Minutes of the 29th Meeting of the SEIAA, Assam held on 04/05/2022

The 29th Meeting of the SEIAA, Assam was held at the SEIAA office on 04/05/2022 at 4.00 p.m.

Agenda Item 1.

Actions on the recommendations of 34th Meeting of SEAC held on 09th April, 2022.

1. **Proposal of EC for mining of Stone from the “Gopeswar Stone Quarry No. 3” under North Kamrup Division Forest proposed by Dhariwal Buildtech limited. SEIAA.2048/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/258068/2022).**


SEAC Resolution 34/2:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of stone from the “Gopeswar Stone Quarry No. 3” under North Kamrup Division Forest proposed by Dhariwal Buildtech limited is placed before the SEAC for review, detail appraisal and deliberation. The reply of EDS is appraised. Letter issued by the MoEF&CC dt. 18th Feb.2018 issued relating to diversion of forest land is discussed. Discussed the mining plan approved by the DGM, Assam, recommendation of the DFO, NK Division. Considering the above and urgency of the work, the SEAC is recommended the proposal approving to *extract 163000 cu.m stone from the Gopeswar Stone Quarry No. 3 under NK Forest Division within a period of two years. Annual extractable quantity of stone approved is 81500 cu.m* subject to strictly adhering all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. The mine out materials shall *exclusively be used for Govt. construction of 6 lane Flyover at Boragaon, Lokhora and Basistha junction along with six lane approach from section ch. K.M. 146+172 to K.M. 162+620 on Guwahati Bypass.*

The Divisional Forest Officer, North Kamrup Forest Division is requested to mark the proposed mine area on the ground fixing boundary pillars before actual mining operation. He shall also ensure necessary surveillance to avoid pilferage and irregularities during mining period. Further, he is also requested to ensure that all the terms and conditions are duly comply by the project proponent.





2. **Proposal of EC for mining of Sand from “DBR/42/Buridehing/ Napam than Gaon/Sand Mining Permit Area for 2021-23” under Dibrugarh Forest Division proposed by Mitali Gogoi. SEIAA.2039/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/ 251146/2022).**

SEAC Resolution 34/3:

The project proposal asking mining of river bed sand from “DBR/42/Buridehing/ Napam than Gaon/Sand Mining Permit Area for 2021-23” under Dibrugarh Forest Division proposed by Mitali Gogoi is placed before the SEAC for review and detail appraisal. Necessary reply furnished by the proponent on EDS has been discussed. The mining plan approved by the DGM, Assam and the requisite documents including the recommendation of the DFO concerned is discussed. After a thread bare deliberation, the committee recommended the proposal to *extract 26000 cu.m. sand from the proposed site at Buridehing river within a period of three (3) years with the condition that there should maintain a non mining zone of 30 meter width from the high bank on both sides of the proposed area. If necessary, the DFO, Dibrugarh Forest Division will reconstruct the site maintaining 2.9 hect. mining area before allowing actual operation. The proponent is allowed to extract 13000 cu.m. sand from the approved site per year strictly following all other terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.*

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dibrugarh Forest Division is requested to reconstruct the mining site keeping 2.9 hect. mining area as mentioned above and mark the boundary accordingly fixing boundary pillars before allowing actual operation. He is also requested to ensure due surveillance to avoid pilferage and irregularities during the mining operation.

3. **Proposal of EC for mining of quartzite from “Quartzite Mining Contract unit at Arting Block- 1, under West Karbi Anglong District proposed by Smt. Priyanka Baruah. SEIAA2059/2021. (SIA/AS/MIN/258592/2022).**

Resolution 34/4:

The project proposal requesting EC for mining of quartzite from “Quartzite Mining Contract unit at Arting Block- 1,” under West Karbi Anglong District proposed by Smt. Priyanka Baruah is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and deliberation. Requisite documents furnished by the proponent in support of her proposal are scrutinized. The LOI issued by the DGM, Assam vide letter No. GM/MM/494/7145-50 dt. 13th Feb. 2020 is discussed. The Mining Plan is approved by the DGM, Assam and communicated vide letter dt. 18th March, 2020 recommending extracting 35520 cu.m. quartzite for five years. Approval of the Principal Secretary, KA Autonomous Council, Diphu communicated vide letter no. KACC/E&F/99/Permit-MM/Quartzite/2017-2019 dt. 16th Dec, 2019 has also been discussed. The committee after detailed discussion recommended the project proposal approving to *extract 35500 cu.m. quartzite from the proposed mining site within a period of 5 (five) years. The proponent is allowed to extract 7100 cu.m. quartzite annually from the approved site strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. In addition to the above, utmost care and adequate measures should be adopted by the proponent so that neither the natural drainage is disturbed nor its water gets polluted in course of mining.*

The Divisional Forest Officer, Karbi Anglong West Division, Diphu is requested to ensure necessary surveillance on the mining operation to avoid any pilferage and irregularities during the mining period. The proposed mining site be marked on the ground fixing boundary pillars as per GPS coordinates mentioned in the approved mining plan before allowing actual mining operation.

4. Proposal asking EC for mining of stone from “Jatinga River Minor Mineral Unit (Stone), proposed by the Divisional Forest Officer Cachar Division, Silchar. SEIAA.2025/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/ 252225/2020)

SEAC Resolution 34/5:

The project proposal submitted by the Divisional Forest Officer, Cachar Forest Division, Silchar requesting EC for mining of river bed stone from “Jatinga River Minor Mineral Unit (Stone) is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and detail discussion. The proposed mining area is 4.36 hect. falls in the Jatinga River. Appraised the proposal and scrutinized the requisite document furnished by the proponent. Request of the DFO, Cachar Division submitted vide letter No. B/7(ii)/AMMCR/5578-79 dt. 2nd Nov. 2021 and even no. dt. 19th January 2022 is discussed in detail. Approved mining plan is also deliberated. Considering all the aspects, the committee recommended the proposal approving to *extract 50000 cu.m. river bed stone within a period of two years subject to the condition that the proposed mining area should be shifted to the other bank of the river leaving a distance of at least 10 meter away from the high bank.* The DFO, Cachar shall arrange marking the proposed mining site on the other bank as advised above measuring 4.36 hect. mining area. The proponent is allowed to *extract 25000 cu.m. stone from the mining site annually* strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Cachar Forest Division shall mark the mining location of the ground fixing boundary pillars recording the GPS coordinates measuring 4.36 hect mining area and the new GPS points has to be intimated to this office for record. The DFO will ensure due surveillance to check pilferage and other irregularities during the mining period. The mining materials shall be utilized exclusively against Govt. developmental works only.

The proposal requesting EC for the proposed “Residential Building at Tarun Nagar, Guwahati by M/s Protech Housing Pvt. Ltd is placed before the SEAC for review, appraisal and detail discussion. Appraised the proposal and scrutinized the documents including the reply of EDS/ ADS submitted by the proponent. The consultant was invited to give presentation on different activities proposed therein before the Hon’ble Members of the committee. Accordingly presentation is given and participated in the subsequent deliberation. The site of the proposed project has already been inspected by a subcommittee of the SEAC and report has also been discussed. The committee after thorough deliberation recommended the project proposal approving to grant EC suggesting the following additional conditions that has to strictly be adhered by the proponent in course of execution.

- 1. The storm water pumping system should have 6 inch. dia. pipe instead of 4 inch dia.*
- 2. The rainwater harvesting to the aquifers should be done from roof top rain water only. UV lighting system is required in the rain water harvesting peat to kill bacteria and microbes that may enter into the peat. This will reduce the chances of contamination (bacterial) of aquifer water.*
- 3. The building should be registered with IGBC.*

6. **Proposal asking EC for mining of stone from “Hidipi (Saijang) P.P. Land Stone Mining Contract Area” under Karbi Anglong East Forest Division, Diphu proposed by Sri Rupsing Kro. SEIAA.1825/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/ 224594/2021).**

SEAC Resolution 34/8:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of stone from “Hidipi (Saijang) P.P. Land Stone Mining Contract Area” under Karbi Anglong East Forest Division, Diphu proposed by Sri Rupsing Kro is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Scrutinized the documents submitted by the proponent. Replies furnished by the proponent on EDS have also been appraised. Approved mining plan, LOI issued by the concerned DFO is discussed. Detailed deliberation is held. The committee after thread bare deliberation recommended the proposal approving for issuance of EC for mining of 15000 cu.m stone from the proposed mining site within a period of **three (3) years**. The proponent is allowed to *extract 5000 cu.m. stone annually* from the approved mine site strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. Further, *the proponent should take utmost care with adequate measures so that neither the natural drainage is disturbed nor its water gets polluted in course of mining.*

The Divisional Forest Officer, Karbi Anglong East Division, Diphu is requested to ensure necessary surveillance on the mining operation to avoid any pilferage and irregularities during the mining period. The proposed mining site be marked on the ground fixing boundary pillars as per GPS coordinates mentioned in the approved mining plan before allowing actual mining operation.

The proponent is allowed to *extract 10000 cu.m. stone per year* strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Nagaon Forest Division, Nagaon is requested to mount due surveillance on the mining operation to check any pilferage and irregularities during the mining period. The proposed mining site be marked on the ground fixing boundary pillars as per GPS coordinates mentioned in the approved mining plan before allowing actual mining operation.

8. **Proposal of E.C for mining of sand from “Bhogdoi River Sand Mining Permit Area, Da-Gayan Gaon”, under Jorhat Forest Division proposed by Sri Gautam Bora. SEIAA. 2018/2022, (SIA/AS/MIN/253364/2022)**

SEAC Resolution 34/12:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of sand from “**Bhogdoi River Sand Mining Permit Area, Da-Gayan Gaon**” under Jorhat Forest Division proposed by Sri Gautam Bora is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Scrutinized the documents submitted by the proponent along with the proposal. Reply of EDS has also been appraised. Recommendation of the DFO, Jorhat dt. 17-01-2022 as well as the approved mining plan is discussed in detailed. The committee after detailed deliberation recommended the project proposal approving to *extract 5000 cu.m. sand from the proposed mining site in two years subject to the condition that at least 10 meter distance from the high bank of both sides of the river be kept a non mining zone to avoid river bank erosion. The proponent is allowed to extract 2500 cu.m. sand annually strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.*

The Divisional Forest Officer, Jorhat Forest Division is requested to mount due surveillance on the mining operation to check any pilferage and irregularities during the mining period. The DFO, Jorhat shall ensure that the proposed mining site be marked on the ground as discussed above fixing boundary pillars and recording the GPS coordinates before allowing actual mining operation.

SEAC Resolution 34/33:

The proposal for modification of EC against mining of stone from “Arang stone minor mineral unit No-2 under Karimganj Division proposed by the DFO, Karimganj Forest Division is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. The report of the DFO, Karimganj Division dt. 20th Nov. 2021 is discussed in detail where he is asking additional quantity from reserved estimation to cater the demand of the Govt. department in his jurisdiction. The validity of the original EC will be expired on 19th Nov. 2023 issued in favour of Smt. Sunita Roy. NOC issued by the original proponent and approved mining plan is discussed. 
SEAC Resolution 34/34:
