- The Department of Mines and Geology submitted DSR of **Annamayya** District. The same is reviewed in the SEAC meeting and observed that the mineral details mentioned at Page No 86 of DSR Report.
- The project proponent vide letter dt. 07.02.2025 submitted dispatch details issued by the Department of Mines and Geology, Madanapalle, Annamayya District.
- The Department of Mines and Geology vide letter dt. 24.09.2012 issued Lease deed executed and work order to the subject mine for 20 years.
- The Committee noted that as per the cluster letter dt 23.10.2024 issued by the Department of Mines & Geology, there are 07 existing quarry leases within the radius of 500 mtrs area. The total cluster area is 25.71 Ha which is > 25 Ha.
- The project proponent requested the committee to raise ADS for submission of revised cluster letter as the few leases in the cluster mines have obtained Environmental clearance before 15.01.2016 but it was not reflected in the cluster letter. Hence, committee recommended for ADS.

d. This proposal was placed in 254<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and then the Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, mining plan, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended **to raise ADS for** submission of revised cluster letter.

e. Accordingly, the project proponent submitted ADS reply on 08.03.2025 and again, this proposal was placed in 256<sup>th</sup> SEAC meeting and noted that:

Mining of minerals (<math>\leq 250</math> ha of mining lease area in respect of non-coal mine lease).</p> <p>The project proponent and their consultant, M / s . <b>VVN Technologies Pvt Ltd</b>, have attended the meeting and presented their proposal. The SEAC Committee noted that:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The SEIAA, A.P., vide order dt. 11.12.2007 issued Environmental Clearance to Subject mine, for mining of Iron Ore –1,20,000 TPA. This order is valid for a period of 8.5 years as the life of the mine is 8.5 years only. i.e., EC order valid upto 10.06.2016.</li> <li>The Department of Mines and Geology vide order dt. 07.01.2008 issued execution proceedings to Subject mine for a period of 20 years i.e., upto 06.01.2028.</li> <li>The committee verified KML map plan and observed no mine leases within 500m radius lease.</li> <li>As per the Indian Bureau of mines (IBM) approved mining plan, dated 21.03.2024, the estimated/minable reserves are 521,630.71 tons. The proposed production is 70,288 tons per annum(Maximum), with an anticipated mine life of 4.34 years.</li> <li>During, the meeting the project proponent requested the committee to issue Start ToR with exemption Public hearing as the hey have already conducted Public hearing on 05.11.2007 for mine lease area, mine lease is continuous and they have not going for any production expansion and production is reduced. The committee agreed for exemption public hearing.</li> </ol>

2. The project proponent shall prepare a detailed plantation plan including no. of species and type of species and area of land allocated for greenbelt.
3. The project proponent shall submit surface runoff prevention measures plan along with budget estimates and allocation for construction of trench along the slope sides of the boundary of the lease area to prevent surface runoff.
4. The project proponent shall submit approach road plan.
