



83rd STATE EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 11.11.2016

F.462 83-04	<p>Proposed Project seeking Environmental Clearance for Periyannagalur West limestone Mines over an extent of 17.36 Ha situated in Periyannagalur West village, Ariyalur Taluk, Ariyalur District for limestone and Marl Production of 0.3MTPA by M/s. The Ramco Cements Limited – To consider EC - Reg.</p>
	<p>The Project Proponent submitted application for Environmental Clearance for - Environmental Clearance for Periyannagalur West limestone Mines over an extent of 17.36 Ha situated in Periyannagalur West village, Ariyalur Taluk, Ariyalur District for limestone and Marl Production of 0.3MTPA. by M/s. The Ramco Cements Limited under category B, schedule 1(a) by M/s. The Ramco Cements Limited.</p> <p>Terms of Reference (TOR) issued to the project for preparation of EIA report and for conducting public hearing vide Lr.No.SEIAA/TN/F.462/TOR-EXT/2012-199./dt 28.11.2012. The subject was placed in the 115th SEIAA meeting held on 25.11.2014 and ToR was further extended for a period of one year vide Lr.No.SEIAA/TN/F.462/TOR-EXT/2012-199./dt 28.11.2014 for period up to 25.11.2015. ToR was again extended in the 68th SEAC meeting held on 26.10.2015 for one year period.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 82nd SEAC and the Committee resolved to issue EC after obtaining certain additional details / clarifications. The Proponent furnished the details on 03.11.2016 and the proposal was again placed in the 83rd SEAC meeting held on 11.11.2016.</p> <p>After detailed discussion, the Committee resolved to recommend to SEIAA for EC subject to the following conditions:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To furnish :- <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i). Report on quality and quantity of ground water to be generated during mining operations and from adjoining areas and method of disposal of same. (ii). Comparative statement on normal ground water and mined out water with respect to qualities & suitability for agriculture etc for one year

period.

2. As per norms, health study should be conducted through competent/approved Health organisations and report submitted for one year.
3. Revised details for leachate generation due to mining activities along with details of collection, treatment and proper disposal shall be furnished.
4. Hydro-Geological study including Infiltration test shall be conducted by any reputed agency to estimate leachate quantity.
5. Corpus fund created should be prioritised and utilized for health issues.
6. CSR: Audited details pertaining to the present mining shall be submitted to SEIAA along with compliance report then and there.
7. Bio-diversity Management Plan for mine and buffer area shall be prepared in consultation with local DFO and submitted to SEIAA.
8. To address noise level issues vibration tests shall be conducted and submitted to SEIAA.
9. For CSR activities as per Ministry of corporate affairs notification dated 27.02.2014, amount shall be earmarked.
10. Green belt shall be provided as per norms of MoEF & CC & Gol, in consultation with local DFO.
