The petitioner has filed EC application for production capacity of 6,174 m³/annum to the SEIAA, A.P. vide applications submitted on 19.01.2013.
- b) The EC applications had placed in the SEAC, A.P. meetings held on 19.03.2013. During the consideration of the said proposal, it emerged that, the project proponent started mining operations without obtaining necessary Environmental Clearance. This amounts to violation of EIA Notification, 2006 and its amendments there of. Hence, action shall be taken in accordance with the provisions laid under the OM dt. 12.12.2012 & 27.06.2013 issued by MoE&F, GOI, New Delhi.
- c) The SEAC has issued a notice to the proponent and directing to submit a written commitment duly complying with the procedure indicated in the Office memorandum dt: 12.12.2012 issued by the MoE&F, GoI, New Delhi.
- d) The Project proponent has submitted the written commitment letters vide Lr. dt: 23.08.2013 to the SEIAA, A.P.
- e) The SEIAA A.P. addressed a letters to the Special Chief Secretary to Government, EFS&T Department, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, Secretariat, Hyderabad on 02.01.2014 for initiating credible action on the violation by invoking powers under section 19 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for taking legal action under Section 15 of the Act for the period for which the violation has taken place. Also requested to inform the evidence of the credible action taken in the matter for further consideration of the proposal for issue of EC.
- f) The industry filed Writ Petition (W.P.No.32983 / 2013) in Hon'ble High Court against the Mines Department and SEIAA. Hon'ble High Court passed orders on 13.12.2013 directing SEIAA *"to consider the said application (i.e. Environmental Clearance application dt.19.01.2013 of the industry) and pass orders thereupon in accordance with law at the earliest, in any event within one month time from the date of receipt of a copy of the order"* and disposed the Writ Petition i.e. W.P.No.32983 / 2013.
- g) The industry submitted representation on 18.12.2013 enclosing Hon'ble High Court orders dated:13.12.2013 for issue of Environment Clearance.
- h) In response to the industry's representation, it was informed on 15.01.2014, that the SEIAA had requested the State Government to initiate credible action against the industry and Environmental Clearance applications of the industry will be further processed only after receipt of evidence of the credible action taken by the State Government. It was also informed to the industry that as per MoEF office memorandum dt.27.06.2013 they have to close down mining operations with immediate effect till Environmental Clearance is obtained. It was also informed to the industry that the time of SEIAA, AP expired on 25.10.2013.

- j) The representation of the industry was again placed in the SEAC, A.P. meetings held on 27.11.2014. The representative of the Project Proponent has attended the meeting, being called vide his letter informing that the Hon'ble High court had ordered for issue of EC within one month. The representative of the proponent could not produce any documents in support of the said claim. After detailed discussion the committee recommended that SEIAA has to address the Government for expedition of credible action against the project proponent.
