Online proposal for granting Environment Clearance was submitted on dated 30/09/2020 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 04/11/2021 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat. The hard copy was submitted by the project proponent on dated 28/01/2021.

The case was listed in 82nd meeting of SEAC, where committee deferred the case in view of the fact that the project proponent did not appeared before the committee. The Committee decided to ask the proponent to submit online applicant

requesting to list the case again for appraisal. Thereafter, the case was listed in 83rd meeting of SEAC, where committee deferred the case and decided to list the case in next meeting.


The case was again listed before the SEAC in its 86th meeting held on 15-16 Sept., 2022.

The SEAC was apprised that the project proposal is Onshore Oil and Gas Exploration, Appraisal and Early Production in Block HF-ONHP-2017/1 in Mandi & Bilaspur Districts, Himachal Pradesh. Vedanta Limited proposed to drill & appraisal wells within the present block boundary HF-ONHP-2017/1. The basic objective of exploratory drilling will be as follows:-

- To determine the presence of potential hydrocarbons.
- 2. To appraise discovered oil & gas.

It was informed that as per MOEFCC OM dated 16th January 2020, Onshore Oil and Gas Exploration and appraisal in Block HF-ONHP-2017-1 project is B2 category, therefore, the public hearing was not required. As proposed the exploratory & appraisal wells will be drilled. The typical area required for each well pad (drill site) will be approx. 300m x 300m. RoU of 30 m (approx.) width for accommodating suitable access roads connecting to well pads (drill sites), OHL and other utilities in future. The Drilling mud will be treated onsite for maximum reuse. The spent WBM drilling mud (approx. 250 to 500 m3 per well) and drill cuttings associated with WBM (approx. 250 to 750 Tons per well) & SBM (approx. 500 to 1500 Tons per well) will be temporarily stored in HDPE lined impervious pits at the well pads. All drill cuttings, spent mud and used oil and other hazardous waste will be disposed as per Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Tran-boundary Movement) Rules, 2016.


Following process is involved in the project as presented before SEAC by the project proponent:



The project proponent explained about the Quick Production Unit' Early Production Unit (2000 BFPD) as under before SEAC:







Following environmental aspects/ components of the project were also explained before the Committee:

Water Consumption/day: 87 KLD during drilling per well and 15 -18 KLD for each early production location.

Source of water: Would be sourced by Water Tankers from locally approved/ authorized sources.

Permission from CGWA or any other agency: NA. No Ground Water Wells shall be drilled for extraction water specifically for this project as the water requirement is very minimal and only for short period.

Energy Consumption: For drilling: 2950 kVA for drilling of each well and will be made available from D.G. Sets For Early Production: Gas Engine Generator (GEG) - 1 MW and 1X500 KVA DG Set for emergency use Kind of Fuel used: HSD, Natural Gas in early production Quantity of fuel used: Approx. 20 KLD for drilling

Wastewater Generated/day: 52 KLD (12 KLD Domestic, 40 KLD from drilling operation) during drilling of each well. During operation of EPUs/QPUs, approximately 225 KLD of produced water and other wastewater (Washing etc) 10 KLD will be generated along with 5 KLD domestic wastewater from each early production location.

Waste water Treatment facility has been proposed as follow:

For drilling: ETP (consisting of physicochemical treatment, Ultra filtration (UF) & RO (if needed) of 50 KLD capacity and the treated water would be used for drilling mud preparation, housekeeping, dust suppression, toilet flushing, and other misc. use. Domestic wastewater during drilling 12 KLD will be treated in STP (of 20 KLD capacity) which will be reused for plantation/ green Belt, etc.

For Early Production: Wastewater (Produced water, other wastewater from washing etc) from Early Production stage will be treated in ETP (consisting of Physicochemical treatment, ultra filtration (UF) & RO (if needed) of 250 KLD Capacity) and the treated water would be used for dust suppression, green belt etc. and also reused for injection into other purposes and the excess quantity will be disposed through abandoned deep dump well or other suitable onshore disposal medium. Mode of discharge: No Discharge to the surface. In principle, ZLD concept will be implemented.



Online proposal for granting Environment Clearance was submitted on dated 07/12/2022 and accepted by the SEIAA secretariat on dated 23/12/2022 and forwarded to SEAC secretariat.

The case was listed in 90th meeting of the SEAC held on 23-24th March, 2023.

After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the Committee, the SEAC decided to list the case in next meeting after compliance to the following observations:

- The project proponent shall resubmit details about built up area after including service areas roads, parking etc.
- 2. The project proponent shall revise and resubmit plantation plan by including local species.
- The project proponent shall recalculate and resubmit water demand, waste water recycling potential balancing details for both construction and operational phases.
- The project proponent shall ensure recycling at least 50% treated waste water through dual plumbing system
 after tertiary treatment- MBBR technology and proving the ultraviolet radiation purification.
- 5. The project proponent also under take sampling and analysis of GLC values of PM 2.5.
- The project proponent shall submit copy of MoU signed with authorized vendor for disposal of bio-medical waste which shall be generated from proposed Hospital.

The project proponent submitted the copy of Essentiality Certificate issued by Department of Housing vide letter dated 21/5/2007, clarification from TCP department vide letter dated 6/8/2022, copy of approved map clarifying difference between build up area by TCP, letter from Revenue Deptt. dated 23 July 2008 regarding approval under Section 118 of the HP Tenancy and Land Reforms act, 1972, Clarification from TCP vide letter dated 14/3/2023 stating that at present the orders of Hon'ble NGT are not applicable on the said project.

After submission of the compliance, the case was again listed in 90th meeting of the SEAC held on 23-24th March, 2023.

After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the Committee, the SEAC decided to list the case in next meeting after compliance to the following observations:

 The project proponent shall submit all the application submitted before all the competent authorities & approvals received thereof in chronological order after approval under Section 118.

 The project proponent shall submit copy of revised approval under Section 118 of HP Tenancy and Land Reforms Act, 1972 or submit clarification from the concerned department that the said approval is valid or not in view of the fact that the approval was earlier granted for the period of 2 years i.e. 23/7/2008 onwards for development and sell of plots and now it has been revised to construction and selling of buildings, villas.
