Deliberation & Decision of SEIAA

The proposal of SEAC dated 11/06/2021 was discussed and refere back to SEAC on 29.06.2021 for the verification of wastewater treatment scheme, conveyance system for the same and change in hydraulic load of existing pipeline.

SEAC re cosidered the proposal in its meeting dated 29.07.2021 and 10.12.2021 and found the submision of treatemet components as Equilisation tank, Mixing channel, Chemical Dosing, Clarifier, Disposal sump, Guard pond satisfactory. For conveyance of treated effluent PP presented that 1 MLD effluent will be received through tankers and 34 MLD through pipeline. It was also noted by SEAC that the MOEF&CC has given CRZ clearance on 21.08.2015 for discharge of 75 MLD effluent through pipeline (40 MLD from ankleshwar panoli and 35 MLD from Jhagadia). SEAC found the submission satisfactory aproppos, recommended the proposal on 12.01.2022 for grant of EC.

After detailed deliberation, the Environment Clearance is Granted incorporating all the conditions stipulated by SEAC, including the additional conditions prescribed below.

- a) A full-fledged analytical laboratory at site for finger print and comprehensive analysis shall be setup at site.
- b) A area of TSDF site shall put up boards of danger area zone at prominent places.
- c) Project proponent shall install all environment management systems as per the CPCB/GPCB directives regarding the effluent discharge and air emission in working condition.
- d) Project proponent shall display the copy of Environment Clearance at the site prominently.
- e) Project proponet shall prepare and follow regular and preventive maintenance plan. The copy of same shall be submitted to SEIAA.
