Category: B2 at par with B1.

The proposed project is for mining of Road metal & Building stone in an area of 6.080 Ha, with a proposed production quantity of 1,31,100 m<sup>3</sup>/annum with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The project proponent and their consultant, M/s. Pragathi Labs & Consultants Pvt Ltd., have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:

- a. The Department of Mines and Geology vide order dt 23.08.2023. issued Extension of Lol to the subject mine for a period of 10 years subject to submission of Approved Mining Plan, EC and CFE within a period of 01 years from the date of issue of Lol.
- The project proponent not submitted valid letter of Intent (LoI) uploaded in Parivesh Portal. Hence, committee recommended to raise ADS for submission of Extension of Letter of Intent.
- c. This proposal was placed in 246<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and then the Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for submission of Extension of Letter of Intent.
- d. Accordingly, the PP vide letter dt. Submitted Extension of Lol 22.02.2025 for a period upto 22.08.2025.
- e. As per the approved mining plan dt. 24.07.2021 the total available mineral reserves are 12,67,678 m³. The proponent proposed to excavate – 1,31,100 m³/annum. The Life of the mine is 10 years.
- f. The project proponent has obtained Standard TOR with public hearing letter on 04.04.2022 and public hearing was

- held on 14.11.2023.
- g. Details of the public hearing: Village developmental activities issues, Environmental compensation issues and employment issues and there are no specific issues raised during the public hearing.
- h. The committee observed working pits in the mine lease area and which is prior to LoI issued and working details were mentioned in the approved mining plan.
- i. The base line data was collected from March,2022 to May 2022 and the predominant wind direction is observed to be West to East. The maximum concentration of SPM(PM10) is observed to be 68 μg/m3. The incremental concentration for individual mine is 6.1 μg/m3 and GLC of SPM will fall within the mine lease area. The committee observed discrepancy in monitoring stations of AAQ data. Hence, committee directed the project proponent to submit revised data.
- j. This proposal was placed in 261<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting and the Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, mining plan, MoEF&CC Notifications & Oms, EIA report, PH minutes and detailed deliberations, Recommended to Raise ADS for submission following:
  - The Project proponent shall submit revised AAQ data.
  - The project proponent shall submit District Survey Report-2023.
  - Clarification letter from Mining Department on the working pits,
- k. Accordingly, the PP submitted ADS reply and again, this proposal is placed in 267<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and committee noted that:
- The Project proponent submitted revised AAQ modelling data.
- The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of Anathapuram District. The same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting and observed that the mineral details mentioned at Page No 66 of DSR Report.
- The PP vide letter dt.18.06.2025 submitted clarification letter and wherein following were noticed:
- Within the Lol subject precise area one old worked out pit existed which covered with grass and small herbs is noticed and it is unable to ascertain the measurement of the pits
- ii. No fresh workings were noticed in the precise area. On verification of the records it is construed that, the pit was developed before the filling the application and also the Thasildar Bommanahall mandal has stated that one old worked out pit was existed in the apaplied area with

- measurements approximately 75\*35\*22 meters.
- iii. One verification of the Grant proposal of the subject area for grant of quarry lease, the then surveyour has also depicted the same in the demarcated sketch.
- iv. On enquir with local villagers and office records it is construed that the old pits was developed by the Vadderas and supplied the building stone & Road metal for construction of houses and lying of roads undertaken by the Government Department respectively to meet their livelihood.
- I. The project proponent informed that they have allocated Rs. 8.0 Lakhs as capital cost and Rs. 3.0 Lakhs as a recurring cost budget for the EMP. The proponent volunteered to provide 2 Steel Portable Toilet for women & sports kit at MPUPS school of Nemkal village as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity and shall maintain till the life of the mine.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, mining plan, MoEF&CC Notifications & Oms, EIA report and detailed deliberations, Recommended SEIAA to issue Environmental Clerance for the mining of 1,31,100 m³/annum over a period of 10 years, covering an area of 6.080 hectares, in favor of Sri T.V.S. Kantha Rao at Sy No. 253, Nemkal Village, Bommanahal Mandal, Anantapuramu District. The recommendation is subject to the following additional conditions:

- The proponent shall comply with the proposals furnished in the Environmental management plan and EIA report.
- The project proponent shall develop greenbelt of 1km along approach roads & village Roadsides.
- The project proponent shall maintain 7.5mt greenbelt in buffer zone and existing buffer zone plantation should not be disturbed.
- The proponent shall take dust suppression measures to meet the CPCB stipulated ambient air quality standards at any point of time.
- The proponent shall carryout suppression of dust generated due to transport vehicles by continuous water spraying using tankers.
- The vehicles carrying the mines material shall be covered with tarpaulin during vehicular movement.
- The project proponent shall not use village road for mineral transportation purpose.
- The project proponent shall restrict vehicles movement during the peak hours to avoid accidents.
- The project proponent shall comply with the commitments made during public hearing.

The proposed project is for mining of Road metal & Building stone in an area of 1.0 Ha. with a proposed production quantity of 17,885 m<sup>3</sup>/annum with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The project proponent and their consultant, M/s. Pragathi Labs & Consultants Pvt Ltd., have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:

- m. The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of Anathapuram District. The same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting and observed that the mineral details mentioned at Page No 66 of DSR Report.
- The PP vide letter dt.18.06.2025 submitted clarification letter and wherein following were noticed:
- Within the Lol subject precise area one old worked out pit existed which covered with grass and small herbs is noticed

- and it is unable to ascertain the measurement of the pits.
- No fresh workings were noticed in the precise area.
- On verification of the google images, before submission of proposals of the subject area for grant of quarry lease, the then surveyor has not depicted the same in the demarcated sketch but submitted google image sketch which shows pit existing within the precise area.
- On enquir with local villagers and office records it is construed that the old pits was developed by the Vadderas and supplied the building stone & Road metal for construction of houses and lying of roads undertaken by the Government Department respectively to meet their livelihood.
- As per the approved mining plan dt. 24.07.2021 the total available mineral reserves are 178565 m<sup>3</sup>. The proponent proposed to excavate – 17885 m<sup>3</sup>/annum. The Life of the mine is 10 years.
- p. The project proponent informed that they have allocated Rs. 5.46 Lakhs as capital cost and Rs. 3.5 Lakhs as a recurring cost budget for the EMP. The proponent volunteered to provide water treatment plant to Nemkal village as a part of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) activity and shall maintain till the life of the mine.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, mining plan, MoEF&CC Notifications & Oms, EIA report and detailed deliberations, Recommended SEIAA to issue Environmental Clerance for the mining of 17,885 m³/annum over a period of 10 years, covering an area of 1.0 hectares, in favor of T. Bhargavi Sy. No. 253, Nemkal (V), Bommanahal (M), Ananthapur District. The recommendation is subject to the following additional conditions:

The Authorized person of the project and their consultant M/s. Team Labs, Hyderabad have attended the meeting and presented the proposal. The SEAC committee noted that:

- The project proponent applied for Surrender of Environmental clearance application.
- b. As per the OM 29.03.2022 the project proponent required to submit following documents:
- Details of the EC granted.
- Details of the consents obtained from state PCB.
- Implementation of status of EC.
- Reasons for surrender of EC.
- Satellite image of the project site condition.
- Factual report by SPCB.
- Time bound action plan for dismantling & Decommissioning of plant by an accredited agency.
- Undertaking in a prescribed template by the authorized signatory of company in a non-judicial stamp paper to comply with the env. Liability.
- c. However, the project proponent not furnished Factual report by SPCB. Hence, committee directed the project proponent to submit ADS for submission of Factual report by SPCB.
- d. This proposal was placed in 251<sup>st</sup> SEAC meeting and the Committee after examining the project proposals,

presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for submission of following:

- Factual report by SPCB.
- A brief statement summarizing the eight points mentioned above.
- Accordingly, the PP submitted ADS reply and again, this proposal was placed in 267<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and committee noted that:
- The APPCB vide letter dt.11.06.2025 submitted Factual report and observed the following:
- In the proposed site 3 Nos of sheds were established.
- In one of the shed a small reactor of 0.5 KLD capacity was insalled.
- The industry has not installed process blocks.
- The industry has not installed any Boiler, D.G set, ETP in the proposed site.
- There is no industrial activity in the proposed site.
- The Project Proponent (PP) did not submit an action plan for dismantling and decommissioning of the plant by an accredited agency. Instead, the PP has requested the Committee to permit the use of the existing sheds for future developmental activities.

K.K PHARMAA under the provisions of Ministry's OM IA3-22/10/2022-IA-III dated 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022.

The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended SEIAA to issue Surrender of Environmental Clearance by M/s. K.K PHARMAA located at Plot Nos 78,79,86 and 87 APIIC, Auto Nagar, Industrial Park, Jagaaiahpeta, Krishna District.

**Decision of SEIAA:-** Agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to accept the surrender of Environmental Clearance with a condition that the proponent shall dismantle reactor and any other installations pertaining to the proposed activity.

The proposed project is for mining of Road Metal & Building Stone in an area of 4.717 Ha. with a proposed production quantity of 66725 Cum/Annum with a condition that the total production during a scheme should be limited to the approved quantity as per Mining scheme/ plan.

The proposed project falls under Item No. 1(a) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006 and its amendments thereof - (i). Mining of minerals (≤250 ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).

The project proponent and their consultant, M/s. Pollucare Engineers India Private Limited have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:

- a. This proposal was placed in 252<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting and then, the project proponent and also their consultant have not attended the meeting and the committee recommend to defer for ADS seeking reasons for not attending the meeting and also to place this case only after the project proponent request the SEAC to place their proposal in the future SEAC meeting.
- b. The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of Alluri Seetharamaraju District. The same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting and observed that the mineral details available at Page No 91 of DSR Report.
- c. The Department of Mines and Geology issued letter of Intent (LOI) vide order dt. 15.07.2023 for a period of 10 years subject to submission of Approved Mining Plan, EC and CFE within a period upto 03 years from date of issue of LoI.
- d. The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter dt 30.07.2024 issued by the Department of Mines & Geology, there no existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. The total cluster area is < 5.0 Ha.</p>
- e. As per the approved mining plan dt. 21.06.2024 the total available mineral reserves are 668865m³. The proponent proposed to excavate 66725 Cum/Annum. The Life of the mine is 10 years.
- f. The committee on viewing KML file uploaded in the Parivesh Portal, observed that small portion of the proposed mine lease area is overlapping with Telangana State boundary.

- g. The PP submitted ENDORSEMENT letter dt.03.01.2025 issued by the Tahsildar, Yetapaka Mandal and wherein stated that as per the Google Earth/Google maps verification and stated that lease boundary overlapping with Telangana State Boundary. However in our verification of Reveneu Records FLT/FMB sketches, the proposed quarry lease at sy. No. 45/1, 46/2 & 46/4 in Kannaigudem Village of Yetapaka Mandal, Alluri Sitharama Raju District.
- h. The committee observed old working pits in the mine lease area. Hence, committee recommended to raise ADS for submission of action taken report.
- i. This proposal was placed in 262<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting and the Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for submission a clarification letter from the Department of Mines & Geology regarding the operations within the mine lease area. Additionally, the proponent is required to provide a detailed action taken report addressing any illegal activities.
- j. Accordingly, the PP submitted ADS reply and again, this proposal was placed in 262<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting and noted that:
- The PP vide letter dt 24.05.2025 submitted clarification letter issued by the DMGO, Paderu, Alluri Seetharama Raju District and wherein action taken report and earlier lease details were not mentioned clearly. Hence, committee recommended to raise ADS for submission a clarification letter from the Department of Mines & Geology regarding the operations within the mine lease area. Additionally, the proponent is required to provide a detailed action taken report addressing any illegal activities.
- k. This proposal was placed in 262<sup>nd</sup> SEAC meeting and the Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended to raise ADS for submission a clarification letter from the Department of Mines & Geology regarding the operations within the mine lease area. Additionally, the proponent is required to provide a detailed action taken report addressing any illegal activities.
- I. Accordingly, PP submitted ADS reply and again, this proposal was placed in 267<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and committee noted that:
- The PP vide letter dt. 26.06.2025 submitted clarification letter and wherein states that as per records of this office, earlier 02

renewal of quarry leases for stone & Metal area having inj Sy.No.45 of Kannaigudem village, Bhadrachalam Mandal, Khammam District for a period of 20 years each and they were operated within the subject survey numer/within the eauction proposed area of Sri P. Tirupathi Rao. Further informed that, as per SEIAA objections of the workings noticed in the LoI area through which operated by Sri Banavath Laxmana and Sri Pokala Srinivasa rao, the both lease holders excavated area is worked pits upto ground level are waterlogged area condition is 16,738 Sqmt.(within the subject proposed area) and depth of the pit cannot be measures as the pits is water logged and also informed that, there no fresh workings and any existing pits in the LoI issued area of Sri Penuballi Tirupathi Rao for grant of guarry lease over an extent of 4.717 Ha in Sy.No. 45/1,46/2& 46/4 of Kannaigudem village, Yetapaka Mandal, Alluri Sitharamaraju District.

The project proponent and their consultant M/s. SV Envior labs have attended the meeting and presented the proposal. The SEAC committee noted that:

- a. The SEIAA, A.P., vide order dt. 02.05.2013 issued Environmental Clearance to subject mine for mining of Black Galaxy granite 6408.6 m<sup>3</sup>/annum. This order is valid up to the life of 12 years or expiry date of mine lease period issued by the Government of A.P., whichever is earlier.
- The Department of Mines and Geology issued work order dt. 03.03.2008 and the same is valid upto 02.03.2028.
- Now the project proponent applied for Extension of EC on 12.05.2025 and reduction of production capacity.
- d. As per the mining plan dt. 17.04.2025 the total available mineral reserves are 566277 m<sup>3</sup>. The Life of the mine is 69 years.
- The project proponent vide letter dt. 10.05.2025 submitted production and dispatch details issued by District Mines and Geology office. Permits within in limits only.

- f.
