Minutes of the 14th Meeting of SEIAA (Day-1) held on 11th October, 2023

The meeting was chaired by Shri A.R. Sinha, Chairman, SEIAA Uttarakhand and was attended by the following:

- (i) Dr. Chandra Bhushan Prasad Member, SEIAA Uttarakhand.
- (ii) Shri S.P. Subudhi, Secretary, SEIAA Uttarakhand.

The meeting started with welcome note by the Chairman. The Chairman informed that total 7 proposals (B1 & B2) are under consideration for grant of EC in this meeting. After detailed discussion and deliberation on each of the proposal as per agenda item, decision taken by the Authority is as under -

- 1) Environmental Clearance for Proposed manufacturing of Pharmaceutical Products at Khasra No- 91 & 2754, Central Hope Town & Shankarpur Hukumatpur, Tehsil- Vikasnagar, District- Dehradun by M/s Neerpath Healthcare Pvt. Ltd Online proposal No SIA/UK/IND3/445476/2023.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

No. 1161 Ka, 1167, 143 /2 (New No 1170 Ka) Mauza Ajabpur Kalan Pargana- Central Doon, Distt- Dehradun by M/s Shree Bankey Bihari Associates LLP by Shri Arvind Kumar Garg (Partner). Online proposal No. SIA/UK/INFRA2/445372/2023.

The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.

- 4) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand/Bajri/Boulder at Khasra No- 2152-2154, 2196, 2899-2914, 3003-3005, 3316, 3435, Village -Naithana, Patti- Chauras, Tehsil - Kirtinagar, District- Tehri Garhwal by M/s Kilkishwar Mining Company by Shri Satye Singh Rama, R/o- Kailash Gate Muni-Ki-Reti, District- Tehri Garhwal. (Area-9.72Ha.). Online proposal No SIA/UK/MIN/415043/2023.

The Authority examine the EIA report of above project which was prepared by Accredited consultancy firm **M/s Natureanalytica Envirocare Solutions Pvt. Ltd** and found that the consultant made it very carelessly without visiting the site and copying EIA & EMP report of other projects as submitted here. Hence, authority decided to reject the proposal and issue show cause notice to consulting agency.

- 5) Environmental Clearance for Extraction of Sand, Bajari and Boulder at Khasra No: 1195, 1196, 1197 to 1199, 1203, 1204, 1206 Vill-Ranihat, Patti- Chauras, Tehsil -Keertinagar, District- Tehri Garhwal by Smt. Sushila Devi W/o Shri Satye Singh R/o- Muni Ki Reti, District- Tehri Garhwal (Area-10.65 Ha). Online proposal No SIA/UK/MIN/415250/2023.

The Authority examine the EIA report of which was prepared by Accredited consultancy firm **M/s Natureanalytica Envirocare Solutions Pvt. Ltd** and found that the EIA is made very carelessly and nobody has visiting the field as which is evident from the following examples:-

- 1- In the area given in EIA report is where as mining plan is made for

- 2- In page no 38 of EIA report method of mining is given where mining uptill 30 mt below ground is proposed.
- 3- Land use pattern is common for other two projects is KMVN and which is impossible.
- 4- In page no 46 of EIA report cropping pattern of banda district has been given which has no relevance with this project.
- 5- Than again cropping pattern of Pauri Garhwal is given.
- 6- In para 3.16 of EIA report (Physiography of the mine area) there is reference of river ken, which is not present here. There is reference of river Yamuna, where as the mining area is given on the banks of River Alkhanda the highest point is given as 90.20 Mrl.
- 7- In page 86 of EIA report Forest cover of Pauri Garhwal was given.
- 8- In table 3.17, the list of floral and faunal species which are same in all three EIA given where one is from champawat district, the report has also reported subabul.
- 9- Socio economic survey reference to the project for proposed municipal solid waste management project for Srinagar Nagar Palika Parishad at village Girgaon, Tehsil-Srinagar which has no relation with this project.
- 10- In page no 123 of EIA report production of 71 TPD has been calculated where as according to mining plan which gives the annual production at 6,32,610 tones which comes to 2635.88 TPD.
- 11- In page no 127 of EIA report says about land use changes where as sustainable river bed mining rule only allows.
- 12- In page no 131 of EIA report species selected for plantation include parthenium, hysterothorus, cassia, tora, cannabis sativa, datura, innoxia, lantana, camara which are weed and harmful to human health.


Based on these observations, the authority rejected the proposal and decided to issue show cause notice to the consulting agency that why he should not be debarred from making EIA & EMP report for any project in the state of Uttarakhand.





The Authority agreed with the recommendations of SEAC and decided to grant the Environment Clearance with the terms and conditions recommended by it.


