SEIAA observed that Point no. 28 of salient features of the project mentions:-



Areas occupied by sensitive manmade land uses (hospitals, schools, places of worship, community facilities) There are numbers of areas occupied by sensitive man made land uses within 15 km of radius Only schools, small hospital and temples are present.

This is a confusing statement. PP / consultant should clarify their statement and submit a letter from District Administration whether mining can be carried out with the presence of these sensitive man-made structures or not?
