village Codar was placed before the Authority and during the discussion it was observed that the Project Proponent had asked permission for extraction for laterite stone quantity of 5000 cubic meters however the committee had recommended the quantity of 1000 cubic meters.


The Authority decided to seek the clarification from SEAC to clarify on what basis the quantity of 1000 cubic meters is recommended instead of 50000 cubic meters as requested by Project Proponent.

2. To discuss on re-validation of the project Marvel Resorts Private Limited at P.T. Sheet No. 121/Chalta No. 2,3,4,38,39 and P.T. Sheet No. 130/Chalta No. 33, St. Inez, Tiswadi, North Goa.

The representative of the project Marvel Resorts Private Limited Mr. Akshay Chandan along with his legal consultant Mr. Premanand Gawas appeared before the Authority.

Decision: After scrutinizing the application and documents submitted by the Project Proponent, the Authority decided that there is a violation at the site. As per Office Memorandum No.F.No.22-21/2020-IA.III dated 07/07/2021 issued by the Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), New Delhi..

The Project Proponent has to pay 1% of the total assessment of cost incurred over the construction whichever he had done till date before







obtaining the re-validation of EC which works out to Rs. 10,00,000/-(Rupees Ten lakhs only). The project proponent shall deposit the said amount within a period of one week before this Authority upon receipt of the proponent the Authority decided to re-validate the EC granted to the project proponent.

3. To decide on re-validation of the Environmental Clearance EC No. 3-181-2010/STE/DR/105 dated 08/05/2015 in respect of lease No. 04/Basalt/89 and lease No. 05/Basalt/89 of Shri. Manuel Da Costa.

Decision: The Authority noted that the project proponent had deposited the fine as directed by this Authority and hence the Authority decided to revalidate the EC No. 3-181-2010/STE/DR/105 dated 08/05/2015 in respect of lease No. 04/Basalt/89 and lease No. 05/Basalt/89 of Shri. Manuel Da Costa.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
