








Minutes of the 93rd SEAC Meeting held on 11th August 2017

<p>93- 04 F.6385</p>	<p>Proposed construction of Residential apartment project by M/s. Perungudi Developers P. Ltd, M/s. Pioneer Software Park Pvt. Ltd., Madras Township Developers Pvt. Ltd., at S.No: 281/2B1A1, 282/4, 282/5, 282/6, 282/7, 283/2A1, 283/2B, 283/2C, 283/2D, Kottivakkam Village, Sholinganallur Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamilnadu – Category “B2”-8(a) Building & Construction Projects -Environmental Clearance-Regarding</p>
	<p>The Proponent, M/s. Perungudi Developers P. Ltd, M/s. Pioneer Software Park Pvt. Ltd., Madras Township Developers Pvt. Ltd., has applied for Environment Clearance for the proposed construction of Residential apartment project with built up area of 124698.89 Sq.m. at S.No: 281/2B1A1, 282/4, 282/5, 282/6, 282/7, 283/2A1, 283/2B, 283/2C, 283/2D, Kottivakkam Village, Sholinganallur Taluk, Kancheepuram District, Tamilnadu on 07.04.2017.</p> <p>The proposal was placed in the 93rd meeting of the SEAC held on 11.08.2017. Based on the presentation made by the proponent and the documents furnished, the SEAC decided to recommend the proposal for the grant of EC to SEIAA, subject to the following specific conditions in addition to the normal conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The proponent proposed to use 21 KLD of treated sewage for gardening purpose. At the same time, an untreated sewage of 147 KLD is proposed to be discharged into the CMWSSB sewer as excess sewage. The Committee interacted with the proponent regarding the possibility of additional reuse for the treated sewage and accordingly the proponent agreed to use an additional 9 KLD for gardening purpose. Thus, 30 KLD of treated sewage should be used for gardening purpose. 2. For CSR activity, Rs 50 Lakhs should be spent. Out of this, Rs 10 Lakhs should be contributed to the Corporation High School, Kondungaiyur, North Chennai for infrastructure development before the receipt of the EC. An amount of Rs. 20 Lakhs shall be contributed to the Pallikaranai Marsh Conservation Authority and the remaining Rs. 20 Lakhs shall be spent for Infrastructure facility

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	<p>in Government High School, Palavakkam before the receipt of Completion Certificate.</p> <p>3. As the water table is very shallow, it is needed that the structural fitness of the construction should take into consideration various hydraulic parameters and also the soil condition. The structural stability to be approved by the competent Authority.</p>
