<b>SIA/AP/MIS/18235/2017 (TOR)</b>	<b>The issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2021. The Committee observed the following:</b>
	<p>As per MoEF&amp;CC Notification G.S.R.343(E), dated.28.03.2016 (New Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016), Rule-17(2) stated as follows:</p> <p><i>Site for Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment and disposal facility (CBMWTF) –</i></p> <p><i>“The selection of site for settling up of such facility shall be made in consultation with the prescribed authority other stakeholders and in accordance with guidelines published by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change or Central Pollution Control Board.”</i></p> <p>As per the guidelines for Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBMWTF): coverage area of CBMWTF: - In any area, only one CBMWTF may be allowed upto 10,000 beds at the approved rate by the prescribed authority. A CBMWTF shall not be allowed to cater health care units situated beyond a radius of 150 kms. However, in an area where 10,000 beds are not available within a radius of 150 kms, another CBMWTF may be allowed to cater the health care units situated outside the said 150 km.</p> <p>In principle permission from the APPCB was not obtained.</p> <p>The project proponent submitted the TOR application through online on 11.07.2017 and requested for issue of TOR.</p>
	<p>Earlier the issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held on 21.07.2017. The Committee observed the following:</p> <p><i>The Project Proponent and their consultant M/s.Team Labs &amp; Consultants have attended the meeting and requested for TOR for proposed common bio medical waste treatment facility- 800 kg/day.</i></p> <p><i>The Committee noted that the proposed project falls under Item 7(da) of the schedule of the EIA Notification 2006- common biomedical waste treatment facility.</i></p> <p><i>The Committee recommended that the Project Proponent shall obtain In-</i></p>

The issue was examined by the SEIAA in its meeting held on 07.08.2017 and Authority noted and agreed with the recommendations of the SEAC. Accordingly a letter was sent to the proponent on 14.08.2017 to submit the information. Subsequently the project proponent submitted the information on 07.01.2020.

The issue was again examined by the SEAC in its meeting held 08.03.2020. The Committee observed the following:

The proposed project is for establishment of Common Bio-medical Treatment Facility with a treatment capacity of 800 kg/day with Incinerator – 200 Kgs/hr and Autoclave – 500 Lts. The proponent along with their consultant M/s. Team Labs and Consultants. attended the meeting and made a presentation. After detailed deliberations on the proposal, the committee recommended to seek Legal Opinion, as it was known that a case was pending in the Hon'ble High court on the issue of allotment of a plant for the Biomedical Wastes.

The issue was again examined by the SEIAA in its meeting held on 30.04.2020 and authority agreed with recommendation of the SEAC, A.P to obtain legal opinion. A letter was addressed to standing council requesting for Legal Opinion on 31.07.2020. Legal Opinion letter received from Standing Counsel on 06.10.2020

The Standing Counsel communicated his opinion vide letter dated 06.10.2020 on the three proposals and the legal opinion stated is as follows:

**“Proponents:**

- i. M/s. Teja's Enviro Care, H.No..42/ 133-3, NGO's Colony, Jayanagar, Kadapa-516002 and the Project proponent is Mr.CH.Surya Prakash Raju, Managing Director.
- ii. M/ s.AMW Consulting Limited, Survey No.4, Pachikapallam Village, Vedurukuppam Mandal, Chittoor District, Project Proponent is Mr.N.Hanumaiah, Managing Director.
- iii. M/s.Rayalaseema Environ Care, Jayanagar Colony,N.G.O Colony, YSR Kadapa (D), Andhra Pradesh, Project Proponent is Mrs.Kodathala Jayalakshmi, Managing Partner.

**Proposed Sites are:**

- i. M/s. Teja's Enviro Care, Sy.No.1125, Suddamalla Village, Ramapuram Mandal, Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh.

**M/ s.Rayalaseema Environ Care :**

Thus, out of three proponents M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care is



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proposed at Mega Industrial Park, Phase-1, Koppa, YSR Kadapa District and made an application within the parameters of S.O.1142(E) Ministry of Environment and Forests Notification dated 17.04.2015 as prescribed under Rule 7(da) and proposed the said project in the Industrial Zone. That apart, the M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care alone is the project run by a woman under the definition of Women empowerment and Entrepreneurship. The said proponent's consultant is Ramky Enviro Services Private Limited, Ramky Grandiose, Ramky Towers Complex, Gachibowli, Hyderabad-500032. This proponent's site is in the industrial Zone and well connected with rail and road transportation in accordance with the proposed terms of reference (TOR). That apart, along with the proponent's application, the proponent placed the subject land as enclosure as defined under Rule 7 (d) of EIA Notification 2006 (MoEFCC) and the intending part and the document enclosed along with the application of Plot No.66 at Industrial Park MIP, Koppa, Phase-I Kadapa District measuring 4835 Sq.mts on Out Right Sale (ORS). That gives the healthy competition and the spirit to run the CBMWTF for the larger public interest. Hence Considered.

**M/s AWM Consulting Limited:**

Then, coming to the 2nd one of M/s. AWM Consulting Limited and proposed Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility at Kurnoothala Village, Lakkireddipalle Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh and made an application within the parameters of S.O.1142(E) Ministry of Environment and Forests Notification dated 17.04.2015 as prescribed under Rule 7 (da) and proposed the said project in Kurnoothala Village, Lakkireddipalle Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh with an intention that they can pick bio-medical waste in both the districts of YSR Kadapa and Chittoor respectively. Their consultant is also Ramky. This proponent's location is 36KMs from Kadapa City. The additional information so interestingly furnished by this proponent and confirmed that he is a litigant and placed the order copy in WP, No.20059 of 2015 dated 10.07.2015. This proponent also placed another order of Appeal No.131 of 2016 (SZ) Southern Bench NGT docket order dated 02.06.2016. That shows, he is a litigant rather than service provider. That apart, he addressed that he intends to clear all the bio-medical waste from two district in his application being a proponent and this is contrary to the stand taken by the Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board through its workshop on 18.09.2018 titled as "Issues and Challenges in Safe Disposal of Bio Medical Waste", and was decided that the APPCB shall encourage establishment of at least one CBMWTF in each

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district. Thus, it is contrary to the concept of having one CBMWTF in each district, unlike the 1<sup>st</sup> proponent M/s Rayalaseema Environ Care confined to YSR Kadapa District. This proponent failed to submit the land documents, which is mandatory under Proposed Terms of Reference (TOR) as contemplate under Rule 7D and also TOR. Hence not considered.

**Teja's Enviro Care:**

This proponent is also proposed at Sy.No.1125 Suddamalla village, Ramapuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh, and made an application within the parameters of S.O.1142(E) Ministry of Environment and Forests Notification dated 17.04.2015 as prescribed under Rule 7(da) and proposed the said project in Suddamala Village, Ramapuram Mandal, YSR Kadapa District is 25 KM from Kadapa City. This proponent is a Managing Partner of Teja's Enviro Care and the PARTNERSHIP deed is not placed along with the proponent's application. That shows, the lack of sheer interest alongside failed to place the land documents to appraise the SEIAA. If the other partners do have any sort of problems due to their Partnership Firm then the Public at large will suffer. This proponent's application appears to be half hearted. Hence not considered.

**SHORTLISTING as per my legal opinion:**

I strongly canvass through this legal opinion that, M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care proponent is Smt.Kodathala Jayalakshmi being a woman. The Union of India and also the State of Andhra Pradesh is encouraging the WOMEN EMPOWERMENT IN DEVELOPING NATIONS through entrepreneurship. In India, it is lower side in comparison with the African Nations and other developing nations. The proponent M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care intending to purchase the land under the terms of Proposed Terms of Reference (TOR). The 1<sup>st</sup> criterion under the said TOR is placed hereunder for appreciation:

"1.Reasons for selecting the site with details of alternative sites examined/rejected/selected on merit with comparative statement and reasons/ basis for selection. The examination should justify site suitability in terms of environmental damages, resources, sustainability associated with selected site as compared to rejects site. The analysis should include parameters considered along with weightage criteria for short-listing selected site."

Thus, I am giving this legal opinion on sound principles of law that, M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care alone do have merit other than the two as discussed above in all aspects and M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care Entrepreneur is a Woman Entrepreneur and it would be a plus point for the said proponent in comparison with the other two proponents of M/s. AWM





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	<p>Consulting Limited and M/s.Teja's Enviro Care respectively.</p> <p><b>Conclusion:</b> Thus, on the foot of the records placed before me and on the strength of the supporting laws, I am giving this opinion that M/ s Rayalaseema Environ Care may be considered for establishing a Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility in YSR Kadapa District. Hence this Opinion."</p>
	<p>Subsequently the issue was examined by the SEAC in its meeting held 08.10.2020. The Committee observed the following:</p> <p>"The project proposal is for establishment of the Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBMWTF) by M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care at Plot No.66, Mega Industrial Park, Kopporthy, YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh.</p> <p>The Committee noted that new CBMWTF is proposed at an industrial estate designated the APIIC i.e., Plot No.66,Mega Industrial Park, Kopporthy,Kadapa,YSR Kadapa District,A.P. Presently, there is no CBMWTF in the YSR Kadapa Distric, Andhra Pradesh.</p> <p>The Revised Guidelines for Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities - issued by the CPCB, Delhi on 21st December, 2016- Rule 6(a) states that " A CBWTF shall preferably be developed in an notified industrial area without any requirement of buffer zone"</p> <p>The APPCB " Guidelines for Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment and Disposal Facilities" Rule 2(a) states that " Atleast one CBMWTF shall be allowed in each and every district of Andhra Pradesh for disposal of Bio-medical waste File No.APPCB-11/44/2020-TEC-EC-APPCB-Part(1)considering the increased bed strenght in future, coverage of veterinary hospitals under BMW Rules, reduction of the cost of the transport, biological waste &amp; discarded medicines from the industries and better administrative control over the CBMWTFs.</p> <p>" Further CPCB, Delhi issued Guidelines for Handling, Treatment and Disposal of Waste Generated during Treatment/Diagnosis/ Quarantine of COVID-19 Patients-Rev.4 on 21st July, 2020.</p> <p>New CBMWTFs are to be encouraged and the issuance of prior environmental clearance is to be expedited so as to ensure the proper collection and disposal of COVID-19 waste to reduce the impact of Noval Corona Virus(COVID-19) and also as per the guidelines issued by CPCB under BMW, Rules, 2016.</p> <p>The entrepreneurs namely M /s.AWM Consulting Limited, Kurnoothala Village, Lakkireddy Mandal , YSR District; M/s.Teja'sEnvirocare, SuddamallaVillage,Ramapuram Mandal and M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care,Plot No.66, Phase-I, Mega Industrial Park, Komparthy, Kadapa have come up with proposals for setting up CBMWTF in YSR Kadapa District, Andhra Pradesh.</p> <p>In this regard, SEIAA, A.P., obtained the legal opinion. Rayalaseema Environ Care, for establishment of CBMWTF at Plot No.66, Phase-I, Mega Industrial Park, Koparthy, Kadapa, YSR District, Andhra Pradesh."</p>
	<p>The issue was examined by the SEIAA in its meeting held on 18.11.2020, 19.11.2020 and 24.11.2020 and authority agreed with recommendation of the SEAC, A.P for issue Standard Terms of References (TOR) to M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care, for establishment of CBMWTF at Plot No.66, Phase-I, Mega Industrial Park, Koparthy, Kadapa, YSR District, Andhra Pradesh.</p>
	<p>The TOR letters were issued to M/s. Rayalaseema Environ Care, for establishment of CBMWTF at Plot No.66, Phase-I, Mega Industrial Park, Koparthy, Kadapa, YSR District, Andhra Pradesh.</p> <p>M/s Teja's Enviro Care filed a writ Petition No.4863 of 2021 in the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. The following are the respondents in the case.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The Union of India, Ministry of Environmental ,Forrest and Climate Change, Rep. 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	<p>SEAC meeting.</p> <p>The Committee noted that SEIAA addressed a letter with Letter No. SEIAAA/AP/KDP/IND/07/2017/357., dated 9.4.2021., to the project proponent informing “as per the orders of the Hon’ble high Court in WP No. 4863/2021 dated 09.03.2021, the matter is reexamined duly considering the request of Teja’s Enviro Care. It is now decided to refer the matter to SEAC for necessary action, as requested by Teja’S Enviro Care. This decision is taken in compliance of Hon’ble High Court order aforesaid”. The copy of the letter was communicated to the SEAC and requested to take necessary action in compliance of the Hon’ble High Court Order. Meanwhile, the legal opinion was sought from the Standing Counsel, SEIAA, A.P., on 30.04.2021 and the same was received on 04.05.2021. SEIAA addressed a letter to SEAC on 07.05.2021 requesting to place before ensuing SEAC,A.P., Committee for their remarks &amp; recommendations on merits on M/s. Further they have not furnished the technical feasibility report.</p> <p>The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, Legal Opinion from the Standing Counsel, MoEF&amp;CC’ Notifications &amp; OMs and Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facilities (CBMWTF) guidelines and detailed deliberations, recommended to <b>REJECT</b> this project proposal i.e., application for Terms of Reference (TOR) for setting up of new CBMWTF facility namely M/s. Director of Mines &amp; Geology (FAC), Vizianagaram, vide Lr. No.4881/Q/2006, dated: 28.08.2020 there are 06 existing quarry leases and 3 Lol issued within the radius from 500 mtrs area.</p> <p>2021. No. 01, Pedaraopalli (V), Kothavalasa (M), Vizianagaram District has filed the application for Environmental Clearance (EC) to the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Andhra Pradesh, through online on 19.04.2018 (SIA/AP/MIN/74672/2018 )under violation. The MoEF&amp;CC, GoI, New Delhi vide Notification S.O.1030(E) dated 08.03.2018 amended the Notification</p>



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S.O.804(E) dated 14.03.2017 and delegated the power to the States for appraisal of category B proposals which are under violation of EIA Notification. On 04.08.2018, the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) returned the application to the applicant through online as the applicant filed the application on 19.04.2018 i.e., after the time limit (30 days) prescribed by MoEF&CC, Govt. of India, in its Office Memorandum dated.16.03.2018. On 25.07.2020, the applicant has filed application for the Terms of reference (TOR) to the SEIAA, A.P., through online (SIA/AP/MIN/55089/2020). Subsequently, the SEIAA, A.P. sought the Essential Details from the project proponent through online on 03.08.2020, to submit the covering letter along with processing fee as per G.O. RT No.3 and approved mining plan and all relevant documents. The project proponent has filed application to SEIAA, A.P., through online on 17.11.2020 for Environmental Clearance. (SIA/AP/MIN/58379/2020). The Committee after examining the project proposals, presentations, MoEF&CC Notifications & OMs and detailed deliberations, recommended that the SEIAA, A.P., may sought legal opinion to take decision on the project proposal of 12.0 Ha Road Metal, Building Stone & Gravel Mine of M/s. Sri G. Sudarshana Rao, Sy. No.01, Pedaraopalli Village, Kothavalasa Mandal, Vizianagaram District, Andhra Pradesh.

The applicant Dr.G.Sudarsana Rao has filed a Writ Petition in the Hon<sup>ble</sup> High Court of A.P. vide WP 2536 of 2021, SR No. WPSR 2976/2021 on 01.02.2021, with the following prayer. "It is humbly prayed that this Hon<sup>ble</sup> Court may be pleased to direct Respondents to issue royalty permits by accepting the undertaking from the petitioner that he shall produce the Environment Clearance within 1 year as contemplated under the letter dated 04.11.2020 bearing No.202-MP-VZM/2020 issued by respondent No.3, pending disposal of the main writ petition and pass such other order or orders as Hon<sup>ble</sup> Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstance of the Case."
