1. Sand/Morrum Mining Project from Ghaghra River bed at Gata no.-Gha 6/2 Village-Kuti to Devaipipar-1, Tehsil-Gola, District-Gorakhpur, Leased Area - 36.423 Ha. File No. 4327/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/26254/2018

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through file/ document and found that notice for public hearing was published only in one daily newspaper. According to EIA notification 2006 (as amended) appendix-(iv) Procedure for Conduct of Public Hearing para 3.3.1..... "advertise the same in one major national daily and one regional vernacular daily"..... Hence SEIAA opined that nodal SEIAA shall seek the information/clarification from UP PCB in this regards.

2. **"Building Stone (Khanda, Gitti & Boulder) Mine" Project at Gata No.-218, (Khanda No.-01) at Village- Nahari, Tehsil Naraini District- Banda, U.P., Leased Area -2.0 ha. File No. 4824/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/36439/2019**

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate".



SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. If the certificate related to cluster provided by the competent authority is found false or incorrect then punitive actions as per the law shall be initiated against the authority issuing the cluster certificate".

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that during presentation the project proponent has shown a letter, letter no. 824/Khanij/2019-20 dated 09/04/2019 issued DMO Chitrakoot and addressed to SEIAA regarding clarification of lease area but the project proponent has not submitted this letter. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent should submit the same to take further action.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to defer the matter as the project proponent did not appear. The matter will be discussed only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal.



SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the cluster certificate submitted mention its Gata no.-707 village- Nathupura for area of 6.169 hac, whereas application is made for Gata No.-224, Village-Patretha, Tehsil-Charkhari, District- Mahoba. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent should submit clarification in this regard along with the relevant documents.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC but the SEIAA replaces the specific condition no-2 of annexure-2 as "If in future during the progressive mining this lease area becomes part of cluster i.e. area equal to or more than 5 ha., limited to B-1 category, then additional conditions based on the EIA conducted by the concerned lease holders shall be imposed and joint EMP shall be implemented. The lease holder shall mandatorily follow all the imposed conditions otherwise it will amount to violation of E.C. conditions. SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to consider the matter in next SEAC meeting.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to direct the secretariat to send a letter to DM Barabanki for providing the factual report of the site and a copy of the letter to DGM and project proponent for necessary action.

11. Bhawani Bux Ordinary Sand Mining in Yamuna River at Gata No.-2 Mi, Village-Mandanpur, Tehsil- Etmadpur, District-Agar, U.P., (Leased Area:7.28 Ha). File No. 4264/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/74773/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to discuss the matter after receipt of inspection report.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC that the project proponent is directed to apply online for any amendment.

13. Sand/Morrum Mining from Yamuna Riverbed at Gata No.-30/1, 30/2, Village-Chakbasantpur, Tehsil & District- Gautam Buddh Nagar, U.P., M/s Shri Pramod Kumar Rai, Lease Area-39.138 Ha. File no. 4393/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/28165/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding one specific condition as follows: "Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied".

SEIAA noted that in its meeting dated 11/05/2019 SEIAA found that SEAC has recommended that time line for public hearing has not been followed but chronological dates of event after acceptance of the application have not been mentioned in minutes of SEAC. Hence the case was referred back to SEAC for these details. SEIAA noted that SEAC has submitted chronological dates of events of the application as per the records. SEAC has not submitted the clear comments/recommendation for the disposal of EC application. Hence SEIAA opined that the case must be referred back to SEAC for clear recommendations for the disposal of the EC application.



SEIAA noted that in its meeting dated 11/05/2019 SEIAA found that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. But the address given in the minutes are different from that of proposed leased area. SEAC has corrected the details and recommended EC. Hence SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC adding one specific condition as follows:- "Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied".


16. Expansion of "Oxygen Boulevard (ITSEZ)" at Plot No. 07, Sector-144, Noida, District-Gautam Budh Nagar, U.P., M/s Oxygen Business Park Pvt. Ltd. File No. 4625/4334/Proposal No. SIA/UP/NCP/27692/2018

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC to grant the prior Environmental Clearance to the proposed project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by the SEAC. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC the SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-

- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.
- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leave trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
- 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
- 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.







- 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
- 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharged. Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be reused or discharged to municipal sewer line.
- 7- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
- 8- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.



SEIAA agreed with recommendation of SEAC to direct the secretariat to keep the letter dated 07/05/2019 of the project proponent in the records.

18. Construction of Additional Tankage at Mathura Marketing Terminal at Village- Bhainsa, Tehsil & Distt.- Mathura, U.P., M/s Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. File No. 4024/Proposal No. SIA/UP/IND2/21687/2018

SEIAA agreed with recommendation of SEAC that the project proponent must be directed to submit the NOC from TTZ authority.

19. "Residential Township" at Village- Bilwa Dohna Pritam Rai and Piperia (Ghanghora), District-Bareilly, U.P., M/s Eldeco Infrabuild Ltd. File No. 4872/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/108331/2019


SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the project. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that the total gross plot area of the project is 144128.27m² and built up area is 146543.99 m². Different size villas have been proposed on 540 plots apart from a school, 4 commercials, kiosk commercial and EWS & LIG. SEIAA noted that population details have been calculated considering 977 residential units whereas total no. of plots are 540. SEIAA also noted that 150 KLD surplus treated waste water is proposed to be discharged to nearby village for irrigation but land availability details, any MOU signed with villagers or any feasibility report regarding its use for fertirrigation is not submitted. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent should submit the clarification on these aspects.
