687th State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) meeting was convened and conducted in reference to the letter no. 1591/81-7-2022 dated 26-12-2022 of Department of Environment Forest and Climate Change, UP.

Agenda A- EC Transfer and Replies

1. **EC Transfer Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/294443/2022; File No. 5967; regarding Sand/Morrum Mining from Betwa River Bed at Gata No.-1396 G, Khand No.- 02, Village- Bhedikhurd, Tehsil- Kalpi, District-Jalaun, Uttar Pradesh**

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Arpit Gupta dated 14/12/2022 regarding the above and found that online application is not complete. Hence SEIAA opined that PP shall submit complete and correct online information.

2. **EC Transfer File No. 4237, Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/295039/2022**

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Chandrajeet Kushwaha dated 08/12/2022 regarding the above and found that online application is not complete. Hence SEIAA opined that PP shall submit complete and correct online information.

3. **EC Transfer File No. 4081, Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/72949/2018**

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Arpit Gupta dated 14/12/2022 regarding the above and found that online application is not complete. Hence SEIAA opined that PP shall submit complete and correct online information.

4. **EC Transfer File No. 451, Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/295047/2022- Sand/Morrum Mining from Betwa River Bed at Gata No.- 317 Mi, Khand No.- 03, Village- Kurauna, Tehsil- Orai, District- Jalaun, U.P., ShriDevendra Kumar Gupta., M/s Shaksham Contractors Suppliers., Area-20.242 Ha, File No.5886/5308**

EC in question was issued vide letter no. 451/Parya/ SEIAA/5886-5308/2020 dated 15.10.2020 for an annual production of 3,03,630 cum per year. Now the request for transfer of EC is for a production of 1,51,815 cum for a period of 6 months. First the

extraction quantity to be reduced from 3,03,630 cum to 1,51,815 cum and then the EC be transferred for a period of 6 months. After this transfer, original EC and transfer order both will become null and void.

SEIAA opined that Environmental Clearance will be transferred only after submission of an affidavit by project proponent and consultant that:-

- a) No legal case is pending in any Court of Law against the above area / EC proposed to be transferred.
- b) EC proposed to be transferred has not been cancelled by any Court of Law/MoEFCC/SEIAA/DEIAA.
- c) EC proposed to be transferred is valid on the date of consideration.
- d) Mine plan has been transferred in the favour of present project proponent.

Further, before issuing EC transfer letter, authorized signatory from SEIAA, UP will ensure that affidavit given by PP and consultant is correct and in case affidavit given by PP and consultant is found to be false, legal action should be initiated against them and transfer order should not be issued and in case it has been issued then it will become null and void. All EC transfer orders will be issued through online portal.

SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Devendra Kumar Gupta S/o Shri Shiv Kumar Gupta R/o 160-Om Shanti Nagar Lakshmi Gate, Thana- Kotwali, Jhansi was cancelled vide DM, Jalaun order no. 45/Khanij-MMC-30 dated 12.05.2021 and another LOI was issued to Smt. Archana Gupta W/o Devendra Gupta R/o 160-Om Shanti Nagar Lakshmi Gate, Thana- Kotwali, Jhansi for a period of 6 months and 1,51,815 cum production capacity vide letter no. 844/Khanij-MMC-30(E-tender 2022) dated 02.12.2022.

Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 451/Parya/ SEIAA/5886-5308/2020 dated 15.10.2020 from Shri Devendra Kumar Gupta to Smt. Archana Gupta W/o Devendra Gupta R/o 160-Om Shanti Nagar Lakshmi Gate, Thana- Kotwali, Jhansi for 1,51,815 cum production capacity for six months. SEIAA added following conditions:-

1. Transfer of EC is granted for a period of 6 months from the date of issue or validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier and after this the original EC and transfer order both will become null and void.
2. Permissible quantity and area shall be strictly limited to quantity and area mentioned in LOI or mining plan, whichever is lesser, and maximum mineable depth will be limited to as approved in the mining plan.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.



6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 21,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
7. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 105 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
8. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.
9. If the air quality deteriorates due to mining, then District Administration & Directorate of Mining should ensure that mining be stopped immediately. Adequate measures be taken for restoring air quality and mining should commence only when air quality attains the prescribed standards.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 451/Parya/SEIAA/5886-5308/2020 dated 15.10.2020 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void

5. EC Transfer File No. 4014, Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/295770/2022(new)-Shamsherpura Sand Mine on Betwa River at Gata No. 01, Village - Shamsherpura, Tehsil- Teharauli, District- Jhansi., Shri Ashish Yadav, (Leased Area-12.14 Ha) File No. 4014/ Proposal No. (SIA/UP/MIN/72470/2018)

EC in question was issued vide letter no. 226/Parya/SEAC/4014/2018 dated 26.12.2022 for an annual production of 1,83,000 cum. Now the request for transfer of EC is for a production of 18,000 cum for a period of 6 months. First the extraction quantity to be reduced from 1,83,000 cu to 18,000 cum and then the EC be transferred for a period of 6 months. After this transfer, original EC and transfer order both will become null and void.

SEIAA opined that Environmental Clearance will be transferred only after submission of an affidavit by project proponent and consultant that:-

- e) No legal case is pending in any Court of Law against the above area / EC proposed to be transferred.
- f) EC proposed to be transferred has not been cancelled by any Court of Law/MoEFCC/SEIAA/DEIAA.
- g) EC proposed to be transferred is valid on the date of consideration.
- h) Mine plan has been transferred in the favour of present project proponent.

Further, before issuing EC transfer letter, authorized signatory from SEIAA, UP will ensure that affidavit given by PP and consultant is correct and in case affidavit given by

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PP and consultant is found to be false, legal action should be initiated against them and transfer order should not be issued and in case it has been issued then it will become null and void. All EC transfer orders will be issued through online portal.

SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Ashish Yadav, Palar Bada Gaon , Jhansi was cancelled vide DM, Jhansi order no. 2077/30 MMC/2020-21 dated 02.02.2021 and another LOI was issued to Shri Kamlesh Kumar Sahu S/o Shri Moolchand Sahu, Nahar Ghati Chirgaon, Moth, Jhansi for a period of 6 months and 18,000 cum production capacity vide letter no. 205/MMC 30/2022-23 dated 18.05.2022.

Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 226/Parya/SEAC/4014/2018 dated 26.12.2022 from Shri Ashish Yadav, Palar Bada Gaon , Jhansi to Shri Kamlesh Kumar Sahu S/o Shri Moolchand Sahu, Nahar Ghati Chirgaon, Moth, Jhansi for 18,000 m³ production capacity for six months. SEIAA added following conditions:-

1. Transfer of EC is granted for a period of 6 months from the date of issue or validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier and after this the original EC and transfer order both will become null and void.
2. Permissible quantity and area shall be strictly limited to quantity and area mentioned in Lol or mining plan, whichever is lesser, and maximum mineable depth will be limited to as approved in the mining plan.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 13,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
7. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 65 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
8. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-

compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.

9. If the air quality deteriorates due to mining, then District Administration & Directorate of Mining should ensure that mining be stopped immediately. Adequate measures be taken for restoring air quality and mining should commence only when air quality attains the prescribed standards.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 226/Parya/SEAC/4014/2018 dated 26.12.2022 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void

Agenda B- 705th SEAC-2 Meeting Dated 25/11/2022

1. **"Sand/Morrum Mining" at Betwa River Bed Gata No.- 314, Khand – 01, Village: Manikpura, Tehsil: Moth, District: Jhansi, Shri. Chandra Pal Singh, Area: 4.75 Ha., File No. 7335/6342/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/403744/2022**

SEIAA noted that SEAC has recommended to grant EC to the above project. SEIAA gone through the file and documents and opined that since replenishment study for the above area has not been submitted yet the above project be referred back to SEAC for review and comments and a letter shall be send to DGM for replenishment study report.

2. **"Building Stone (Khanda, Giiti, Boulder, Red Morrum) Mining Project" at Gata No.: 1078, Khand No.:39, Village: Gonda, Tehsil: Karwi, District: Chitrakoot, Area: 2.024 Ha., File No. 7338/6921/ Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/406142/2022**

In light of discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022. SEIAA opined to accept the recommendation of SEAC-1 and grant EC to the said project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC-1 adding following specific conditions:-

1. Validity period of this EC is 5 years from the date of issue as the Lol has been issued for a period of 5 years or co-terminus with the validity of current mine plan or current lease period whichever is earlier. After this period the EC will become null and void.
2. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. Three tier green shelter belt of 7.5m width should be developed on the periphery of mine lease area. Local and native species should be planted in consultation with Forest/Horticulture Department/Agriculture University.
6. Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
7. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh

- water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
8. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 3,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.
 9. In consultation with District Environment Authority or an Authority nominated by concerned DM, project proponent will prepared a conservation and management plan for rejuvenation and management of water bodies having total surface area of more than 15 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six monthly compliance status will be presented by project proponent before the nominated authority in the District.
 10. Department of Geology and Mines, Government of Uttar Pradesh and / or concerned district administration, before releasing the security deposit to Project Proponent will ensure that Project Proponent has fully complied with the EC conditions. Non-compliance, if any, should be reported to UPSPCB for appropriate legal action and recovery of compensation.
 11. Any application for transfer of this EC, during its validity period unless it is cancelled by a competent authority, has to be necessarily accompanied with status of compliance of EC conditions duly certified by IRO, MoEFCC, GoI, Lucknow.
 12. Number of mining projects are coming up in district. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP to carry out regional EIA-EMP report including carrying capacity of environmental components to assess the capacity to further bear the pollution load for such areas within a period of 1 year and submit the same to SEIAA, UP for evaluation.
 13. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS in district within a period of one year and submit geo-referenced map of these stations along with data. Details of existing CAAQMS, if any, be submitted within a period of three months.
 14. Large number of mining projects are ongoing as well as new mining leases are coming up in the district. A reference be sent to DGM and MS, SPCB for preparing mitigation plan for controlling air pollution in the district especially in mining areas.
 15. If the air quality deteriorates due to mining, then District Administration & Directorate of Mining should ensure that mining be stopped immediately. Adequate measures be taken for restoring air quality and mining should commence only when air quality attains the prescribed standards.
3. **"ROMA AEROCITY" Affordable Housing under PMAY at Arazi No.-282, Vill- Dhaneshari, Harahua, Varanasi, U.P., M/s Roma Builders & Promoters Private Limited. File No. 7239/Proposal No. SIA/UP/INFRA2/406144/2022**
- In light of discussion held in SEIAA meeting no. 597 dated 05.05.2022. SEIAA opined to accept the recommendation of SEAC-2 and grant EC to the said project along with all the general and specific conditions as suggested by SEAC-2. In addition to the conditions imposed by SEAC, SEIAA added following additional specific conditions:-
- 1- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of solar power plant and solar electrification details within the project.

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- 2- The project proponent shall ensure to plant broad leaf trees and their maintenance. The CPCB guidelines in this regard shall be followed.
 - 3- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details on quantification of year wise CER activities along with cost and other details. CER activities must not be less 2% of the project cost. The CER activities should be related to mitigation of Environmental Pollution and awareness for the same.
 - 4- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of estimated construction waste generated during the construction period and its management plan.
 - 5- The project proponent shall submit within the next 3 months the details of segregation plan of MSW.
 - 6- The project proponent shall ensure that waste water is properly treated in STP and maximum amount should be reused for gardening flushing system and washing etc. For reuse of water for irrigation sprinkler and drip irrigation system shall be installed and maintained for proper function. Part of the treated sewage, if discharged to sewer line, shall meet the prescribed standards for the discharge.
 - 7- Under any circumstances untreated sewage shall not be discharged to municipal sewer line.
 - 8- The project proponent will ensure that proper dust control arrangements are made during construction and proper display board is installed at the site to inform the public the steps taken to control air pollution as per the Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules.
 - 9- The project proponent shall install micro solar power plants, toilets in nearby villages, public place or school from CER fund of the project for which E.C is granted in addition to and water harvesting pits and carbon sequestration parks / designed ecosystems.
 - 10- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
 - 11- If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
 - 12- Provision for charging of electric vehicles as per the guidelines of GoI / GoUP should be submitted within the next 3 months.
 - 13- PP should display EC granted to them on their website. 6-monthly compliance report should be displayed on their website and to be given every six month to residents / occupants of the building.
 - 14- EC is granted with the condition that EC is valid only for the building plan which has been submitted by PP for seeking EC. In case approved building plan is different from the one submitted for seeking EC then this EC will stand null and void.
4. Building stone (Sand Stone) Mining project at Arajai No 428, Village- Dhuriya, Tehsil- Chunar, District-Mirzapur, Shri Sanjay Singh, Area:2.828 Ha., File No. 7343/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 405484/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendations of SEAC- 2 to close/ delist the file as the project proponent did not appear and open only after submission of online request on prescribed online portal. A letter shall be send to DM, Mirzapur; to ensure that no mining

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activity is started until valid EC is obtained and in case mining has been carried out without valid EC then work should be stopped and legal action should be initiated against the PP.

5. Expansion of Group Housing Project "Shere Shalimar Mannat, at Village-Muhammadpur Nawabganj, District- Barabanki, M/s Shalimar Corp. Ltd, Shri Mohammad Adullah Masood. File No. 7345/Proposal No. SIA/UP/INFRA2/406404/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC to issue the additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA also added following points to ToR:-

- 1- Certified Compliance Report of the previous EC should be submitted at the time of EIA.
- 2- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 3- Copy of all the analysis reports duly signed by analyst approved by NABL or MoEF&CC shall be annexed with the EIA report and original analysis reports should be presented at the time of presentation.
- 4- MOU signed between the project proponent and the consultant should be submitted.
- 5- A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain the forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per law under the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit along with EIA.
- 6- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 7- Provision for charging of electric vehicles as per the guidelines of GoI / GoUP should be submitted.
- 8- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire ToR while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report. A presentation to this effect should be made before SEAC at the time of EIA-EMP presentation.
- 9- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.

6. Building stone Sandstone Mining project at Gata No- 21/2, Village-Latifpur Tehsil-Chunar, District-Mirzapur, Shri Ras Singh, Area 1.618 Ha., File No. 7346/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN/ 406546/2022

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of SEAC-1 to issue additional ToR to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. SEIAA added following points to ToR-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/ amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- 3- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).
- 4- Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
- 5- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.

- 6- KML file for the area and mining lease area should be provided.
- 7- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.
- 8- In case project proponent intends to temporarily store mined out material or any tools, equipments or other material outside mine lease area then NOC from competent authority for doing so should be submitted and details of such area and associated Environmental impacts should be included in EIA-EMP report. This should also be clearly mentioned during public hearing.
- 9- Road network to be used by the project should be clearly shown on Survey of India toposheet in 1:50,000 scale. In case road network involves forest road, permission should be obtained from Forest Department and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of appraisal of EIA-EMP report.
- 10- The project proponent should clearly spell out whether it is a green field or brown field project. In case it is a brown field project and -
 - (i) If the earlier and present lease holder are same then compliance report of previous EC should be submitted.
 - (ii) If the earlier and present lease holder are different then environmental footprint of the site and mitigation measures should be included in EIA-EMP report.
- 11- In case of expansion / renewal of earlier EC, following information should be submitted
 - a. Status of compliance of earlier EC conditions by Integrated Regional Office, MoEFCC, Gol, Lucknow.
 - b. Copy of CTE and CTO issued by SPCB.
 - c. Status of submission of six-monthly compliance report to EC granted earlier
 - d. Court cases, if any.
- 12- Observations raised in public hearing, replies submitted by project proponent, suitable modifications carried out in EIA-EMP report.
- 13- Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 2,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.
- 14- In consultation with District Environment Authority or an authority nominated by concerned DM, Project Proponent will prepare a conservation and management plan for the rejuvenation and management of water bodies having a total surface area of not less than 10 ha. Funds for the same will be kept in a separate bank account and six-monthly implementation status will be presented by the Project Proponent before the nominated authority in the district.
- 15- Number of mining projects are coming up in district. Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP to carry out regional EIA-EMP report including carrying capacity of environmental components to assess the capacity to further bear the pollution load for such areas within a period of 1 year and submit the same to SEIAA, UP for evaluation.
- 16- Department of Geology & Mines, GoUP in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS in district within a period of one year and submit



geo-referenced map of these stations along with data. Details of existing CAAQMS, if any, be submitted within a period of three months.

- 17- Along with the EIA-EMP report, PP / consultant will also submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed entire ToR while preparing draft EIA-EMP report for PH. Further, PP / consultant will submit in tabular form as to how they have addressed issues raised during public hearing and have incorporated the same in final EIA-EMP report. A presentation to this effect should be made before SEAC at the time of EIA-EMP presentation.
- 18- Project Proponent in consultation with UPSPCB will establish required number of CAAQMS within a period of one year and submit geo-referenced map of these stations along with data on six-monthly basis.

2. Directions/suggestions given during public hearing and commitment made by the project proponent should be strictly complied.
