M/s CMG Biotech Limited proposed for setting up a new Active Pharmaceutical Ingredient (API) Manufacturing unit at Plot No: 53 & 54 Phase -I, Industrial Area, Sansarpur, Terrace, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh. The proposed project is green field project. Currently there is an existing shed constructed for the establishment of herbal products manufacturing unit as per Consent to establish obtained for the herbal products vide consent number CTE/BOTH/New/RO/2021/3687032 dated 13 August 2021, but further due to change in planning, M/s CMG Biotech Limited now propose to produce the API in the same plant shed and with the same machinery. The total capacity of the plant will be 165 MTPM. Total plot area is 2050 m². The proposed project shall generate employment of 32 nos. Total cost of the project is Rs. 4.7246 Crores. Power requirement of 100 KWH will be sourced from HPSEB. D.G. Sets with capacity of 125 KVA will be installed as power-backup. The total requirement of fresh water for the proposed project will be 41.5 KLD. Water requirement will be made available through Bore well.

The SEAC in its 88th meeting discussed the matter and decided to appraise the case after issuance of necessary directions from SEIAA, Himachal Pradesh in view of clarifications obtained, from MoEF&CC, GoI on Notification no. SO 2859(E) dated 16-07-2021 for relaxation of API/ bulk drug proposals received before 31-12-2021 or earlier pending before SEAC.

Meanwhile SEAC also advised the project proponent to revisit the list of products submitted for seeking Environmental Clearance as under the relaxation only products for addressing ailment such as Noval Corona Virus (COVID-19) are eligible for the appraisal as Cat B2 project as an interim measure.

The hard copy was submitted by Project proponent on dated 25/02/2021.

The case was appraised by the SEAC in its 79th meeting with following observations:

1. The project proponent shall submit the details mining plan as per the guidelines of the concerned department about the existing 66 KVA HT electricity line crossing the mining site.
2. The project proponent shall submit revised details w.r.t. alignment of approach road to the mining site.
3. The project proponent shall submit revised KML showing surrounding mining site area.

The project proponent submitted compliance to the above observations on dated 27-12-2022. Accordingly, the case was listed before the SEAC in its 88th meeting.

After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent that the HT electricity line has been removed by the concerned department from the proposed mining site as submitted by the project proponent, but could not give any evidence, documentary proof or through revised

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drone video regarding the same. The Committee decided to list the case in next meeting after submission of the following observations:

1. The project proponent shall submit revised drone video showing that the existing 66 KVA HT electricity line crossing the mining site has been removed by the concerned department.


The case was listed before the SEAC in its 81st meeting but the project proponent did not appear before the Committee; therefore, it was decided to list the case in next meeting.

The case was again appraised by the SEAC in its 82nd Meeting with following observations:

1. The project proponent shall propose and submit clearly depict the correct details in the presentation and mining plan as per the observations of the Committee w.r.t. method of mining on the same has not been mentioned in the mining plan, approach road.
2. The project proponent shall also obtain & submit valid Letter of Intent.
3. The Committee observed that the clarification w.r.t. above points may also be obtained from the 'Geological Wing', Department of Industries, HP why these details are not incorporated in the Mining Plan and why it should not be rejected on technical grounds.

The project proponent submitted compliance to the above observations on dated 15-09-2022. Accordingly, the case was listed before the SEAC in its 88th meeting.

After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the committee, the SEAC observed that the reply submitted by the proponent was not as per the observations and hence decided to list the case in next meeting after submission of the revised and complete reply/information.

1. The project proponent shall construct boundary pillars in the proposed mining area.
2. The project proponent shall submit copy of complaint filed before the competent authority regarding illegal mining activities visible in the videography shown to the Committee during the appraisal of the case for proposed mining area.
3. The project proponent shall submit NOC from the competent authority/department regarding impact of mining activities to adjoining Hydro-Power Project i.e. Yogendra Power.
4. The project proponent shall also submit clarification from the office of State Geologist for not mentioning the adjoining Hydro-Power Project in the joint inspection report.
5. The project proponent shall submit affidavit to provide five plastic waste shredders, five plastic waste compactor & five baling machines to the concerned ULBs/ PRIs through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.
6. The project proponent shall provide 10 solar lights through Department of Environment, Science & Technology, GoHP.

After deliberating on the information submitted by the project proponent and considering the facts placed before the committee. After detailed deliberation on the facts placed before the SEAC decided to make final recommendation in next meeting after compliance of the following observations:

1. The project proponent shall submit copy of valid Letter of Intent issued from the Mining Department.

Item No. 3, Items for discussions:-

- 3.1 Representation by Dr. Banta regarding Compliance of order dated 15.09.2022 passed by Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi in MA No. 57/2022 in disposed OA no. 55 of 2020 titled as Dr. Pawan Kumar Banta Vs. Union of India & Ors.

A representation has been received from Dr. Banta. In this regard, in order to ascertain the facts w.r.t. allegations made by Dr. Pawan Kumar Banta received in this office, the case was listed in 59th meeting of HP SEIAA held on 28th September, 2022 at DEST office with following directions:-

.....the matter was placed before the SEAC in 86th meeting for decision. The Committee observed that as such as on date no action is pending before committee and there is no pendency at the level of SEAC. More over the SEAC has no jurisdiction over monitoring the change in feature of the project; the same is to be looked into by concerned authority i.e. SPCB or TCP OR MC. The Committee observed that the SEIAA may take necessary action as deem fit in the matter.

.....Therefore, the matter was listed before SEIAA in its 59th meeting; the Authority examined the matter as per the observations of the SEAC in its 86th meeting and in view of the Hon'ble NGT orders dated 14/9/2022. The SEIAA examined the matter and noted that the matter is sub judice before the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh. The same has also been observed by the Hon'ble NGT orders dated 14/9/2022. It was also decided that the Member Secretary (SEIAA) will issue a show cause notice to M/s Nirvana Woods & Hotels

Pvt. Ltd. to reply to the allegations made of non-compliance of the Terms & Conditions of Environment Clearance granted. The matter will be discussed further by the SEIAA after receiving the reply of M/s Nirvana Woods & Hotels Pvt. Ltd. to this show cause notice.

Then after, a notice was issued to M/s Nirvana Woods & Hotels Private Limited vide this office letter dated 06.11.2022. The reply of notice was received in this office vide their letter dated 08.12.2022.

Earlier a committee comprising of different officials from concerned Department's were constituted under the chairmanship of SDM (C), Rural, Shimla in order to ascertain the facts w.r.t. allegations received through email on dated 18.04.2022 from Sh. Anil Thakur, Kyari Gramin Kalyan Sabha, Shimla regarding illegal and unauthorized construction by M/s Nirvana Woods and Hotels Pvt. Limited in khasra number-2 of village Rirka which is a Nallah as per revenue record and the debris which is being thrown in to the Nallah by the project proponent is coming down and hitting the people including children and creating damage to the property of villagers.

Now, this office has received a report from SDM(Civil), Shimla, Rural vide letter dated SML-SDM-Reader-21/02 dated 04.01.2023, stating that:

..... the spot visit was fixed for 1st October, 2022 along with the members/representatives as per the term of reference to the committee to give a clear cut blockage/encroachment on the Nallah in Khasra no. 2 of village Rirka Shimla. It is submitted that in this behalf the alleged project is under construction and the Nallah as reflected in the revenue records has been developed by concretization on both sides under their possession. There is no such blockage/encroachment on the face of it. The nallah has been developed according to the construction plan as put out by the project report the issue on representatives on spot for the overall safety of the structures. It is pertinent to mention here that as per the report of patwari the existing nallah is in running condition. The nallah has been preserved as such looking into the flow of water and concretization has been done on the edges.

.....During the course of deliberation on the spot regarding side cutting, dumping and preservation of strata was discussed and the project authorities were instructed to duly comply with the norms without fail to ensure that downstream no harm is caused in any manner during the seasonal fluctuating flow of water in the nallah. That remedial actions need to be taken during the construction period to ensure that no further damage is caused to life and property. The nallah measures around 3 mtr in width and the retaining wall has been brought up for proper channelization of nallah. There is no visible blockage over the nallah. The construction is visibly a few meters beyond the retaining wall as can be seen in the photographs. The only caution which is required would be to ensure that the seasonal flow is properly maintained as it will fluctuate depending upon the season and also accounting for any untoward incident which may accompany like mudslide or debris flow.

The SEAC in its 88th meeting reviewed the report and observed that no violation is reported by the Committee. The SEIAA may take the decision accordingly.

Malakpur Bangran, Tehsil Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana for mining/extraction of Sand, Stone and Bajri located at Khasra No. 376/250/228, Measuring 03-91-12 Hectares (Private land, River Bed), falling Mauza/Mohal Bangran,

Tehsil Paonta Sahib, District Sirmaur, Himachal Pradesh on 18.01.2023 as per the provisions of EIA, 2006.

As per the provision of circular issued by MoEF&CC vide OM No. 291 dated 06/05/2022 (the auto TOR has been issued to the PP online on predefined standard format.

The SEAC in its 88th meeting deliberated on the issuance of Standard TORs. The SEAC observed that standard TOR has been generated online as per the provision of OM No. 291 dated 06/05/2022 issued by MoEF&CC. The SEAC recommended that, if required, Standard TOR letter may also be issued from SEIAA in favour of the project proponent.
