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# Minutes of the 505<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) held on 25.10.2021

The meeting of 505<sup>th</sup> State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, UP (SEIAA) was held on-line on 25.10.2021 at the Directorate of Environment. The following were present in the meeting:-

 Common Bio-medical Waste Treatment Facility at Khasra No.-1006, Village- Paharpur, Post-Gotha Rasoolpur, District-Deoria, U.P., ShriAmaresh Kumar Rai, M/s JKN Purvanchal CBWTF Works. File No. 5790/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIS/55933/2020

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC dated 08.09.2021 to grant of environmental clearance to the project adding one specific condition:-

- The unit shall strictly comply with the CPCB guidelines for setting up the Common Bio-Medical Waste Treatment Facility (CBWTF).
- Stone Mining at Gata No.-669, Khand No.-07, at Village-Khailar, Tehsil-Sadar, District-Mahoba., Shri Siddharth Yadav, Area-2.530 ha. File No. 6420/Proposal No. SIA/UP/MIN /64125/2021

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC dated 08.09.2021 to issue the terms of References (ToR) SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToRs to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and Lol. In case there is any difference clarification/amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and Lol.
- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).

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- 4- Plan for using the mine void for productive use in consultation with local administration and gram-panchayat.
- 5- SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit permission of CGWA or proposal for alternative source of fresh water.
- 6- KML file for the area and mining lease area should be provided.
- 7- Status of leases granted/to be granted in various mining khands along with production since the formulation of DSR, duly certified by the competent authority should be submitted.
- 8- In case project proponent intends to temporarily store mined out material or any tools, equipments or other material outside mine lease area then NOC from competent authority for doing so should be submitted and details of such area and associated Environmental impacts should be included in EIA-EMP report. This should also be clearly mentioned during public hearing.
- 9- Road network to be used by the project should be clearly shown on Survey of India toposheet in 1:50,000 scale. In case road network involves forest road, permission should be obtained from Forest Department and a copy of the same should be submitted at the time of appraisal of EIA-EMP report.
- 10- The project proponent should clearly spell out whether it is a green field or brown field project. In case it is a brown field project and -
  - If the earlier and present lease holder are same then compliance report of previous EC should be submitted.
  - (ii) If the earlier and present lease holder are different then environmental footprint of the site and mitigation measures should be included in EIA-EMP report.
- 11- In case of expansion / renewal of earlier EC, following information should be submitted
  - Status of compliance of earlier EC conditions by Integrated Regional Office, MoEFCC, Gol, Lucknow.
  - b. Copy of CTE and CTO issued by SPCB.
  - c. Status of submission of six-monthly compliance report to EC granted earlier
  - d. Court cases, if any.
- 12-Observations raised in public hearing, replies submitted by project proponent, suitable modifications carried out in EIA-EMP report.
- 13- Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 3,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.

SEIAA agreed with the recommendation of the SEAC to issue the additional ToRs to the title proposal for conducting EIA studies. The SEIAA also added the following points to TOR;-

- 1- All pages of technical documents/EIA/EMP etc. should be signed by the consultant and project proponent both.
- 2- The lease area its address and production per annum should match with as mentioned in DSR and LoI. In case there is any difference clarification/amendment letter from competent authority shall be submitted along with EIA. EIA and public hearing shall be conducted as per the lease area its address and production per annum mentioned in DSR and LoI.
- 3- Public hearing shall be conducted as per EIA notification, 2006 (as amended).

In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 2,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants below Uttar Pradesh Forest Department's survival rate will be treated as violation of EC condition.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Anand Kumar Gupta dated 17.08.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 489/Parya/SEAC/4100/2018 date 24.11.2018. SEIAA gone through file, documents and noted that the geo-coordinates mentioned in new LOI are different from previous EC. Hence SEIAA opined that EC cannot be transferred in such situation. Hence SEIAA opined that project proponent shall submit a certificate from competent authority that area being transferred is same area for which EC was issued and the reason for change in co-ordinates.

Transfer of EC of Proposed Riverbed Morrum Mining Project from Yamuna River of M/s R.
 A. And Sons located at Khand No. 14/3,14/4, Village - Dedhawal, Tehsil - Manjhanpur,
 District - Kaushambi,UP. Sanctioned Lease Area - 24.28 ha, Effective working Area 16.996 ha Transfer letter dated 08-10-201 File no- 4305

SEIAA noted that the above area was previously transferred for six months vide letter no. 543/Parya/SEIAA/Gen/2020 dated 23.12.2020 in which it is mentioned that EC will not be transferred further and after 6 months the EC will be null and void. However in EIA notification 2006 (as amended) there is no limitation in transfer of EC, hence SEIAA opined to transfer the above EC. SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Ravindra Singh Jaiwar dated 08.10.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 302/Parya/SEAC/4305/2018 date 08.10.2021. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh 28B/100, D/1 Neta Chauraha Allahpur Sadar Allahabad. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh was cancelled vide DM, Kaushambi, order no. 1536/KhananSahayaKadated29.01.2020 and another LOI was issued to Shri Satish Ravindra Singh Jaiwar S/o Shri Jitendra Singh Jaiwar M/s Ex Sand Pvt. Ltd. Golden city Panchmadi road Pipariya Madhya Pradesh, vide letter no. 468(ka)/Khanij-co dated 25.09.2021. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 543/Parya/SEIAA/Gen/2020 dated 23.12.2020 from Shri Rajesh Kumar Singh 28B/100, D/1 Neta Chauraha Allahpur Sadar Allahabad to Shri Satish Ravindra Singh Jaiwar S/o Shri Jitendra Singh Jaiwar M/s Ex Sand Pvt. Ltd. Golden city Panchmadi road Pipariya Madhya Page 4 of 6

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Pradesh for six months and capacity 2,42,500 m<sup>3</sup>/annum. Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 543/Parya/SEIAA/Gen/2020 dated 23.12.2020 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geocoordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Satish Kumar dated 08.10.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 589/Parya/SEAC /4181/2018 date 18.12.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Mohammad Ali R/o Mohammadabad Bizoura, Amroha. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Mohammad Ali vide letter dated 06.03.2018 was cancelled vide DM, Bulandshahar order dated 12.07.2021 and another LOI was issued to Shri Satish Kumar S/o Shri Jile Singh 66/1 near Bara Talab, Baghpat vide letter no. 311/Khanan lipik dated 27.09.2021. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 589/Parya/SEAC /4181/2018 date 18.12.2018 from Shri Mohammad Ali R/o Mohammadabad Bizoura, Amroha to Shri Satish Kumar S/o Shri Jile Singh 66/1 near Bara Talab, Baghpat for capacity 114240 m³/annum .Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 589/Parya/SEAC/4181 /2018 date 18.12.2018 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geocoordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

 Transfer of EC of Sand Morrum mining at Khand No. K-1 Gata no. 364Mi, 366Mi, 367Mi, 390Mi, Vill: Kharka, Tehsil Bhognipur, Distt: Kanpur Dehat.U.P. L. area 16.3 ha. Transfer letter dated 22-10-2021 file no- 4159.

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Chandra Shekhar Agrawal dated 21.09.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 599/Parya/SEAC/4159/2019 dated 08.02.2020. SEIAA gone through file, documents and found that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Bisan Singh S/o Shri Ghanaram station road parichha Jhansi. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Bisan Singh vide letter dated 18.01.2018 was cancelled vide DM, Kanpur Dehat order no. 462/Khanij/2018-19 dated 06.07021 and another LOI was issued to Shri Chandra Shekhar Agrawal S/o Shri Munna lal Agrawal 117Kailash Residency Jhansi vide letter no. 506/upKhanij/ 2021 dated 10.08.2021 for a period of 6 months. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 599/Parya/SEAC/4159/2019 dated 08.02.2020 from Shri Bisan Singh S/o Shri Ghanaram station road parichha Jhansi to Shri Chandra Shekhar Agrawal S/o Shri Munna lal Agrawal 117Kailash Residency Jhansi for six months and 131700 m³ capacity. Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no 599/Parya/SEAC/4159/2019 dated 08.02.2020 shall remain same.

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Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geocoordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

 Transfer of EC of Proposed river bed Sand Mining from Yamuna River at Gata No. 10/25 & 10/26, Village-Kataiya, Tehsil-Chail, District- Kaushambi, U.P. (Leased Area-24.28 ha) Transfer EC 3980 dated 22-10-2021

SEIAA noted that application for transfer of EC has been made. SEIAA gone through file and documents and found that geo-coordinates of the previous lease are not present in the file. Hence SEIAA opined that the project proponent shall submit geo-coordinates of the previous lease.
