SEIAA noted that SEAC has commented that the project proponent/Consultant informed the committee that this area is within 5 km of the CPA boundary in the district of Sonbhadra. The project proponent/Consultant also informed the committee that this area is in SPA as per the EPI score defined by the CPCB assessment of 2018. The NGT order dated 02/8/2021 in the matter of Appeal No. 54/2020 Anil Kumar Yadav Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors. with Review Application No. 07/2021 in Appeal No. 04/2020 Abhinav Gramodyog & Seva Sansthan Versus State Environment Impact Assessment Authority, Uttar Pradesh & Ors. Mentions that... "Accordingly, the joint Committee of MoEF&CC, CPCB and State PCB may, with the help of the District Magistrate, Sonbhadra, finalise the exercise and clarify the factual position of the outer boundary of the CPA and distance of the projects in question from said area. The State PCB will be the nodal agency for coordination and compliance. The Joint Committee may also give a report whether the projects in question fall within the prohibited distance from the protected area under the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 and the inter-State boundary."...Because of the



above order, the committee requests SEIAA to get clarification on whether this case can be taken as category B1 or not.

SEIAA opined that a clarification from SPCB shall be sought whether the above area is within 5 km of the CPA boundary in the district of Sonbhadra or not. Meanwhile the project shall be delisted and the project proponent is at liberty to apply in MOEFCC as category "A" project. Further, SEIAA opined that a letter be sent to DM, Sonbhadra that no mining should take place without valid EC.



11. Regarding transfer of Environment Clearance for sand Mining Project at the riverbed of Yamuna at Khand no. 14/11 to 14/12 located in village Katri, Tehsil Kausambi, District Kausambi, U.P.(lease area -10.46 ha) file no. 4152 Proposal no. SIA/UP/MIN/239438 /2021

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Chandrajeet Kushwaha dated November 2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 27/Parya/SEAC/4152/2018 date 18.04.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Keshari Nandan Singh S/o Shri Rama Shankar Singh Vastu Nagar, Hawelia Jhunsi Phoolpur, Allahabad. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Keshari Nandan Singh was cancelled vide DM, Kaushambi order no. 807(2)/khanij-Ka dated 29.10.2020 and was transferred to M/s Aditya Enterprises for 06 months vide letter no. 556/parya/SEIAA/Gen/2020 dated 23.12.2020. New LOI was issued to M/s Aditya Enterprises Prop. Shri Akhilesh Kumar S/o Shri Ramdas Mathura Urf Parandih Thana Tharavai, Phoolpur Allahabad vide letter no. 908/Khanij-ka dated 29.11.2020 for a period of 6 months. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 27/Parya/SEAC/4152/2018 date 18.04.2018 from Shri Keshari Nandan Singh S/o Shri Rama Shankar Singh Vastu Nagar, Hawelia Jhunsi Phoolpur, Allahabad to M/s Aditya Enterprises Prop. Shri Akhilesh Kumar S/o Shri Ramdas Mathura Urf Parandih Thana Tharavai, Phoolpur Allahabad for six months and 1,40,700 m³ capacity, SEIAA added the following conditions:-

1. In the absence of replenishment study, keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State, EC is transferred for a period of 6 months from the date of issue.
2. For seeking any extension in transfer period or re-transfer, PP shall submit fresh annual replenishment study to SEIAA, UP for amendment in EC for mineable quantity and maximum permissible depth for mining based on scientific findings of replenishment study. Such study shall be placed before SEAC for appraisal.



3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.
5. If the proposed project is situated in notified area of ground water extraction, where creation of new wells for ground water extraction is not allowed, requirement of fresh water shall be met from alternate water sources other than ground water or legally valid source and permission from the competent authority shall be obtained to use it.
6. Project Proponent should submit action plan for carrying out plantation at least @1,000 plants / ha of lease area. In this case, PP should prepare a plan, duly approved either by Forest Department or Horticulture Department, for planting at least 11,000 plants, either on government land or community land, within a periphery of 5 km from the boundary of the lease area along with provision for maintenance for 5 years. Survival of plants should not be less than the survival rate notified by Uttar Pradesh Forest Department otherwise it will be treated as violation of EC condition.

Rest all the content of Environmental Clearance letter no. 27/Parya/SEAC/4152/2018 date 18.04.2018 shall remain same.

Area mentioned in the previous EC is being transferred only. If there is a change in geo-coordinates of the area then EC will be null and void.

12. Transfer of EC of Chelra Sand Mine on Betwa River at Khand No.- 1055, 1107, Villgae-Chelra, Tehsil- Moth, District-Jhansi, Shri Ashish Yadav (Leased Area-16.187 Ha) File No. 4037/Proposal No. (SIA/UP/MIN/72674/2018)

Second transfer

SEIAA gone through the letter of Shri Harsh Sahu dated 17.11.2021 regarding transfer of Environmental Clearance to the above project issued vide letter no. 225/Parya/SEAC /4037/2018 date 08.03.2018. SEIAA gone through file and documents and noted that the Environmental Clearance was issued to Shri Ashish Yadav, S/o Shri Ram Pratap, Village & Post- Palar Bada Gaon, Jhansi. SEIAA noted that the previous lease issued to Shri Ashish Yadav was cancelled vide DM, Jhansi order no. 2103/30MMC/2018-19 dated 02-02-2019 and transferred to Shri Nishant Shukla vide letter no. 418/Parya/SEIAA /4037/2020 dated 15-10-2020 for 06 months. New LOI was issued to M/s Harsh Sahu S/o Shri Vinod Kumar Sahu 940/15 Civil Lines, Near Sita Hotel, Jhansi vide letter no. 876/30 MMC/2021-22 dated 25.10.2021 for a period of 6 months and for 15,000 m³ production capacity, whereas the previous EC was issued for 1,62,000 m³/year. Hence SEIAA opined to transfer Environmental Clearance issued vide letter no. 225/Parya/SEAC/4037/2018 date 08.03.2018 from Shri Ashish Yadav, S/o Shri Ram Pratap, Village & Post- PalarBadaGaon, Jhansi to M/s Harsh Sahu S/o Shri Vinod Kumar Sahu 940/15 Civil Lines, Near Sita Hotel, Jhansi for six months and 15,000 m³ capacity, SEIAA added the following conditions:-

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1. In the absence of replenishment study, keeping in mind various orders issued by Hon'ble NGT and development works in the State, EC is transferred for a period of 6 months from the date of issue.
2. For seeking any extension in transfer period or re-transfer, PP shall submit fresh annual replenishment study to SEIAA, UP for amendment in EC for mineable quantity and maximum permissible depth for mining based on scientific findings of replenishment study. Such study shall be placed before SEAC for appraisal.
3. A certificate from Forest Department shall be obtained that no forest land is involved in mining or as a route and if forest land is involved the project proponent shall obtain forest clearance and permission of Central and State Government as per the provisions of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and submit before the start of work.
4. The mining lease holders shall, after ceasing mining operations, undertake re-grassing the mining area and any other area which may have been disturbed due to their mining activities and restore the land to a condition which is fit for growth of fodder, flora fauna etc.


