1. **Proposal of EC for collection of Sand-gravel from “Tarajuli Sand Gravel Mahal (Dhansiri River)” under Dhansiri Forest Division proposed by Sri Gilard Basumatary. SEIAA.1877/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/235098/2021)**

**SEAC Resolution 29/2:**

The project proposal asking EC for mining of Sand-Gravel from “**Tarajuli Sand-Gravel Mahal on the river Dhansiri**” under Dhansiri Forest Division proposed by **Sri Gilard Basumatary** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Documents furnished by the proponent including the reply of ADS are scrutinized. Detailed discussion is held. Approved mining plan, recommendation of the concerned DFO and LOI issued to the proponent have been discussed. Considering all the aspects, the committee recommended the proposal approving to **extract 35710 cu. m sand and 35710 cu.m gravel manually from the proposed site within 5 (five) years.** The proponent is allowed to **extract 7142 cu.m sand and 7142 cu.m gravel per year** from the approved site strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhansiri Forest Division is requested to ensure that mining be allowed strictly within the approved area and not beyond the limit of the same. He will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. 2. **Proposal of EC for mining of Sand from "Madhura River MMU No.1 (Sand) Under Cachar Division proposed by Sri Purnam Deb. SEIAA.1828/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/225081/2021).**

**SEAC Resolution 29/3:**

The proposal requesting EC for mining of Sand from "Madhura River MMU No.1 (Sand) under Cachar Forest Division proposed by Sri Purnam Deb is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Appraised the project proposal and required documents submitted by the proponent including the reply of EDS are scrutinized. Approved mining plan and report of the DFO, Cachar Division submitted on 18<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2021 is also thoroughly discussed. The committee after detailed deliberation recommended the proposal approving to extract **75000 cu.m sand manually from the approved site within 5 (five) years period subject to the condition laid down below.**

1. There should maintain a **non mining zone** of about 100 mts distance/length along the proposed mining area between GPS co ordinates

• E-92°54'23.68" ; N- 24°54'55.70" and (b). E- 92°54'24.24" ; N-24°54'52.50" .

• A minimum 10 meter distance from the river bank along the southern side across the proposed mining area should also be kept as **non mining zone.**

The proponent is allowed to extract **15000 cu.m sand from the proposed mining site annually** strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan and adhering to the conditions quoted above.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Cachar Forest Division is requested to ensure that mining be allowed strictly within the approved area following the condition discussed above. He is requested to fix up boundary pillars on the ground to mark the proposed mining site before allowing actual operation. The DFO will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure due compliance by the project proponent on the conditions laid down there in during the pendency of the mining period.

6. **Proposal of EC for mining of ordinary earth from “Rukni River Minor Mineral Sand Mahal Rajghat Part- I under Cachar Division proposed by Sri Anjan Malakar. SEIAA1859/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/230362/2021),**

SEAC Resolution 29/14:

The project proposal asking EC for mining of Sand from “**Rukni River Minor Mineral Sand Mahal Rajghat Part- I**” under Cachar Division proposed by **Sri Anjan Malakar** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Thorough scrutiny of the documents submitted by the proponent is done. Approved mining plan, recommendation of the concerned DFO as well as reply of the EDS/ADS are discussed. The committee after detail deliberation recommended the proposal approving **to excavate manually 25000 cu.m sand and within two years with the following condition.**

- A non mining zone should strictly be maintained within the proposed mine area between the GPS coordinates E-92<sup>0</sup>49'28.92"; N- 24<sup>0</sup>31'31.47" and E- 92<sup>0</sup>49'28.51"; N-24<sup>0</sup>31'27.62".
- Minimum 10 meter width non mining zone from the high bank should be kept along the Southern side of the river (proposed site) to protect river bank erosion.
- The proponent shall have to strictly follow all other terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan.

The proponent is allowed to excavate 12500 cu.m sand from the proposed site annually strictly adhering to the conditions discussed above.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Cachar Forest Division is requested to ensure that mining be allowed strictly within the approved area and not beyond the limit of the same. He will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure due compliance by the project proponent on the conditions discussed above and laid down in the approved mining plan during the pendency of the mining period.

8. **Proposal of EC for of from "Chandighat Mineral Mineral Unit-2(Stone) Madhura River Bed under Cachar Division, Silchar proposed by Sri Debajit Deb. SEIAA.1934/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/241754/2021).**

SEAC Resolution 29/17:

The proposal asking EC for mining of river bed stone from " **Chandighat Minor Mineral Unit-2(Stone) Madhura River Bed**" under Cachar Division, Silchar proposed by **Sri Debajit Deb** is placed in the SEAC meeting for appraisal. 9. **Proposal of EC for mining of ordinary river earth from “Gabharu River Earth Mahal -- No.2” under Sonitpur West Forest Division proposed by M/S Siddhi Vinayak Service. SEIAA.1933/2021, (SIA/AS/MIN/244500/2021).**

SEAC Resolution 29/19:

The proposal asking EC for mining of ordinary earth from “**Gabharu River Earth Mahal -- No.2**”\_under Sonitpur West Forest Division proposed by **M/S Siddhi Vinayak Service** is placed before the SEAC for appraisal and discussion. Requisite documents submitted by the proponent are verified. Detailed deliberation is held. On scrutiny of the base maps etc. it is seen that the right bank of the mining site is about 20mts. away from the right bank of the river whereas land is available on the other three site of the proposed site. To guard the river bank from erosion *the committee opined to keep 50 mts distance from the right bank a non mining zone and a modified map be prepared accordingly. The modified map should be submitted to the DFO, Sonitpur West Division for his approval.* The committee after due deliberation recommended the proposal approving to **extract 20000 cu.m ordinary earth manually from the proposed site within two years with the condition that the DFO, Sonitpur West Division shall have to approved the modified map as stated above.** It is also approved to **extract 10000 cu.m. Ordinary earth from the proposed site annually** strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. The mine out materials should exclusively be utilized in Missamari for construction works of OTM ACCN & allied Facilities.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Sonitpur West Division is requested approve the modified map after physical field survey keeping same area (4.0 Hect) before allowing actual field activities. He will ensure that mining be allowed strictly within the approved area and not beyond the limit of the same. The proponent is approved to **extract 20000 cu.m stone from the proposed mining site per year** strictly following all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. The Divisional Forest Officer, Sonitpur East Division is requested to ensure that mining be allowed strictly within the approved area and not beyond the limit of the same. He will ensure due surveillance on the mining operation to avoid occurrences of irregularities during the mining period. He will also ensure due compliance by the project proponent on the conditions discussed above and laid down in the approved mining plan during the pendency of the mining period.



Considering the urgency facing by to the Govt. department for development works, the committee recommended **approving for issuance of EC in favour of the DFO, Kamrup West Division to extract manually 20000 cu.m sand from the “Batha River MCA for sand No.2” within one (1) year period.** The DFO, Kamrup West Division shall have to strictly follow all the terms and condition laid down in the approved mining plan. In addition to the above, the DFO, Kamrup West Division will ensure that the approved mine out materials be utilized exclusively for Govt. development works as per indent submitted by the development department.
