The applicant has submitted the proposal in terms of the provisions of the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India Notification dated 14th March, 2017 for violation. Brief Note on the Proposal: 1. Earlier the PP has obtained EC from MoEF & CC on 13.02.2001 for production of 1 Lakh TPA chrome ore over the total lease area of 89 ha. 2. The Mining lease was executed on 04.01.2002 for a period of 20 years (i.e. upto 03.01.2022). 3. The MoEF & CC has issued FC on 05.07.2001for diversion of 22.80 ha forest land in Mahagiri D.P.F for Chromite Mining. 4. The PP has applied proposal at MOEF & CC for enhancement of production capacity from 1 LTPA to 2.15 LTPA along with enhancement of Chrome beneficiation plant from 36,000 MTPA to 60, 000 MTPA and ToR was issued on 22.01.2010 EIA study and accordingly Public Hearing was conducted on 31.08.2010. | The ADS dated 11.11.2021 uploaded on 13.12.2021 (and earlier query dtd. 24.09.2021) are not complied yet. Meanwhile the ML has expired on 03.01.2022. There is no clarity on whether the |

After Public hearing was conducted the PP has dropped the proposal of expansion from 1 LTPA to 2.15 LTPA and obtained EC for Chrome Ore beneficiation plant to enhance production capacity from 36,000TPA to 60,000TPA on 26.02.2016.</p> <p>6. Again the PP applied for application obtaining fresh ToR on 21.07.2016 and the MoEF observed that this is violation case as the excess production was made from 2002-03 to 2007-08 by PP for which EC granted of capacity 1 LTPA. The PP has submitted the detailed assessment of ecological damage, remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan and has included the same in the EIA report. 6. The PP has estimated an amount of Rs.4,57,300.00/- (Rupees Four lakhs fifty-seven thousand and three hundred only) towards the cost of assessment of Environmental / Ecological damage due to violation as well as Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan and the SEAC in the absence of any guidelines, the cost as suggested by the proponent in the EIA report have taken into account for remediation plan as well as Natural and Community Resource Augmentation Plan. 7. The SEAC have in its meeting held on 08.11.2021 have recommended for grant of EC after compliance of the specific conditions in terms of the provisions of the MoEF&CC, Govt. of India notification dated 14.03.2017 and other stipulated conditions. The EC shall be issued by the SEIAA after receipt of relevant bank guarantee towards cost of remediation plan and natural and community resource augmentation plan i.e. an amount of Rs.4,57,300.00/- (Rupees Four lakhs fifty seven thousand and three hundred only). 8. The proposed project falls under Item - 5(d) Man-made fibres manufacturing in the 'Project or Activities' listed within the Schedule to the EIA notification,2006 and is a Category "B" Project. The proposed IOCL is proposing to set up a900 TPD Continuous Polymerisation (CP) unit with downstream units of 500TPD Partially Oriented Yarn (POY)/ Draw Texturized Yarn (DTY), 100TPD Full drawn Yarn (FDY)&300TPD Polyester Staple Fibre (PSF). 


